



**America East Quarterfinals
No. 2 Stony Brook 80, No. 7 Maine 54
Postgame Notes**

- Stony Brook improves to 22-9 overall and advances the semifinals for the fifth-straight year.
- The win was Stony Brook's second in three tournament games against Maine and ninth in a row over the Black Bears overall.
- Stony Brook improves to 11-12 all time in tournament play while Maine, winless in its last 10 tournament games, fell to 16-34.
- The win was the Seawolves' seventh in the tournament over the last five years after they totaled just four victories in its first eight tournaments.
- No. 2 seeds are now 28-1 all time against No. 7 seeds.
- The Seawolves held Maine, the league's top-scoring team to 19 points below its season average and a season-low 30 percent shooting percentage from the field.
- America East Player of the Year Jameel Warney led the Seawolves with 15 points, eight rebounds and four blocks.
- Xavier Pollard led Maine with 11 points.
- Stony Brook will play the winner of #3 Hartford and #6 Binghamton in the second men's semifinal Sunday at 7:15 p.m. at SEFCU Arena.
