## AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Protecting home court has been important early on in conference play. The top five teams in the league standings: Boston U. (7-1), Stony Brook (6-1), Vermont (6-2), Albany (4-3) and Hartford (4-3) are a combined 16-2 at home during conference play.
- America East has two of the nation's top scorers in Albany's Gerardo Suero and Boston University's Darryl Partin. Suero (21.3 ppg) is fourth in the country while Boston University's Darryl Partin is 16th (19.8 ppg).
- There is a youth movement in America East. No teams regularly start more than two seniors while Albany and Binghamton are two of nine Division I programs without a senior on its roster and Hartford gets over 60 percent of its scoring from freshmen. Additionally, eight of the league's top 20 scorers are freshmen or sophomores, led by Maine's Justin Edwards, who ranks fifth (15.2 ppg), and who is also sixth in rebounding (6.2 rpg).

## WEEKLY HONOREES



### CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Darryl Partin, Sr., Guard, Boston U.

Partin picked up his second Player of the Week honor of the season and third of his career after leading Boston U. to three wins last week by averaging a league-best 19 points per game. He also contributed 5.0 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game.



### CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Tommy Brenton, Jr., Forward, Stony Brook

Brenton earned his first career Player of the Week award after averaging a double-double and excelling defensively in Stony Brook's two wins last week. The junior forward contributed 11.0 points, 11.0 rebounds, 3.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists while shooting 88.9 percent from the field.



### ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Four McGlynn, Fr., Guard, Vermont

McGlynn is the America East Rookie of the Week for the third time after averaging 13.3 points per game off the bench in Vermont's three wins last week. McGlynn twice paced his team in scoring and added a pair of game-sealing free throws in his other game.

## ALBANY GREAT DANES

- Albany tries to rebound from its loss to Vermont on Jan. 19 when it hosts Binghamton on Wednesday. The Great Danes, who are averaging 84.8 points in league wins and just 64.7 points in its losses, swept last year's set from the Bearcats.

- Logan Aronhalt, the league's fourth-leading scorer (15.8 ppg), scored 12 points at UVM, including the 1,000th of his career.

- Albany, which leads the league in scoring (73.6 ppg), is 7-0 at home but just 5-9 on the road.

- Gerardo Suero ranks fourth nationally averaging 21.3 points per game.

## BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

- The Bearcats committed 17 turnovers and scored just 49 points in a loss to UNH Sunday.

- Sophomore Robert Mansell scored a game-high tying 19 points. He ranks sixth in the conference in scoring (14.6 ppg).

- Freshman Ben Dickinson is tied for 13th amongst the league's scoring leaders averaging 12.3 points per game and ninth in rebounding (5.9 rpg).

## BOSTON UNIVERSITY TERRIERS

- The Terriers, who moved into sole possession of first place in the America East standings with the win, have won seven straight overall by an average margin of 14.4 points while holding foes to just 53.3 points per game.

- Darryl Partin scored a game-high 17 points and ranks second in the league and 16th nationally averaging 19.8 points per game.

- The Terriers next face Stony Brook, which they have won five straight against.

- The Hawks, who lead the conference averaging 6.9 steals per game, have surrendered just 53 points per game in their four conference wins.

- Andres Torres scored 10 points and ranks 14th in scoring (12.0 ppg) and has upped average to 14.4 ppg in league play.

## MAINE BLACK BEARS

- Justin Edwards tallied 14 points, nine rebounds and seven assists. The five-time league Rookie of the Week ranks fifth among league leaders in scoring (15.2 ppg) and sixth in rebounding (6.2 rpg)

- After averaging 76.2 points through its first 13 games, the Black Bears are averaging just 61.8 points during their five-game losing skid.

- Maine leads the league in FG shooting (.462) and FG percentage defense (.419).

- Brian Neller is tied for the league lead with 54 made 3-pointers (2.7 pg) and is sixth on UMBC's all-time list with 143 treys.

- UMBC has a week off before heading to Albany on Feb. 1.
