AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Four America East teams sit at .500 or better, including Vermont (4-2), winner of four of its last five including victories over Old Dominion and Siena, Albany (4-3), which has won three out of its last four.
- America East teams are 7-5 since Saturday with five of those victories coming over Atlantic 10, Colonial Athletic Association and MAAC schools.
- Several newcomers have been impressive in the early going. Albany's Gerardo Suero (21.0 ppg), a junior transfer, ranks third in scoring while Maine's Justin Edwards, a freshman, ranks fourth with 20.0 points through four games and also leads the conference in steals (3.8 spg) and blocks (2.0 bpg). Binghamton freshman Ben Dickinson is tied for seventh averaging 15.0 points per game while Vermont freshman Four McGlynn is 14th averaging 11.2 points through six games.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Darryl Partin, Sr., Guard, Boston U.

Partin picked up his second career Player of the Week honor by scoring 20-plus points in all three of his games and week and leading the Terriers to two wins in those three games. The senior guard averaged 23 points, five rebounds and two assists against three quality opponents, Cleveland State, Rhode Island and Hofstra in the TicketCity Legends Classic at URI.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Justin Edwards, Fr., Guard, Maine

Edwards picked up his second straight Rookie of the Week honor by leading Maine to its first-ever win over Holy Cross on Sunday. The freshman guard scored 22 points on 9-of-15 shooting while adding seven rebounds, six steals, and a block in the Black Bears' 72-60 win over the Crusaders Sunday, its first win in seven all-time series meetings.

- Albany downed Fairleigh Dickinson Sunday by closing the first half on a 13-0 run and shooting 49 percent from the field.
- Gerardo Suro, the league's third leading scorer (21.0 ppg), eclipsed the 20-point mark for the fourth time this season and finished with 23 points.
- The Great Danes, which rank second in America East averaging 69.7 points per game, have won back-to-back games and three of their last four.
- Logan Aronhalt (15.0 ppg) added 15 points, eight rebounds and five assists. He and Suro are the league's second-best scoring tandem (36.0 ppg).

HARTFORD HAWKS

- The Hawks committed 22 turnovers and dropped their seventh straight game to start the season by losing to Yale Tuesday.
- Hartford had its best offensive game of the year, scoring a season-best 69 points and shooting a season-high 50 percent from the field. Genesis Maciel and Wes Cole each had season highs of 16 points.
- After leading America East as team in steals last season, the Hawks rank second so far in 2011-12, swiping 7.9 thefts per game.
- First-year players make up six of Hartford's top eight scoring leaders and are contributing over 70 percent of the scoring through five games.

NEW HAMPSHIRE WILDCATS

- Playing for the first time in 10 days, UNH was not affected by the layoff early against Dartmouth Wednesday, shooting 52 percent from the floor in the opening frame and holding on for the win.
- The Wildcats' Alvin Abreu scored a game-high 21 points on 7-of-13 shooting. He ranks second among league leaders averaging 17 points per game.
- Brian Benson added nine points and nine rebounds. He is the league leader on the glass, pulling down 11.5 misses per game.
- As has been a staple during Bill Herrion's tenure, New Hampshire has been strong defensively, holding opponents to 60.5 points per game, which is tops in America East.

- Playing for the first time in a week, Binghamton fell at Missouri Sunday. The Tigers shot 56 percent from the field and won the turnover battle 21-6.
- Freshman Ben Dickinson led four Bearcats in double figures with 15 points and added seven rebounds. He is one of just three players to rank in the conference's top 10 in both scoring (T-7th - 15.0 ppg) and rebounding (10th - 6.2 rpg).
- Robert Mansell scored 11 points and ranks sixth among the league's scoring leaders (15.2 ppg).
- Freshmen have paced Binghamton in scoring in four of its five games.

- Darryl Partin scored 10 of his game-high 27 points in the final five minutes to seal the victory. The league's leading scorer is averaging 23.7 points per game, which also ranks among the nation's top 10.
- The Terriers are shooting 48 percent as a team during their win streak compared with their 38 percent mark in their first four games.
- Boston U. plays crosstown-rival Boston College for the first time since 2004 on Saturday.

- Gerald McLemore, the league's active leading scorer (1,264 pts.), scored a game-high 26 points.
- Only four America East players are currently averaging over 20 points per game and two of them are Black Bears. McLemore ranks second among leaders (21.7 ppg) while Justin Edwards, the reigning Rookie of the Week, is fourth (20.0 ppg).
- The Black Bears have shot a league-high 49.2 percent through four games while allowing foes to shoot just 40.0 percent, also a league-best.

UMBC RETRIEVERS

- UMBC is one of just two teams to have had three different 20 point scorers this season. Chase Plummer, Brian Neller and Chandler Thomas have all eclipsed the barrier.
- Chris De La Rosa, a second-team all-league selection last year, has left the program due to personal and family related matters.

- SBU has seven players averaging 6.8 points per game or better including Joyner and Bryan Dougher, who are tied for the team lead (10.2 ppg).

- Glass and Ben Crenca each scored a team-best 13 points against the Saints. Brian Voelkel had seven points, 14 rebounds and eight assists.
