America East Conference

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Men's Basketball

- America East sent three teams to the postseason for just the second time in league history.
- Stony Brook hosted Illinois in the first round of the NIT. The Seawolves became just the second America East squad to play a postseason game on its home court and first since Niagara hosted an NIT contest in 1987. SBU was edged by the Illini, 76-66, in front of a sellout crowd of 4,423 fans at Stony Brook Arena.
- Boston University advanced to the semifinals of the College Basketball Invitational by blowing out Oregon State, 96-78, in the first round and downing Morehead State, 91-89, in overtime of the quarterfinals at Case Gym.
- Vermont defeated Boston University, 83-70, in the 2010 America East Men's Championship Game in front of a sellout crowd and a nationally television audience on ESPN2. The title was Vermont's fourth since 2003.
- UVM faced Syracuse in the first round of the NCAA Championship in Buffalo and ranked sixth out of 65 NCAA teams with a 92 percent graduation rate.
- America East posted four wins against BCS-conference schools in 2009-10 and has seven victories against Big Six schools since 2008.
- Newman's Own Foundation contributed more than \$100,000 to charities in America East communities during the championship.
- Ten of 15 All-America East selections return this season, including a trio of first-team selections in Binghamton's Greer Wright, Boston University's John Holland and Maine's Gerald McLemore.

at No. 2 Vermont 83, No. 4 Boston University 70

Marqus Blakely recorded a monster double-double of 24 points and 18 rebounds to lead Vermont to its fourth America East crown since 2003... The 'Cats have now won four league titles in the last eight years.

Semifinals: Sunday, March 7

No. 2 Vermont 57, No. 6 New Hampshire 38

The Catamounts held UNH to the lowest point total in a conference semifinal contest and advanced to their sixth America East title game in eight years... Garvey Young led the way with 15 points.

No. 4 Boston University 70, No. 1 Stony Brook 63

Corey Lowe tallied 24 points, six rebounds and five steals off the bench to lead the Terriers to their first America East final since 2003... Carlos Strong added 15 points and eight boards.

Jake O'Brien (28 pts) and Corey Lowe (26 pts) combined for 54 points and led the Terriers to the second-largest margin of victory in tournament history... Boston U. tied the record for three's in a game with 14.

SEASON OUTLOOK

• The Great Danes will look to rebound from a season in which they won just seven games and finished last in the league standings for the first time since the 2003-04 season.

• Sophomore point guard Mike Black hopes to build on a solid rookie season when he was selected to the America East All-Rookie squad. Black averaged 10.7 points and 3.7 assists in conference play and scored 14 or more points in five of his last seven contests.

• Albany's Will Brown may be only 38, but he is the longest tenured America East head coach. Entering his 10th year on the Great Danes' bench, Brown ranks second among the league's coaches with 113 Division I victories and a pair of conference titles.

SEASON OUTLOOK

- The Retrievers, who went just 4-26 last season, will need to improve their defense, which ranked last in America East in 2009-10 by allowing 73.8 ppg.
- UMBC ranked among the nation's best in taking care of the ball once again last season. After finishing second and third in turnover margin each of the last two years, respectively, the Retrievers ranked 25th in 2009-10, averaging just 11.4 tpg.
- Junior guard Chris De La Rosa averaged 11.7 points and a league-best 5.1 assists in his first season at UMBC. The Siena transfer also ranked second among league leaders in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.20).
- Senior Justin Fry, the team's last remaining link to the 2008 championship squad, returns after missing last season due to injury. Fry averaged 8.1 points and 4.7 rebounds during the 2008-09 campaign and should help improve UMBC's rebounding margin (-9.7), which ranked last in the league in 2009-10.
