**New Hampshire coach Maureen Magarity's opening remarks:**

You know what I am just so proud of these young ladies, it was just a great game, and they had a great comeback in the second half. But what can I say about this team, it has been a little disappointing year, but we all had a good feeling going into this tournament and like I always say when you have Kelsey Hogan on your team with a ball in her hands at the last couple of seconds of the game, usually good things happen so I am just so proud of this team.

**New Hampshire's Kelsey Hogan on the game-winning shot:**

We actually did practice that play at practice the other day, I think the same thing happened, Ariel [Gaston]'s pass was a little off, I lost it a little bit then I got it back and it looked like coach Magarity says, "Okay three seconds you have to go," and I just did the best shot I could at that point. We are going to give Albany a good fight for sure, we are ready, we are excited and we want that one more than anything.

**New Hampshire's Morgan Frame on the comeback and getting Albany for the next game:**

We had some strong takes, we just knew we have to keep playing hard and coach always says we have to win by ourselves and we stayed really strong and came out with a win. We were really excited for being in their [Albany] bracket. We know they are a great team, but we played them at home and we were up by 12 at the first half. So if we can play strong for the whole game, we are going to do great against them. We are really excited to play them.

**Coach Magarity on the overall game and facing Albany:**
