AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- America East is the only Division I conference with three players ranked among the nation's top-20 scoring leaders. Albany's Gerardo Suero (21.5 ppg) is sixth in the country, while Maine's Gerald McLemore is 11th (20.8 ppg) and Boston University's Darryl Partin is 17th (20.2 ppg).
- Maine head coach Ted Woodward received a contract extension that will run through the 2014-15 season on Dec. 22. The eighth-year head coach has led Maine to consecutive top-3 finishes in America East for only the second time in the past 20 years and a 40-31 record over the last two-plus seasons.
- America East recently announced its largest national television package in league history. The slate will include 38 America East regular season and post-season appearances on ESPN networks in basketball and men's lacrosse as well as five games nationally televised on CBS Sports Network.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Alasdair Fraser, So., Forward, Maine

Fraser picks up his first career Player of the Week award after averaging 16 points, eight rebounds and 1.3 blocks in three wins. He started his week off by collecting 12 points and five rebounds in a 77-60 win over Utah Valley U. on Monday. He then had one of his best games of the season, registering his third double-double of the campaign (19 points, 11 rebounds) in a 64-60 win over Eastern Illinois Wednesday. The 6-foot-7 big man finished his week with 16 points and eight rebounds in a 71-58 victory over Brown on Friday.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Justin Edwards, Fr., Guard, Maine

Edwards earned his fourth Rookie of the Week honor already this season by averaging 16 points, eight rebounds and 4.7 assists in leading Maine to three wins last week. He had 17 points, seven rebounds and five assists in a win over Utah Valley U. on Monday, then had 14 points, nine boards and four helpers in Wednesday's win over Eastern Illinois. Edwards capped the week off by scoring 16 points, grabbing eight rebounds and adding five assists against Brown Friday.

ALBANY GREAT DANES

- Albany looks to take a winning record into league play as it faces Mount St. Mary's Saturday.

- Albany trailed Maryland by just three (74-71) with 3:02 left on Wednesday, but the Terrapins closed the game on a 9-1 run and dealt the Great Danes their first loss in three games.

- Gerardo Suero scored 22 points and added seven rebounds and eight assists. He eclipsed the 20-point mark for the third straight game and league-best ninth time this year and also leads America East and ranks sixth nationally averaging 21.5 ppg.

- The Great Danes are a perfect 4-0 at SEFCU Arena this season and have won seven straight at home dating back to last season.



BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

- Manhattan jumped out to a 43-13 halftime advantage and shot 59 percent for the game in dealing Binghamton its 12th straight loss.

- Jimmy Gray scored a season-high 15 points for the Bearcats. He also had three assists and ranks eighth among league leaders (3.8 apg).

- Robert Mansell scored 14 points and ranks seventh among league leaders averaging 13.3 ppg.

- Ben Dickinson is one of just four players to rank in the conference's top 13 in both scoring (6th - 13.8 ppg) and rebounding (T9th - 6.0 rpg).

- The Bearcats open conference play against Maine at home on Monday.

- Boston U. closes out 2011 at Quinnipiac on Saturday. It's last time out, La Salle used an 11-0 first half run to build a lead and dealt the Terriers their fifth straight defeat on Thursday.

- Malik Thomas led the Terriers with career highs of 17 points and eight rebounds.

- Darryl Partin scored 12 points and ranks third among league leaders and 17th nationally averaging 20.2 points per game.

- The Terriers were without point guard D.J. Irving, who missed his second straight game with an injury. He ranks 12th among league leaders in scoring (12.6 ppg) and is second in assists (4.9 apg).



HARTFORD HAWKS

- Hartford plays for the first time in nine days as it travels to La Salle Saturday. The Hawks fell in double overtime at Marist in its last game Dec. 21.

- Freshman Nate Sikma poured in a career-high 23 points. He's one of three Hawks averaging double figures (10.1 ppg) and is also contributing a team-best 5.0 rebounds per game.

- Freshman Jamie Schneck came off the bench and registered the first double-double by a Hawk this season, scoring 16 points and grabbing 13 boards.

- Sikma and Schneck are two of several freshmen contributing for Hartford. Five of the team's top seven scorers are first-year players and freshmen are accounting for 66 percent of the team's scoring.



MAINE BLACK BEARS

- Maine shot under 40 percent for just the third time this season and had its three-game win streak snapped at Florida Gulf Coast Thursday.

- Gerald McLemore scored a game-high and tied his season high with 26 points. He ranks second in America East and 11th nationally averaging 20.8 points per game.

- McLemore, Justin Edwards and Alasdair Fraser all rank in the league's top 10 in scoring and combine to score 49.3 points per game.

- Maine head coach Ted Woodward received a contract extension through 2015 on Dec. 22.



UMBC RETRIEVERS

- Ryan Cook scored a game and career-high 26 points off the bench on 9-of-14 shooting.

- Cook is the fourth different Retriever to score 20 or more points in a game joining Chase Plummer, Brian Neller and Chandler Thomas. UMBC joins Albany as the only team in America East to claim four 20-point scorers.

- Plummer is one of just four players to rank in the league's top 12 in both scoring (11th - 12.8 ppg) and rebounding (2nd - 8.9 rpg).
