



**America East Quarterfinals  
No. 5 Hartford 63, No. 4 Maine 62 (OT)  
Postgame Notes**

- Hartford advances to its ninth semifinal in ten years notched its 26th overall tournament win.
- Hartford head coach Jennifer Rizzotti won her 24th tournament game, the most in America East history.
- There were no lead changes first 26-plus minutes of the game. There were eight ties and eight lead changes over the rest of the game including four lead changes in overtime.
- Hartford has won three-straight America East tournament games over the Black Bears.
- Maine broke the America East single-season 3-point record by making nine tonight, giving them 231 for the season. The former record was 223 hit by UMBC in 2007-08.
- Maine tied an America East tournament record with 32 3-point attempts in the game.
- In the three meetings this season between the Hawks and Black Bears, two went to OT (both won by Hartford) and one was decided by four points (won by Maine)
- Maine took 18 3-pointers in the first half, the 3rd most taken in a half in an America East tournament game.
- The last OT game in the America East Championship was in the 2009 quarterfinals when No. 1 Boston U. beat No. 8 Albany, 77-75, in Hartford.
