



**America East Quarterfinals
No. 4 Albany 86, No. 5 UMBC 56
Postgame Notes**

- Albany improves to 17-15 overall and 10-3 at home this season with the win and advances to the championship semifinals for the third-straight year and sixth time overall.
- UMBC ends its season 9-21 after surpassing its previous season win total for the second-straight year.
- Albany improves to 12-9 all time in championship play while UMBC falls to 9-10.
- The win was Albany's second in three tournament games vs. UMBC and its 10th in the last 11 games in the series overall.
- Will Brown improved to 12-9 all time in tournament play, the 12 wins ranking as the sixth-most in league history.
- Albany shot 56.1 percent from the floor.
- The Great Danes dominated the paint, outscoring the Retrievers, 40-18, in the key.
- Peter Hooley scored a career-high 30 points on 12-of-16 shooting.
- It's the first 30-point effort in the tournament by an America East player since Greer Wright (31) and Moussa Camara (30) each hit the mark in the first round of the 2011 tournament.
- Quentin Jones scored a career-high 18 points for UMBC.
- Albany will play #1 Vermont in the first men's semifinal, rematch of last year's championship game, Sunday at 5 p.m. at SEFCU Arena.
