Head Coach Matt Senk

Opening statement:

“The first thing I’d like to do is apologize to Coach Morris and his fine Miami team for the miscommunication that took place in the eighth inning and clearly I felt compelled to take action right away and pull that player so that...uh...anyway...feel badly about that. But, it doesn’t take away from an outstanding effort from our players. We did what we always try to do and that is to pitch and play defense and we played errorless. Our pitchers came in there and did a terrific job and our guys scored first and we answered back and did a lot of really, really terrific things tonight that allow you to beat an outstanding team like Miami. So, time is certainly the crooked numbers later in the game that was due to some timely hitting and we played a really solid game tonight and obviously were very pleased to starting off this tournament off with a win and being in the winner’s bracket”

On playing UCF tomorrow:
