

America East Semifinals No. 2 Stony Brook 69, No. 3 Hartford 64 Postgame Notes

- Second-seeded Stony Brook advances to its third America East title game, all which have come since 2011.
- The Seawolves will host fourth-seeded Albany in the America East Championship game on Saturday, March 15 at Pritchard Gym at 11:30 a.m.
- The Seawolves improve to 23-9 and have won 14 of its last 17 games.
- The finals trip is the 24th for a No. 2 seed and 16th in the last 19 years.
- The win was Steve Pikiell's ninth tournament victory, moving him into a seventh-place tie on the all-time list.
- Stony Brook improves to 12-12 all time in tournament play while Hartford fell to 18-27.
- The win was the Seawolves' eighth in the tournament over the last five years after they totaled just four victories in its first eight tournaments.
- The Seawolves shot 56 percent from the field, including 64 percent in the second half.
- Carson Puriefoy scored a game-high 21 points for Stony Brook.
- Corban Wroe scored a career-high 21 for Hartford.
