AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Protecting home court has been an important ingredient to having success in conference play. The top four teams in the league standings: Boston U. (7-1), Stony Brook (7-1), Vermont (6-2), Albany (5-3) are a combined 16-0 at home against America East opponents.
- America East has two of the nation's top scorers in Albany's Gerardo Suero and Boston University's Darryl Partin. Suero (21.5 ppg) is fourth in the country while Boston University's Darryl Partin is 16th (19.8 ppg).
- There is a youth movement in America East. No teams regularly start more than two seniors while Albany and Binghamton are two of nine Division I programs without a senior on its roster and Hartford gets over 60 percent of its scoring from freshmen. Additionally, eight of the league's top 20 scorers are freshmen or sophomores, led by Maine's Justin Edwards, who ranks fifth (15.2 ppg), and who is also sixth in rebounding (6.4 rpg).

WEEKLY HONOREES



CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Darryl Partin, Sr., Guard, Boston U.

Partin picked up his second Player of the Week honor of the season and third of his career after leading Boston U. to three wins last week by averaging a league-best 19 points per game. He also contributed 5.0 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game.



CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Tommy Brenton, Jr., Forward, Stony Brook

Brenton earned his first career Player of the Week award after averaging a double-double and excelling defensively in Stony Brook's two wins last week. The junior forward contributed 11.0 points, 11.0 rebounds, 3.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists while shooting 88.9 percent from the field.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Four McGlynn, Fr., Guard, Vermont

McGlynn is the America East Rookie of the Week for the third time after averaging 13.3 points per game off the bench in Vermont's three wins last week. McGlynn twice paced his team in scoring and added a pair of game-sealing free throws in his other game.

ALBANY GREAT DANES

- Albany shot 57 percent after halftime to post a comeback win over Binghamton Wednesday.
- The win, Albany's sixth in its last nine games, extended its home court win streak to 11 games (8-0 this season).
- Gerardo Suero had his 15th 20-plus point outing of the year, pouring in 25 points against the Bearcats. He leads the league and ranks fourth nationally averaging 20.5 points per game.
- The Great Danes, who lead the league scoring 73.6 points per game, are averaging 82.6 points in league wins and just 64.7 points in losses.
- Albany resumes play at Hartford Saturday.

BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

- Binghamton scored 68 points, its most since tallying 74 on Nov. 12 vs. Colgate, and held a five-point lead midway through the second half at Albany Wednesday, but got outscored 29-18 the rest of the way en route to its 20th straight loss.
- Robert Mansell scored a team-high 22 points. He ranks sixth in the conference in scoring (15.0 ppg).
- Ben Dickinson added 21 points and eight rebounds. He's 12th amongst the league's scoring leaders (12.8 ppg) and ninth in rebounding (5.9 rpg).
- The Bearcats travel to Maine Saturday. Dickinson had 18 points and 10 rebounds in the two team's first meeting, a 76-61 Black Bear win on Jan. 2.

- Boston U. shot 50 percent and downed UMBC Tuesday, its 15th straight win at home against conference opponents.
- Darryl Partin scored a game-high 17 points and ranks second in the league and 16th nationally averaging 19.8 points per game.
- The Terriers, who are tied atop the America East standings with the Seawolves, have won seven straight overall by an average margin of 14.4 points while holding foes to just 53.3 points per game during the surge.

HARTFORD HAWKS

- Hartford, which has won three of its last five games, lead America East with 7.0 steals per game and has allowed just 53 points per game in its four conference wins.
- Andres Torres ranks 15th in scoring (11.8 ppg) and has upped average to 13.5 ppg in league play.
- Five of the team's top seven scoring leaders. are freshmen, including Wes Cole (10.3 ppg).
- Hartford hosts Albany Saturday. The Hawks have won five of their last seven vs. the Great Danes.

MAINE BLACK BEARS

- After scoring just seven points in his previous two games combined, Gerald McLemore poured in 25 against the Wildcats. He ranks third among league leaders averaging 18.1 points per game.
- Alasdair Fraser and Justin Edwards had double-double of 22 points and 10 rebounds and 14 points and 10 rebounds, respectively. Those two, along with McLemore, combine for 46.2 points per game, which ranks second to Albany's Gerardo Suero, Logan Aronhalt and Mike Black among trios.
- Maine leads the league in FG shooting (.465) and is second scoring 72.6 points per game.

- The Retrievers shot just 31 percent and fell at Boston U. their last time out Tuesday.
- Plummer scored a game-high tying 17 points and added nine rebounds. He is one of just two players to rank in the conference's top 10 in both scoring (7th - 14.0 ppg) and rebounding (4th - 7.5 rpg).
- Brian Neller ranks second among league leaders with 54 made 3-pointers (2.7 pg) and is sixth on UMBC's all-time list with 143 treys.

- The Seawolves lead America East and rank in the top 40 nationally allowing just 59.4 ppg and are surrendering just 54.4 ppg in their last nine wins.


