Albany's Coach Will Brown opening statement:

I am proud of my guys. I am the one coach in this league who is dumb enough to have wanted Vermont. We wanted this game. I have a tremendous amount of respect for their program. I am proud of my guys. They executed the game plan to a T. We talked about doing a great job on their perimeter guys, doing a great job on the glass, and making them defend. We watched so much film and we missed so many opportunities during the regular season when we played them. We did a very good job sharing the ball offensively, and we were very unselfish on both ends of the floor.
