

America East Semifinals No. 2 Stony Brook 79, No. 3 New Hampshire 59 Postgame Notes

- The Seawolves advance to their second America East title game in program history. The first appearance came in Stony Brook's first season in the league back in 2002.
- The top-two seeds will play in the title game for the 14th time and the second-straight year. It is just the third time since 2000 that the top-two seeds have advanced to the finals (2010, 2013, 2014).
- The No. 2 seed has advanced to five-straight America East title games. Two of those teams took home the crown (2012 Albany & 2010 Vermont)
- New Hampshire was denied its first title game appearance while playing in its 14th semifinal.
- Stony Brook ties a program record with 24 wins this season (1985-86). The Seawolves had already broken the program Divsion I record of 20 wins set back in 2005-06.
- The Seawolves are 20-0 this season when leading with five minutes to go in the game.
