UMBC Head Coach Randy Monroe

On the type game it was

"It's typical of what the America East Conference has been like all year. Every game has been a war, it has been a dog fight."

On Darryl Proctor

"I can't tell you how proud and fortunate I am to have had the opportunity to coach Darryl (Proctor). He put us on his back and he was not to be denied tonight. I cannot tell you how proud I am of him tonight and of what he's done for this program."
