AMERICA EAST NEED TO KNOW

- Stony Brook (16-7, 11-1 AE) and Vermont (16-10, 10-2 AE) are both riding seven game win streaks and sit in first and second place, respectively in the league standings.
- Protecting home court has been an important ingredient to having success in conference play. The top four teams in the league standings: Stony Brook (11-1), Vermont (10-2), Boston U. (9-3) Albany (7-5) are a combined 21-3 at home against America East opponents.
- America East has two of the nation's top scorers in Albany's Gerardo Suero and Boston University's Darryl Partin. Suero (21.8 ppg) is ranked fifth nationally while Boston University's Darryl Partin ranks 14th (20.1 ppg).
- While the team that wins the conference tournament gets crowned league champion and receives the league's NCAA berth, where teams finish in the regular season goes a long way in determining the league champion. Only twice in America East's 32 year history has a team finished outside the top two and gone on to win the league title. In addition, with the conference championship game being played at the highest remaining seed, hosting that game is crucial as the home team has won 25 of the previous 28 matchups.

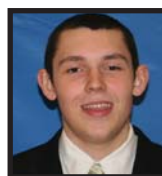

CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Alasdair Fraser, So., Forward, Maine

Fraser tallied his league-best sixth double-double of the season and led Maine to its third straight win en route to earning Player of the Week honors for the second time this season. He racked up 21 points, 12 rebounds, four assists in three blocks in Maine's win at UMBC Saturday.



CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK Alvin Abreu, Sr., Guard, New Hampshire

Abreu earned his second career Player of the Week accolade after fueling New Hampshire's win over Hartford Wednesday. The senior scored 20 of the Wildcats' 52 points and hit a three-pointer with just 27 seconds left and the game tied at 49 to lift them to the win. He added 10 rebounds to collect his first career double-double.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK Justin Edwards, Fr., Guard, Maine

Edwards put forth a solid all-around effort in Maine's win at UMBC Saturday and earned his seventh Rookie of the Week award as a result, tying him for second most in league history. The freshman guard racked up 16 points, seven rebounds, six assists and three steals in the win.

• Albany, which leads America East scoring 74.0 ppg, tries to snap a two-game losing skid when it visits UNH Thursday. Albany won the first matchup 86-63 on Jan. 11.

• Their last time out, the Great Danes lost a 17-point lead by allowing Boston U. to shoot 56 percent in the second half and fell for just the second time at home this year.

• Gerardo Suero, scored 28 points and leads America East and ranks fifth nationally in scoring (21.8 ppg).

• As a team, Albany leads the league with 569 free throw attempts and is shooting a conference-best 75.0 percent from the line.



BINGHAMTON BEARCATS

• The Bearcats, who lead America East in attendance averaging 2,771 per game at the Events Center, have a week off before returning to action at Hartford on Feb. 12.

• In its last game, Binghamton allowed Boston U. to shoot 50 percent from the floor and dropped to 0-23 on the season.

• Robert Mansell scored a team-high tying 13 points for the Bearcats. He ranks seventh among league leaders averaging 14.7 points per game and has upped that average to 16.1 ppg in league games.

• Ben Dickinson also scored 13 and ranks 13th among the league's top scorers (12.6 ppg) and is eighth in rebounding (6.8 rpg).

• Boston U. goes for its third straight win when Maine visits Case Gym Thursday. With a win, which would be the Terriers' seventh in nine games against the Black Bears, Boston U. is guaranteed to finish no worse than fourth in the league standings.

• On Monday, the Terriers came back from a 17-point deficit by shooting 57 percent after half-time and beat Albany for its second straight win.

• Darryl Partin scored an America East season-high 33 points and ranks second among league leaders and 14th nationally in scoring (20.1 ppg).

• Boston U. ranks second in America East allowing only 60.1 points per game in conference play and are fourth scoring 68.2 ppg.



HARTFORD HAWKS

• Hartford shot a season-high 52 percent en route to its fifth league win of the season at UMBC Tuesday. The Hawks sit just a half game behind Maine for fifth place in the league standings.

• Nate Sikma led the Hawks with 20 points, seven rebounds and five assists. He's one of three Hartford freshmen (Wes Cole, Mark Nwakamma) averaging over 8.0 points per game.

• Overall, five of the team's top seven scoring leaders are freshmen, who contribute 61 percent of the team's scoring output.

• Hartford's leading scorer, Andres Torres (11.8 ppg), is four assists shy of 300 for his career.



MAINE BLACK BEARS

• Maine, winner of three of its last four, visits Boston U. on Thursday. The Black Bears have not been swept by the Terriers since the 2008-09 season.

• In their last game Monday, the Black Bears committed 16 turnovers which turned into 21 Vermont points and their three-game win streak snapped.

• Maine played without Alasdair Fraser, who ranks 10th in scoring (10.2 ppg) and 3rd in rebounding (7.8 rpg).

• Gerald McLemore, the league's third-leading scorer (18.1 ppg), scored 20 points, his 10th 20-plus point scoring outing of the year.

• Maine leads the league in both FG percentage (.459) and FG percentage defense (.413).

• Chase Plummer had a night to remember, scoring a career-best 28 points on 11-of-14 shooting. He's one of just two players to rank in the league's top 10 in both scoring (6th - 15.1 ppg) and rebounding (5th - 7.5 rpg).

• Brian Neller added 14 points and sank four three-pointers. He ranks second in the league with 63 made three-pointers.

• Alvin Abreu, the league's Co-Player of the Week, scored a game-high 19 points. He ranks ninth among league leaders in scoring (13.5 ppg).

• UNH ranks among the league's best defensive teams, holding foes to 63.7 ppg, which ranks third in the league.

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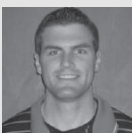
