AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Boston University, winner of four of its last five games, beat Boston College on Saturday, its first win over its crosstown rival since 1974. The win was America East's ninth over a BCS conference school since 2008.
- The Terriers' Darryl Partin ranks second nationally averaging 23.9 points per game and leads the country in made field goals with 73.
- America East announced its largest national television package in league history last week. The slate will include 38 America East regular season and post-season appearances on ESPN networks in men's and women's basketball and men's lacrosse as well as five games nationally televised on CBS Sports Network.
- Several newcomers have been impressive in the early going. Albany's Gerardo Suero (20.9 ppg), a junior transfer, ranks second among league leaders while Maine's Justin Edwards, a freshman, ranks fourth with 20.2 points. Binghamton freshman Ben Dickinson is fifth averaging 15.0 points per game.

WEEKLY HONOREES



PLAYER OF THE WEEK D.J. Irving, So., Guard, Boston U.

Irving earned his first career Player of the Week honor after dominating in all phases of the game and leading Boston U. to wins over Delaware and Boston College last week. A sophomore guard, Irving had a spectacular all-around week averaging 12.5 points, 9.0 assists,

6.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals in the two games. He also shot 56 percent from the field (9-of-16), including 71 percent from three-point range (5-of-7), and had a 4-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio, committing just four miscues in 68 minutes of action.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Justin Edwards, Fr., Guard, Maine

Edwards earned his third straight Rookie of the Week honor, becoming the seventh player in league history to win the award in three consecutive weeks. The freshman guard averaged 17.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists while shooting 56.5 percent from the field in Maine's two games last week. Edwards contrib-

uted 14 points, three rebounds and three blocks in an overtime loss at Eastern Illinois on Wednesday. He then had 21 points, seven rebounds and a pair of assists in Sunday's overtime victory at Rhode Island.

ALBANY GREAT DANES

- Albany shot a blistering 65.5 percent from the floor and extended its home court win streak to six (3-0 this year) with a win over Colgate Wednesday.
- Gerardo Suero scored 29 points on 11-of-14 shooting. He ranks second among league leaders averaging 20.9 points per game.
- Logan Aronhalt and Mike Black each added 16 points. Suero, Aronhalt and Black average a combined 47 points per game, which ranks second among America East trios.
- · Albany, which ranks second in America East in scoring averaging 70.6 points per game, is scoring 79.8 ppg in their wins and 59.0 ppg in their losses.

BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

- The Bearcats allowed Bucknell to shoot 61 percent from the floor and fell for the seventh straight time on Tuesday.
- Freshman Ben Dickinson tallied a game-high 20 points. He is one of just three players to rank in the conference's top 10 in both scoring (6th - 15.0 ppg) and rebounding (8th - 6.6 rpg).
- Dickinson isn't the only freshman contributor for Binghamton as first-year players comprise four of team's top six scoring leaders and have paced the team in points in six of its seven games this season.
- The Bearcats will have 10 days off before resum ing play against Hofstra on Dec. 17.

- The Terriers will host #25/24 Harvard on Saturday. It will be the first time an America East team has hosted a ranked opponent since Vermont entertained #23 Nevada on Nov. 23, 2005.
- Boston U. allowed the Hawks to shoot 50 percent from the field and had its four-game win streak snapped on Wednesday.
- · Boston U. is shooting 47 percent in wins this season, compared with just 38 percent in losses.
- Darryl Partin scored 24 points, his eighth game going over 20 already this season. He leads America East and ranks second nationally averaging 23.9 points per game.

HARTFORD HAWKS

- Quinnipiac converted 20 Hartford turnovers into 26 points en route to the win Tuesday. The Hawks host Niagara Saturday.
- Senior Andres Torres scored a career-high 25 points on 7-of-12 shooting, including 6-of-9 from three-point land. His 9.4 points per game are a team best.
- · Freshmen are playing key roles for the Hawks as five of the team's seven top scorers are first-year players. Nate Sikma leads the group averaging 8.6 points and a team-high 4.6 rebounds per game.
- · After leading America East as team in steals last season, the Hawks rank second so far in 2011-12 swiping 7.8 thefts per game.

MAINE BLACK BEARS

- The Black Bears led Notre Dame 64-63 with nine minutes left but the Fighting Irish used a 10-0 run down the stretch to earn the win Thursday.
- Gerald McLemore scored a season-high 27 points. He ranks second among league leaders and 11th nationally averaging 21.8 points per game.
- · McLemore, Justin Edwards and Alasdair Fraser are the league's top scoring trio, averaging a combined 55.5 points per game. McLemore ranks second (21.8 ppg), Edwards is fourth (20.2 ppg) and Fraser is 12th (13.5 ppg).
- · Saturday's game at San Diego will be a homecoming for McLemore, who resides from there.

UMBC RETRIEVERS

- UMBC plays at Towson Saturday in its first action in 10 eight days.
- UMBC's bench scored 41 of the team's points at American on Dec. 1. Chase Plummer led the way with 18 points and nine rebounds. He's one of just three players to rank in the league's top 10 in both scoring (T-10th - 14.8 ppg) and rebounding (2nd - 7.9 rpg).
- UMBC is one of just three teams (Albany, Maine) to have had three different 20 point scorers this season, Chase Plummer, Brian Neller and Chandler Thomas have all eclipsed the barrier.
- · Chris De La Rosa, a second-team all-league selection last year, has left the program due to personal and family related matters.

NEW HAMPSHIRE WILDGATS

- · UNH had four players in double figures led by Alvin Abreu's 18 points. He's tied for fifth among league leaders averaging 15.0 points per game.
- · UNH continues to excel defensively as it held Brown to just 56 points and 36 percent shooting. The Wildcats lead America East holding opponents to 60.8 points per game and are second in field goal percentage defense (.415).
- · The Wildcats go for their second straight win when they visit Fairfield Sunday.
