AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Protecting home court has been an important ingredient to having success in conference play. The top four teams in the league standings: Stony Brook (9-1), Vermont (8-2), Albany (7-3) and Boston U. (7-3) are a combined 20-1 at home, Vermont at New Hampshire opponents with the Terriers suffering the only defeat among the four at the hands of the Catamounts Wednesday.
- America East has two of the nation's top scorers in Albany's Gerardo Suero and Boston University's Darryl Partin. Suero (21.1 ppg) is tied for sixth in the country while Boston University's Darryl Partin ranks 15th (19.8 ppg).
- While the team that wins the conference tournament gets crowned league champion and receives the league's NCAA berth, where teams finish in the regular season goes a long way in determining the league champion. Only twice in America East's 32 year history has a team finished outside the top two and gone on to win the league title. In addition, with the conference championship game being played at the highest remaining seed, hosting that game is crucial as the home team has won 25 of the previous 28 matchups.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK Bryan Dougher, Sr., Guard, Stony Brook

Dougher propelled his team into first place in the America East standings by averaging 21.5 points and shooting 57 percent from the field in two Stony Brook wins last week. The Player of the Week award is his first of the year and second of his career.



CO-ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Justin Edwards, Fr., Guard, Maine

Edwards averaged 16.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in a pair of Black Bear wins to claim his sixth Rookie of the Week honor of the season. His six awards are tied for the fourth-most any rookie has won in America East history. (8-of-9) last week.



CO-ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Four McGlynn, Fr., Guard, Vermont

McGlynn earned his second Rookie of the Week honor in as many weeks and fourth of the season by leading Vermont to a 77-60 win over New Hampshire on Sunday. The freshman scored 20 points on 5-of-10 shooting off the bench.
