AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Vermont's loss, paired with Stony Brook's win over Hartford, gave the Sea-wolves (19-8, 13-2 AE) a one-game lead over the Catamounts (19-11, 12-3 AE) in the league standings. With a win over Maine Sunday, SBU would clinch the regular-season title, the No. 1 seed for the league championship and an NIT bid should it not make the NCAA tournament.
- America East teams went 5-4 in BracketBusters games last weekend. It's the third time in five years the league has had a winning record in the event.
- America East has two of the nation's top scorers in Albany's Gerardo Suero and Boston University's Darryl Partin. Suero (21.7 ppg) is ranked fifth nationally while Boston University's Darryl Partin ranks 21st (19.7 ppg).
- Only twice in America East's 32 year history has a team finished outside the top two and gone on to win the league title. In addition, with the conference championship game being played at the highest remaining seed, hosting that game is crucial as the home team has won 25 of the previous 28 matchups.

WEEKLY HONOREES



PLAYER OF THE WEEK Ferg Myrick, So., Forward, UNH

Myrick earned his first career Player of the Week honor by averaging 17.0 points and 4.5 rebounds in leading New Hampshire to a pair of wins last week. He began his week by scoring 15 points, including 13 in the first half, and adding three rebounds in a key 56-54 win at Boston University on Wednesday. On Saturday, Myrick scored a team-high tying 19 points, which also equaled his season high, and added six rebounds in a 72-58, win over Towson.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Mark Nwakamma, Fr., Forward, Hartford

Nwakamma had his best week of the season, averaging 16.0 points and shooting 82 percent (14-of-17) from the field in two Hartford wins en route to earning his first Rookie of the Week honor of the year. The freshman forward started his week by scoring 14 points on 6-of-8 shooting to go with four rebounds and three assists in a 64-50 win over Maine. He then had a career-high tying 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting in a 67-51 win at St. Peter's Saturday.
