AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Protecting home court has been important early on in conference play. The top five teams in the league standings: Stony Brook (6-1), Boston U. (5-1), Vermont (5-2), Albany (4-3) and Hartford (4-2) are a combined 15-1 at home during conference play.
- America East has two of the nation's top scorers in Albany's Gerardo Suero and Boston University's Darryl Partin. Suero (21.3 ppg) is fourth in the country while Boston University's Darryl Partin is 18th (19.8 ppg).
- There is a youth movement in America East. No teams regularly start more than two seniors while Albany and Binghamton are two of nine Division I programs without a senior on its roster and Hartford gets over 60 percent of its scoring from freshmen. Additionally, eight of the league's top 20 scorers are freshmen or sophomores, led by Maine's Justin Edwards, who ranks fifth (15.2 ppg), and who is also sixth in rebounding (6.2 rpg).

WEEKLY HONOREES



CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Mike Black, Jr., Guard, Albany

Black earned his second career Player of the Week award after leading Albany to a pair of wins last week and into a first-place tie with Stony Brook atop the league standings at 4-1. For the week, he averaged 16 points, nine rebounds, 3.5 assists and shot 50 percent (11-of-22).



CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK D.J. Irving, So., Guard, Boston U.

Irving picked up his second Player of the Week award of the season by leading Boston U. to wins over two teams that were previously unbeaten in league play. For the week, Irving averaged 17 points, eight assists and 2.5 rebounds and made 50 percent of his three-point tries.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Justin Edwards, Fr., Guard, Maine

Edwards netted his fifth Rookie of the Week honor of the year as he averaged 14.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists in a pair of games last week.

• Albany has the weekend off before facing Binghamton on Wednesday. The Great Danes swept last season's set from the Bearcats.

• Their last time out, the Great Danes shot committed 18 turnovers and fell at Vermont.

• Logan Aronhalt, the league's fourth-leading scorer (15.8 ppg), scored 12 points, including the 1,000th of his career.

• Albany, which leads the league in scoring (73.6 ppg), is 7-0 at home but just 5-9 on the road.

• Gerardo Suero ranks fourth nationally averaging 21.3 points per game.

• Ben Dickinson scored 16 points and added seven rebounds off the bench. The freshman is tied for 11th amongst the league's scoring leaders averaging 12.6 points per game and tied for seventh in rebounding (6.1 rpg).

• Sophomore Robert Mansell ranks sixth in the conference in scoring (14.6 ppg).

• The Terriers converted 23 UNH turnovers into 25 points en route to the win Thursday.

• Darryl Partin scored a game-high 20 points, his 10th 20-plus point game of the year. He ranks second in the league and 18th nationally with 19.8 ppg.

• The Terriers have a +9.8 margin of victory during their win streak while holding foes to just 55.8 points per game.

• It's last time out Thursday, Hartford shot a season-high 51 percent and held Maine to only 49 points en route to its fourth win in five games.

• The Hawks, who lead the conference averaging 7.1 steals per game, have surrendered just 53 points per game in its four conference wins.

• Andres Torres ranks 14th in scoring (12.1 ppg) and has upped his average to 15.2 ppg in league play.

• Five of the team's top seven scoring leaders. are freshmen, including Wes Cole (10.6 ppg).



MAINE BLACK BEARS

• Justin Edwards tallied 14 points, nine rebounds and seven assists. The five-time league Rookie of the Week ranks fifth among league leaders in scoring (15.2 ppg) and sixth in rebounding (6.2 rpg)

• After averaging 76.2 points through its first 13 games, the Black Bears are averaging just 61.8 points during their five-game losing skid.

• Maine leads the league in FG shooting (.462) and FG percentage defense (.419).

• Chase Plummer is one of just two players to rank in the league's top 10 in both scoring (8th - 13.5 ppg) and rebounding (5th - 7.3 rpg).

• Brian Neller ranks second in America East with 51 made 3-pointers (2.8 pg). He's sixth on UMBC's all-time list with 140 treys.

• Brian Benson continues to pace the league in rebounding, pulling down 8.9 boards per game.

• The Wildcats rank among the league's best defensive teams holding foes to 64 points per game, which is third, and 43 percent shooting.

• Stony Brook, which is 7-0 at home this season and won eight straight there overall, lead the league holding teams to 60.7 points per game, which ranks in the top 50 nationally.

• UVM is averaging 72.2 points per game in its 11 wins against just 58.1 per game in its 10 defeats.

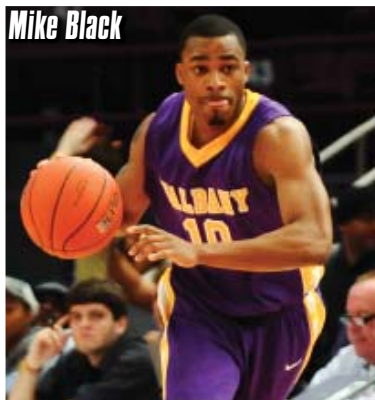
