



**America East Semifinals  
No. 1 Albany 65, No. 5 Hartford 51  
Postgame Notes**

- The Great Danes move into their third-straight America East title game.
- The No. 1 seed advances to the title game for the 24th time in 29 appearances (note: there was no No. 1 seed in 1994), and improves to 61-11 overall in the America East tournament.
- Albany won its seventh-straight tournament game and improves to 7-1 in the America East Championship under head coach Katie Abrahamson-Henderson
- The Great Danes have won six-straight over the Hawks, including the last two meetings in the tournament (2013 title game).
- Albany improved to 6-0 in the tournament against the No. 5 seed.
- The No. 1 seed has defeated the No. 5 seed six times in eight semifinal meetings
- Albany went on a 15-3 run over the final 7:55 of the first half, holding Hartford to 1-12 shooting and forcing three turnovers.
- Hartford set the record for most 3-point field goal attempts in a semifinal with 29
- Hartford junior Amber Bepko averaged 18.5 ppg in the tournament, scoring 21 vs. Albany and 16 vs. Maine.
- Albany's Sarah Royals has 16 assists over the first two tournament games. The tournament record is 24 set by Maine's Amy Vachon in 1999.
- The Great Danes finished with a 42-12 advantage in the paint.
