## AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Stony Brook, winner of six straight, is off to its first 4-0 America East start in program history, while Albany has won six of eight and sits at 3-1. Finishing among the league's top two is crucial for teams with championship aspirations. Only twice in America East's 32 year history has a team finished outside the top two and gone on to win the league title (Delaware '99, Holy Cross '80).
- America East is the only Division I conference with three players ranked among the nation's top-20 scoring leaders. Albany's Gerardo Suero (22.2 ppg) is fourth in the country, while Boston University's Darryl Partin is 14th (20.2ppg) and Maine's Gerald McLemore is 15th (20.2 ppg).
- There is a youth movement in America East. No teams regularly start more than two seniors while Albany and Binghamton are two of nine Division I programs without a senior on its roster. Additionally, four of the league's top 20 scorers are freshmen, led by Maine's Justin Edwards, who ranks fourth (15.2 ppg), and who is also seventh in rebounding (6.4 rpg). Binghamton's Ben Dickinson is 14th in scoring (12.1 ppg) and ninth in rebounding (6.1 rpg).

## WEEKLY HONOREES



### PLAYER OF THE WEEK Gerardo Suero, Jr., Guard, Albany

Suero continued his elite play averaging 24.7 points, 6.7 rebounds and 4.3 assists in helping Albany go 2-1 last week en route to earning his second straight America East Player of the Week award and fourth overall. The junior transfer, who ranks fourth nationally averaging 22.5 points per game, started his week by contributing 24 points, nine rebounds and five assists in a win over Hartford on Monday. He followed that showing by scoring 22 points to go with seven boards in the Great Danes' win over UMBC on Thursday. Suero wrapped up his week by tallying a game-high 28 points at Stony Brook Sunday.



### ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Four McGlynn, Fr., G, Vermont

McGlynn led UVM to a 2-1 week by averaging 14.3 points and 3.3 rebounds and picked up his second Rookie of the Week honor of the season as a result. The freshman guard's best game of the week came in a win over Boston U. on Wednesday. McGlynn scored a 20 points and canned 4-of-7 three-point attempts. He then had 14 points and a career-high six rebounds in a win over Hartford on Sunday.

## ALBANY GREAT DANES

- The Great Danes shot 53 percent from three-point land (10-of-19) and improved to 3-1 in league play with a win over UNH Wednesday. The victory was their sixth in eight games.

- With the win, Albany improved to 6-0 at SEFCU Arena this season and has won nine straight there dating back to last season. The Great Danes can make it 10 straight when they host Maine Saturday.

- Logan Aronhalt scored a game-high 21 points and ranks fourth among league leaders in scoring (16.0 ppg). He is 35 points shy of 1,000 for his career.

- Gerardo Suero had his 20+ scoring streak stopped at nine but scored 17 points. He ranks fourth nationally averaging 22.5 points per game.

## BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

- Binghamton resumes play on Thursday and will try to snap a four-game losing streak against Vermont when they travel to Burlington.

- The Bearcats shot 37 percent at Boston U. Sunday and dropped their 15th straight game. The loss dropped Binghamton to 0-3 in the league standings for the first time in its America East history.

- Robert Mansell scored a game-high 21 points. The sophomore ranks eighth among the league's scoring leaders (14.3 ppg).

- Ben Dickinson had 12 points and eight rebounds and ranks 13th among America East scoring leaders (12.1 ppg) and eighth in rebounding (6.2 rpg).

- Darryl Partin scored 27 points, including the 1,000th of his career (844 at Boston U., 174 at La Salle), and ranks second among league leaders and 14th nationally averaging 20.2 ppg.

- D.J. Irving scored a career-high 23 points and added 11 assists for his first career double-double.

- Boston U. hosts Stony Brook in a rematch of last year's America East title game Saturday. The Terriers have won 13 straight games against league foes on their home court.

- Wes Cole, Yolonzo Moore II and Andres Torres each scored 11 points to lead the Hawks.

- Torres ranks 16th among league leaders averaging 11.6 points per game. He's upped his scoring in conference play, averaging 17.0 ppg in three conference games.

- Five of Hartford's top seven scorers are freshmen, who account for 64 percent of the team's scoring.

- Gerald McLemore scored a team-high 17 points. He's third in America East and 15th nationally averaging 20.2 points per game.

McLemore, Justin Edwards (15.2 ppg) and Alasdair Fraser (14.1) are second among trios scoring 49.5 ppg.

- The Black Bears, who return to action at Albany Saturday, are the league's top offensive team scoring 75.6 points per game and shooting 48 percent from the field.

- UMBC, which has a week off before traveling to Hartford on Jan. 17, has held the edge on glass in 11 of its 16 games this year.

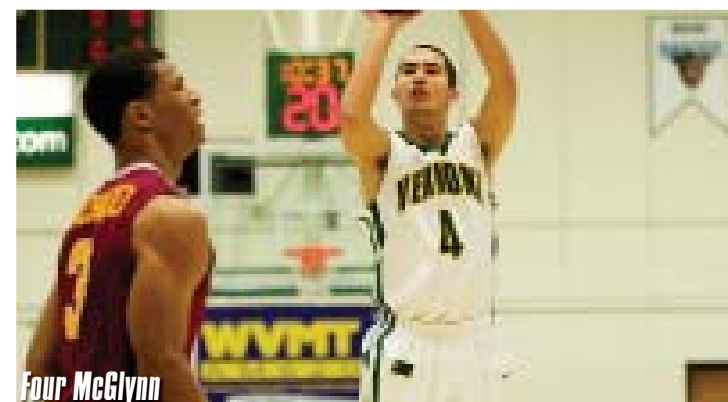
