In the NCAAs

America East is 10-22 all-time in NCAA tournament play. In fact, America East is the only automatic-qualifying Division I conference to have three different programs reach the NCAA quarterfinal round in that span. Albany and UMBC won first-round contests, over Loyola and Maryland, respectively, in 2007, and Stony Brook defeated Denver in the first round in 2010. America East also had a Final Four team in 1999, when Towson achieved the feat.
