

## America East Quarterfinals No. 2 Stony Brook 61, No. 7 UMBC 49 Postgame Notes

- Stony Brook advances to the semifinals for the first time since 2010.
- The No. 2 seed is now 40-24 in America East tournament play and has advanced to the semifinals in five-straight years.
- The Seawolves improve to 7-12 in the tournament and will make their fourth semifinal appearance.
- The win was the first for Sony Brook over UMBC in championship play and the Seawolves now lead the all-time series, 13-12.
- Stony Brook extends its winning streak to eight.
- The Seawolves have a Division I record 23 wins and are one win shy of tying the all-time program record for wins.
- After trailing, 7-5, at the 15:29 mark of the first half, Stony Brook scored 20-straight over the next 10:16.
- Jessica Ogunnorin scored in double figures for the sixth-straight game for Stony Brook.
- UMBC falls to 6-10 in the America East tournament.
- America East Rookie of the Year, UMBC's Sara Tarbert, scored in double figures for the 13th-straight game and the 22nd time this season.
- Tarbert also recorded her sixth double-double of the season.
