AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Three America East teams sit at .500 or better, including Vermont (4-2), winner of four its of last five, Albany (3-2), which has won two out of its last three and Maine (1-1).
- Boston U. knocked off Atlantic 10 foe Rhode Island, 70-64, Saturday for its first win of the season and Joe Jones' first as Terrier head coach.
- Several newcomers have been impressive in the early going. Albany's Gerardo Suero, a junior transfer, scored 31 points at Syracuse on Nov. 15 and is averaging 20.6 points per game, which ranks third in the league. Maine's Justin Edwards, a freshman guard, scored 20 points at UConn on Nov. 17 and ranks second with 22.0 points through two games. Binghamton's Ben Dickinson ranks seventh averaging 15.0 points per game while Vermont's Four McGlynn is 14th averaging 11.2 points through four games.

WEEKLY HONOREES



PLAYER OF THE WEEK Gerardo Suero, Jr., G, Albany

Suero racked up 60 points and shot 64 percent from the floor in two games last week to earn his first career America East Player of the Week honor. Averaging a league-best 25.7 points over his first three games as a Great Dane, Suero contributed 30.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game last week. He scored 29 in a win over Brown on Monday and added 31, the most for an Albany player since 2007, against #5 Syracuse on Tuesday.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Justin Edwards, Fr., G, Maine

Edwards impressed in his first two collegiate games, averaging 22.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.5 steals in helping the Black Bears start 1-1. The freshman guard scored 24 points on 11-of-13 shooting while adding nine rebounds, five steals, three blocks and a pair of assists in the Black Bears' win over Maine-Machias Monday. He then helped Maine stay with #4 UConn, scoring 20 points to go with five rebounds, two assists and two steals.

- Gerardo Suero, the league's third leading scorer (20.7 ppg) eclipsed the 20-point mark for the third time this season and finished with 21 points.

- Three others had twin figures: Logan Aronhalt (18 pts), Mike Black (16 pts) and Luke Devlin (12 points).

- The Bearcats outrebounded the Peacocks 38-32 and rank fourth in America East with a +1.8 rebound margin.

- The win was Joe Jones' first as the Terriers' head coach and 87th at the Division I level.

- Darryl Partin, the league's leading scorer (22.7 ppg), scored 20 points for the third straight game.

- D.J. Irving had a huge games, scoring a career-high 21 points on 9-of-14 shooting and adding eight assists, five rebounds and three steals.

HARTFORD HAWKS

- After leading America East as team in steals last season, the Hawks rank second so far in 2011-12, swiping 8.2 thefts per game.

- First-year players make up six of Hartford's top eight scoring leaders and are contributing over 70 percent of the scoring through five games.

MAINE BLACK BEARS

- Justin Edwards tallied 20 points and five rebounds against UConn and is averaging 22.5 points and seven boards through his first two games as a Black Bear.

- The Black Bears have shot a league-best 52.7 percent through two games while allowing foes to shoot just 35.7 percent.

UMBC RETRIEVERS

- After contributing a double-double at VMI, Chris De La Rosa sat out his fourth game of the year.

- UMBC is one of just two America East teams to have had three different 20 point scorers. Besides Plummer, Brian Neller netted a career-best 27 points against Loyola and freshman Chandler Thomas had 23 at VMI.
