## AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Stony Brook (17-7, 12-1 AE) and Vermont (16-10, 10-2 AE) are both riding long win streaks and sit in first and second place, respectively, in the league standings. The two teams meet on Sunday in a crucial contest. The Seawolves lock up a share of the regular-season title and the No. 1 seed for the tournament with a win while Vermont gains the inside track for the No. 1 seed with a win. SBU, UVM and Boston U. (14-13, 10-3 AE) will be the top three seeds for the league championship in some order.
- The top three teams in the league standings: Stony Brook (12-1), Vermont (10-2), Boston U. (10-3) are a combined 17-1 at home against league foes.
- America East has two of the nation's top scorers in Albany's Gerardo Suero and Boston University's Darryl Partin. Suero (21.7 ppg) is ranked fifth nationally while Boston University's Darryl Partin ranks 15th (19.9 ppg).
- Only twice in America East's 32 year history has a team finished outside the top two and gone on to win the league title. In addition, with the conference championship game being played at the highest remaining seed, hosting that game is crucial as the home team has won 25 of the previous 28 matchups.

## WEEKLY HONOREES



### CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Alasdair Fraser, So., Forward, Maine

Fraser tallied his league-best sixth double-double of the season and led Maine to its third straight win en route to earning Player of the Week honors for the second time this season. He racked up 21 points, 12 rebounds, four assists in three blocks in Maine's win at UMBC Saturday.



### CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Alvin Abreu, Sr., Guard, New Hampshire

Abreu earned his second career Player of the Week accolade after fueling New Hampshire's win over Hartford Wednesday. The senior scored 20 of the Wildcats' 52 points and hit a three-pointer with just 27 seconds left and the game tied at 49 to lift them to the win. He added 10 rebounds to collect his first career double-double.



### ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Justin Edwards, Fr., Guard, Maine

Edwards put forth a solid all-around effort in Maine's win at UMBC Saturday and earned his seventh Rookie of the Week award as a result, tying him for second most in league history. The freshman guard racked up 16 points, seven rebounds, six assists and three steals in the win.

## ALBANY GREAT DANES

- Albany converted 18 Maine turnovers into 22 points and snapped its three game losing skid on Saturday.

- Gerardo Suero tallied his 20th 20-point scoring outing and finished with 28 points. He ranks fifth nationally averaging 22.0 points per game.

- As a team, Albany leads the league with 604 free throw attempts and is shooting a conference-best 74.7 percent from the line.

- Albany hosts Vermont on Wednesday and can clinch the No. 4 seed for the America East Championship with a win.

## BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

- The Bearcats, who lead America East in attendance averaging 2,771 per game at the Events Center, travel to Hartford for their first action since Feb. 4 on Saturday.

- In its last game, Binghamton allowed Boston U. to shoot 50 percent from the floor and dropped to 0-23 on the season.

- Robert Mansell scored a team-high tying 13 points for the Bearcats. He ranks seventh among league leaders averaging 14.7 points per game and has upped that average to 16.1 ppg in league games.

- Ben Dickinson also scored 13 and ranks 13th among the league's top scorers (12.6 ppg) and is eighth in rebounding (6.8 rpg).

## BOSTON UNIVERSITY TERRIERS

- Darryl Partin scored 14 points and ranks second among league leaders and 15th nationally in scoring (19.8 ppg).

- Boston U., which ranks second in America East allowing only 59.6 points per game in conference play, goes for a season sweep of UNH at Case Gym on Wednesday.

- Overall, five of the team's top seven scoring leaders are freshmen, who contribute 61 percent of the team's scoring output.

- Hartford's leading scorer, Andres Torres (11.8 ppg), is four assists shy of 300 for his career.

- Chase Plummer led UMBC with 18 points and nine rebounds. He's the only player to rank in the league's top 10 in both scoring (4th - 15.2 ppg) and rebounding (5th - 7.5 rpg).

- Brian Neller ranks second in the league with 66 made three-pointers (2.8 ppg)
