AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- America East is the only Division I conference with three players ranked among the nation's top-15 scoring leaders. Maine's Gerald McLemore ranks seventh (21.5 ppg), Albany's Gerardo Suero (21.4 ppg) is tied for eighth while Boston U.'s Darryl Partin ranks 13th scoring 20.8 points per contest.
- Boston University beat Boston College on Dec. 3. The win was America East's ninth over a BCS conference school since 2008.
- Maine head coach Ted Woodward received a contract extension that will run through the 2014-15 season on Dec. 22. The eighth-year head coach has led Maine to consecutive top-3 finishes in America East for only the second time in the past 20 years and a 39-30 record over the last two-plus seasons.
- America East recently announced its largest national television package in league history. The slate will include 38 America East regular season and post-season appearances on ESPN networks in basketball and men's lacrosse as well as five games nationally televised on CBS Sports Network.

WEEKLY HONOREES



PLAYER OF THE WEEK Chase Plummer, So., Forward, UMBC

Plummer earned his first career Player of the Week honor after averaging a double-double of 16.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in a pair of games last week. A sophomore forward, Plummer recorded his third and fourth double-doubles of the year in close losses to Morgan State and Rider last week. He scored 11 points and added 12 rebounds and three steals against the Bears on Thursday before racking up a career-high 22 points and 11 rebounds in an overtime loss to the Broncs Saturday.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Four McGlynn, Fr., Guard, Vermont

McGlynn picked up his first Rookie of the Week honor of the year after nearly leading Vermont to a win over Iona, one of the top mid-major teams in the country this season, Saturday. The freshman guard came off the bench to score a career-high 19 points in a 73-72 loss to the Gaels. He shot 7-of-12 from the floor, including 2-of-4 from long range, and added a pair of rebounds.

ALBANY GREAT DANES

- Albany goes for its fifth win in its last seven games against Dartmouth Friday. The Great Danes beat St. Francis, N.Y. its last time out.

- Gerardo Suero went over the 20-point mark for the seventh time, scoring 25 points against the Terriers. He ranks second in America East and is tied for ninth nationally averaging 21.4 points per game.

- Albany is one of the most explosive offensive teams in the the league, ranking second in both scoring (72.1 ppg) and field goal percentage (.457).

- The Great Danes feature one of the top tandems in the league. Suero and Logan Aronhalt (15.2 ppg) combine for the league's second-highest scoring output among teammates (36.6 ppg).

BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

- Freshman Ben Dickinson scored a team-high 17 points and is one of just four players to rank in the conference's top 10 in both scoring (7th - 14.1 ppg) and rebounding (9th - 6.3 rpg).

- Robert Mansell ranks ninth among league leaders averaging 13.2 points per game.

- The Bearcats, who have led America East in home attendance each of the last eight years, are once again drawing the most fans in 2011-12 and are averaging 3,121 fans through five home dates.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY TERRIERS

- The Terriers were without starting point guard D.J. Irving, who missed the game with an injury. He ranks 13th among league leaders in scoring (12.6 ppg) and is second in assists (4.9 apg).

- Darryl Partin scored a team-high 17 points. He ranks third among league leaders and 32th nationally averaging 20.8 points per game.

- Boston U. wraps up the non-conference portion of its schedule on road and faces La Salle on Dec. 29 and Quinnipiac on Dec. 31.

- Freshman Jamie Schneck came off the bench and registered the first double-double by a Hawk this season, scoring 16 points and grabbing 13 boards,

- Sikma and Schneck are two of several freshmen contributing for Hartford. Five of the team's top seven scorers are first-year players and freshmen are accounting for 66 percent of the team's scoring.

- Justin Edwards (17.3 ppg, 6.3 rpg) and Alasdair Fraser (13.1 ppg, 7.9 rpg) are two of four players to rank in the top 10 in both scoring and rebounding.

- Maine head coach Ted Woodward received a contract extension through 2015 on Thursday.

- Plummer is one of just four players to rank in the league's top 10 in both scoring (8th - 13.8 ppg) and rebounding (2nd - 8.7 rpg).

- Chris De La Rosa, a second-team all-league selection last year, has left the program due to personal and family related matters.


