No. 3 Hartford 69, No. 6 Binghamton 42 Postgame Notes

- Hartford improves to 17-15 overall overall and advances the semifinals for the third time in the last four years and 13th time overall.
- The win is Hartford's seventh in its last eight games and its seventh straight over Binghamton.
- Hartford improves to 18-26 all time in tournament play while Binghamton falls to 7-9.
- The win snaps a six-game losing skid for No. 3 seeds and was just the second win for a No. 3 in the last 11 years.
- The Hawks opened a 17-3 lead to start the game, hitting 7 of their first 11 shots.
- Hartford shot 52.2 percent from the field as a team while holding Binghamton to 28.6 percent and 42 points, the fewest in a quarterfinal game.
- Mark Nwakamma led the Hartford with 19 points, five rebounds and a career-high six blocks, which ties for the fifth most in tournament history.
- Yosef Yacob's 10 points led Binghamton, which ends its season 7-23.
- Hartford will play #2 Stony Brook in the second men's semifinal Sunday at 7:15 p.m. at SEFCU Arena.
- It is the first time since 1999 the top four seeds reached the semifinals.
