AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Stony Brook, winner of seven of its last eight, sits tied atop the league standings at 5-1 with Boston U., winner of four straight, a half game back at 4-1. Finishing among the league's top two is crucial for teams with championship aspirations. Only twice in America East's 32 year history has a team finished outside the top two and gone on to win the league title (Delaware '99, Holy Cross '80).
- America East is the only Division I conference with three players ranked among the nation's top-25 scoring leaders. Albany's Gerardo Suero (21.6 ppg) is fourth in the country, while Boston University's Darryl Partin is 17th (19.8 ppg) and Maine's Gerald McLemore is 21st (19.6 ppg).
- There is a youth movement in America East. No teams regularly start more than two seniors while Albany and Binghamton are two of nine Division I programs without a senior on its roster. Additionally, four of the league's top 20 scorers are freshmen, led by Maine's Justin Edwards, who ranks fifth (15.7 ppg), and who is also seventh in rebounding (6.1 rpg). Binghamton's Ben Dickinson is 12th in scoring (12.4 ppg) and ninth in rebounding (6.0 rpg).

CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Mike Black, Jr., Guard, Albany

Black earned his second career Player of the Week award after leading Albany to a pair of wins last week and into a first-place tie with Stony Brook atop the league standings at 4-1. For the week, he averaged 16 points, nine rebounds, 3.5 assists and shot 50 percent (11-of-22).



CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK D.J. Irving, So., Guard, Boston U.

Irving picked up his second Player of the Week award of the season by leading Boston U. to wins over two teams that were previously unbeaten in league play. For the week, Irving averaged 17 points, eight assists and 2.5 rebounds and made 50 percent of his three-point tries.

Edwards netted his fifth Rookie of the Week honor of the year as he averaged 14.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists in a pair of games last week.


