AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- League play continues with three games on Sunday. The Black Bears (2-0) Albany (2-0) and Stony Brook (2-0) are the lone remaining unbeaten teams. Finishing among the league's top two is crucial for teams with championship aspirations. Only twice in America East's 32 year history has a team finished outside the top two and gone on to win the league title (Delaware '99, Holy Cross '80).
- America East is the only Division I conference with three players ranked among the nation's top-20 scoring leaders. Albany's Gerardo Suero (22.1 ppg) is fourth in the country, while Maine's Gerald McLemore is tied for 11th (19.7 ppg) and Boston University's Darryl Partin is tied for 17th (20.0 ppg) and.
- There is a youth movement in America East. No teams regularly start more than two seniors while Albany and Binghamton are two of nine Division I programs without a senior on its roster. Additionally, four of the league's top 20 scorers are freshmen, led by Maine's Justin Edwards, who ranks fourth (15.6 ppg), and who is also seventh in rebounding (6.2 rpg). Binghamton's Ben Dickinson is 13th in scoring (12.1 ppg) and ninth in rebounding (6.1 rpg).

WEEKLY HONOREES



PLAYER OF THE WEEK Gerardo Suero, Jr., Guard, Albany

Suero put together a monster week, averaging 25 points, 8.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists in a pair of games, and earned his third Player of the Week honor of the season as a result. The junior guard single-handedly led Albany to a win at Mount St. Mary's on Saturday as he recorded his first career double-double (28 points, 10 rebounds) and with his team trailing by one, converted a three-point play with just 38 seconds left that proved to be the difference in the 65-64 victory. Suero also held his own against ACC competition, racking up 22 points, seven rebounds and eight assists in a loss at Maryland on Wednesday.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Wes Cole, Fr., Guard, Hartford

Cole provided a spark off the Hartford bench and picked up his second Rookie of the Week honor of the season as a result. The freshman guard contributed 13 points, six rebounds and two steals in 25 minutes of action in the Hawks' loss at La Salle Saturday. The sharpshooter, who ranks second in America East with 33 made three pointers, netted 4-of-5 tries from long range against the Explorers.

• The Great Danes go for their first 3-0 America East start since the 2005-06 season when they visit Stony Brook in a battle of 2-0 teams Sunday.

• Albany shot 56 percent and overcame a 14-point deficit by outscoring UMBC 80-49 over the final 33 minutes en route to its third straight win Thursday.

• Gerardo Suero, Logan Aronhalt and Mike Black, who all scored 22 points, are the league's top scoring trio averaging 50.5 ppg and rank first, fifth and 11th among league leaders, respectively. Suero ranks fourth nationally (22.1 ppg).

• Albany ranks second in the league in scoring (74.3 ppg) and is averaging 88.5 ppg in league play.

BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

• Robert Mansell scored a game-high 22 points. The sophomore ranks eighth among the league's scoring leaders (13.9 ppg).

• Ben Dickinson ranks 13th among America East scoring leaders (12.1 ppg) and ninth in rebounding (6.1 rpg).

• Andres Torres scored nearly half of Hartford's points, scoring a career-high 27. He leads the Hawks and ranks 16th among league leaders averaging 11.9 points per game.

• Five of Hartford's top seven scorers are freshmen, who account for 64 percent of the team's scoring.

MAINE BLACK BEARS

• Maine has won five of its last six overall and is a perfect 5-0 at home this season. The Black Bears' 2-0 league start is their first since 2004-05.

• Gerald McLemore went over the 20-point mark for the seventh time this year and scored a season-high 29 points on 9-of-15 shooting. He's tied for 11th nationally averaging 20.5 points per game.

• The Black Bears, who return to action Wednesday at home against Boston U., are the top offensive team in the league averaging 76.2 points per game.

UMBC RETRIEVERS

• Chase Plummer tallied 15 of his 17 points in the first half and is averaging 21.7 points and 6.0 rebounds through three league contests. Overall, he is one of just three players to rank in the league's top 10 in both scoring (6th - 14.6 ppg) and rebounding (5th - 7.8 rpg).

• UMBC, which next hosts Stony Brook on Wednesday, outrebounded Maine 34-31 and has held the edge on glass in 11 of its 15 games this year. The Retrievers are second in America East with a 1.4 rebound margin.
