AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Five of the nine seeds for the 2012 America East Men's Basketball Championship will be decided on the final day of the season.
- With a win over Maine, Stony Brook will claim its second regular-season title in three years, the No. 1 seed for the tournament and an automatic NIT bid should it not reach the NCAAs.
- Should Stony Brook lose, Vermont would earn a share of the regular-season crown and the No. 1 seed as it holds the tiebreaker over the Seawolves.
- Hartford, New Hampshire and Maine will be seeded fifth through seventh. Should the Wildcats beat Binghamton today and the Black Bears lose to Stony Brook, UNH would be No. 5, Hartford No. 6 and Maine No. 7. If Maine wins, it will be No. 6 regardless of what UNH does and Hartford will be No. 5 while UNH will be No. 7. The Hawks hold the three-way tiebreak.
- America East teams went 5-4 in BracketBusters games last weekend. It's the third time in five years the league has had a winning record in the event.

WEEKLY HONOREES



PLAYER OF THE WEEK Ferg Myrick, So., Forward, UNH

Myrick earned his first career Player of the Week honor by averaging 17.0 points and 4.5 rebounds in leading New Hampshire to a pair of wins last week. He began his week by scoring 15 points, including 13 in the first half, and adding three rebounds in a key 56-54 win at Boston University on Wednesday. On Saturday, Myrick scored a team-high tying 19 points, which also equaled his season high, and added six rebounds in a 72-58, win over Towson.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Mark Nwakamma, Fr., Forward, Hartford

Nwakamma had his best week of the season, averaging 16.0 points and shooting 82 percent (14-of-17) from the field in two Hartford wins en route to earning his first Rookie of the Week honor of the year. The freshman forward started his week by scoring 14 points on 6-of-8 shooting to go with four rebounds and three assists in a 64-50 win over Maine. He then had a career-high tying 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting in a 67-51 win at St. Peter's Saturday.
