AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- · Boston University beat Boston College on Dec. 3. The win was America East's ninth over a BCS conference school since 2008.
- · America East is the only Division I conference with three players ranked among the nation's top-20 scoring leaders. Maine's Gerald McLemore is eighth (22.0 ppg), Boston U.'s Darryl Partin (21.2) is 14th and Albany's Gerardo Suero (20.9) is 16th.
- · America East recently announced its largest national television package in league history. The slate will include 38 America East regular season and postseason appearances on ESPN networks in men's and women's basketball and men's lacrosse as well as five games nationally televised on CBS Sports Network.
- Several newcomers have made immediate impacts this season. Albany's Gerardo Suero (20.9 ppg), a junior transfer, ranks third among league leaders while Maine's Justin Edwards, a freshman, ranks fourth with 17.9 points. Binghamton freshman Ben Dickinson is fifth averaging 15.0 points per game.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK Gerardo Suero, Jr., Guard, Albany

Suero earned his second Player of the Week honor of the season after averaging 20.5 points and 5.0 rebounds in a pair of games last week. The junior transfer had the best game of any America East player this week, scoring 29 points on 11-of-14 shooting in Al-

bany's win over Colgate on Wednesday. He also added five rebounds and a pair of assists. Suero scored 12 points to go with five rebounds, three assists in his team's loss to Siena Monday.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Wes Cole, Fr., Guard, Hartford

Cole earned his first career Rookie of the Week honor after scoring a career-high 26 points off the bench last week against Niagara and nearly leading Hartford back from a 17-point deficit. The freshman guard, who averaged 14.5 points and 2.0 steals for the week, canned

eight three-pointers against the Purple Eagles, including seven in the second half. His eight treys are the second-most in Hartford history and are tied for seventh on America East's single-game list.

- Albany shot a blistering 65.5 percent from the floor and extended its home court win streak to six (3-0 this year) with a win over Colgate Wednesday.
- Gerardo Suero scored 29 points on 11-of-14 shooting. He ranks third among league leaders averaging 20.9 points per game.
- Logan Aronhalt and Mike Black each added 16 points. Suero, Aronhalt and Black average a combined 47 points per game, which ranks second among America East trios.
- · Albany, which ranks second in America East in scoring averaging 70.6 points per game, is scoring 79.8 ppg in their wins and 59.0 ppg in their losses.

BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

- The Bearcats allowed Bucknell to shoot 61 percent from the floor and fell for the seventh straight time on Tuesday.
- Freshman Ben Dickinson tallied a game-high 20 points. He is one of just three players to rank in the conference's top 10 in both scoring (5th - 15.0 ppg) and rebounding (T-7th - 6.6 rpg).
- · Dickinson isn't the only freshman contributor for Binghamton as first-year players comprise four of team's top six scoring leaders and have paced the team in points in six of its seven games this season.

- The Terriers have a week off before hosting defending Patriot League champion Bucknell on Dec.






- · The Black Bears will have eight days off before hosting Utah Valley on Dec. 19. It will be their first home game since Nov. 27.

STONY BROOK SEAWOLVES


