PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Justin Milo, So., OF, Vermont
(Edina, Minn./Edina/Cornell)

Milo had just three hits (.300 ba) in UVM's three-game series at Hartford but two of them produced game-winning RBI to propel the Catamounts into the conference tournament. His two-out, RBI single plated the gamewinner in the fifth inning of Vermont's come-from-behind 3-2 win over the Hawks in Saturday's first game, while his two-run homer in the first inning of Saturday's nightcap was all the Cats needed for a 3-1 victory. Milo slugged .600 and reached base at a .417 clip for the week. He also drove in three runs total and scored two more on his own during the must-win series.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Zach Groh, Sr., RHP, Binghamton
Reading, Pa./The Perkiomen School

Groh earned his fifth win of the season for top-seeded Binghamton after allowing no earned runs in seven innings against Maine. He scattered six hits, five singles and one double, in the outing and struck out seven to boost his season total to 69. Groh walked just one batter in the effort and remained undefeated against conference opponents with a 3.07 ERA. This is his second such award of the season, also garnering the season's first weekly pitching accolade.

ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Corey Taylor, Fr., CF, Binghamton
Vestal, N.Y./Vestal

Taylor continued his mastery of America East pitching with six hits in three games against Maine. He batted .500 while drawing a walk, driving in two runs and crossing the plate for three more runs. Taylor finished his first conference season with a .418 average (28-for-67), tops in the league. The rookie has hit safely in eight straight games and 10 of his last 11 games, recording 12 RBI in that span. This is the second straight week Taylor as earned the conference's rookie award.
