Maine Head Coach Richard Barron, opening remarks:

"I'd like to thank Hartford and Newman's Own and the job that everyone does putting on this tournament. And I'm very happy for Maine fans to see us get out of the play-in game for the first time since 2006. Tough game. Stony Brook is very feisty and well coached. We got very fortunate down the stretch. Very happy for our team, we were able to double last season's win total and we can use that progress looking forward."

Barron on the second half

Stony Brook did a very good job making us pay for our mistakes for most of the second half. Whitney Davis hit some shots and made us pay. They did a really good job taking advantage of our defensive hiccups. One thing we did much better in the second half was rebound. I was disappointed in our rebounding effort in the first half but I thought rebounding was in our favor in the second half."

Maine forward Samantha Baranowski on the program's first tournament win since 2006:

"It's exciting, as coach said, for the first time in a while to get out of the play-in game. We are excited for tomorrow now."
