AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- · America East is the only Division I conference with three players ranked among the nation's top-20 scoring leaders. Albany's Gerardo Suero (21.5 ppg) is sixth in the country, while Boston U.'s Darryl Partin ranks 11th scoring 20.8 points per contest and Maine's Gerald McLemore is 17th (20.2 ppg)
- Albany, Maine and Vermont combined to go 7-0 last week. The Great Danes and Catamounts have won consecutive games while the Black Bears have won three in a row.
- Maine head coach Ted Woodward received a contract extension that will run through the 2014-15 season on Dec. 22. The eighth-year head coach has led Maine to consecutive top-3 finishes in America East for only the second time in the past 20 years and a 40-30 record over the last two-plus seasons.
- America East recently announced its largest national television package in league history. The slate will include 38 America East regular season and postseason appearances on ESPN networks in basketball and men's lacrosse as well as five games nationally televised on CBS Sports Network.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK Alasdair Fraser, So., Forward, Maine

Fraser picks up his first career Player of the Week award after averaging 16 points, eight rebounds and 1.3 blocks in three wins. He started his week off by collecting 12 points and five rebounds in a 77-60 win over Utah Valley U. on Monday. He then had one of

his best games of the season, registering his third double-double of the campaign (19 points, 11 rebounds) in a 64-60 win over Eastern Illinois Wednesday. The 6-foot-7 big man finished his week with 16 points and eight rebounds in a 71-58 victory over Brown on Friday.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Justin Edwards, Fr., Guard, Maine

Edwards earned his fourth Rookie of the Week honor already this season by averaging 16 points, eight rebounds and 4.7 assists in leading Maine to three wins last week. He had 17 points, seven rebounds and five assists in a win over Utah Valley U. on Monday, then

had 14 points, nine boards and four helpers in Wednesday's win over Eastern Illinois. Edwards capped the week off by scoring 16 points, grabbing eight rebounds and adding five assists against Brown Friday.

- Albany trailed Maryland by just three (74-71) with 3:02 left on Wednesday, but the Terrapins closed the game on a 9-1 run and dealt the Great Danes their first loss in three games.
- · Gerardo Suero led four Great Danes in twin figures with 22 points and added seven rebounds and eight assists. He eclipsed the 20-point mark for the third straight game and league-best ninth time this year and also leads America East and ranks sixth nationally averaging 21.5 points per game.
- The Great Danes are a perfect 4-0 at SEFCU Arena this season and have won seven straight at home dating back to last season.




