### #BEWBB NOTES

#### 10 STRAIGHT FROM 'NOVA

The Wildcats are on a 10-game winning streak, their longest since the 2003-04 season. Jasmine Bascoe leads the Wildcats, averaging 17.3 points and 4.4 assists per game. The sophomore has recorded five 20-point games this season, including a 30-point performance in November. The team is averaging 19.6 assists per game, ranking 13th in the nation. Villanova is the second-best defensive team in the BIG EAST, allowing 58.8 points per game while opponents shoot just .372 from the field. The Wildcats face Marquette on the road on Sunday, January 4, live on Peacock.

#### VALENZUELA, QUIÑONEZ SPLIT WEEKLY LAURELS

Seton Hall graduate student forward Mariana Valenzuela averaged 19.5 points on .636 shooting in a 2-0 week against Creighton and Xavier, earning her the BIG EAST Player of the Week honor. At Creighton, she scored a team-high 23 points on 8-for-12 shooting, including 4-for-5 from three-point range, along with six rebounds, helping Seton Hall secure its first victory in Omaha in 10 years. UConn forward Blanca Quiñonez nabbed her third straight weekly honor as freshman of the week. Quiñonez scored 12 points on 5-for-7 shooting in the 94-47 win at Butler. She added three rebounds and three steals.

#### BIG EAST TO PROVIDE PUBLIC AVAILABILITY REPORTS FOR MEN'S AND WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Beginning in 2025-26, the BIG EAST Conference will provide public reports on the availability of student-athletes in conference games in the sports of men's and women's basketball. BIG EAST schools will be required to submit availability reports three hours before the scheduled tipoff time. Under the reporting structure, players will be designated as "questionable" or "out." Availability reports will be posted on the BIG EAST website throughout the 2025-26 season.

## NEWS & NOTES

### AROUND THE BIG EAST

- The BIG EAST is 6-3 against top 25 teams this season.

#### Butler

- They have forced their opponents to commit double-digit turnovers in 15 of the last 17 games.

- Lily Zeinstra leads the Butler offense, averaging 10.3 points per game. She is shooting 46.2 percent from the floor and 35.8 percent from beyond the arc.

- The Bulldogs had six players score in double figures against Dayton on Nov. 28 to mark the first time Butler has had six players in double figures in the last 15 seasons.

#### UConn

- With a 15-0 record, UConn is off to their best start since the 2017-18 season.

- UConn is 4-0 against nationally ranked teams this season. The Huskies are on a 44-game winning streak in BIG EAST regular-season play.

- Sarah Strong leads the Huskies, averaging 18 points, 8.1 rebounds, 4.5 assists, 3.5 steals, and 1.6 blocks per game.

- Azzi Fudd scored a season-high 31 points in win vs. #6 Michigan. She has a .493/.485/1.000 shooting split this season.

#### Creighton

- Neleigh Gessert is third in the NCAA with 48 made 3-pointers.
- Kiani Lockett delivered a career-high 25 points to lift Creighton to the road W at Drake.
- The Bluejays have recorded nine games of 10+ made treys this season.

#### DePaul

- Kate Novik has reached double figures in 11 of 15 games played this season while Michelle Ojo has scored double figures four times.

- Novik recorded her first career triple-double with 12 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists, for the eighth triple-double in program history in win vs. UMass Lowell.

- The win over Grambling State marked the first time since 2023 that DePaul held an opponent to under 40 points in a game.

#### Georgetown

- Khia Miller leads GU this season with 10.9 ppg followed by Victoria Rivera (9.4 ppg).

- Against Towson, they set a new program record with 14 3-pointers in the contest.

- Head coach Darnell Haney recorded his 100th career victory against Sacred Heart.

#### Marquette

- Halle Vice has had three consecutive double-double performances.

- Marquette made 11 3-pointers against Winthrop for the most treys made in a game since 2023.

- The Golden Eagles rank sixth in the country with a 39.2 three-point percentage.

- Cara Consuegra recorded her 250th career victory against Milwaukee.

#### Providence

- Sabou Gueye leads the team in scoring, averaging 13.9 points and shoots a team-best 50.3-percent from the field (85-169) and 75.5-percent from the foul line (37-49).

- Third in the BIG EAST in scoring defense (59.7) and field-goal percentage defense (.380).

- As a team, PC grabbed 55 rebounds against CCSU, the most since 2013.

- One of five teams in NCAA Division I that will face the Huskies and Gamecocks this season.

#### St. John's

- With 13 assists vs. Georgia Tech, Shaulana Wagner became the first St. John's player to record double-digit assists since Tiana England (10) against Seton Hall on Feb. 22, 2020.

- The win over #18 Oklahoma State marked the team's highest-ranked victory since 2023. The last-ranked non-conference victory was in 2015 when they beat South Florida.

#### Seton Hall

- They have had a lead at the half in 12 games this season. Seton Hall's victory over Saint Peter's was the 800th in program history.

- Savannah Catalan has recorded at least three steals in 13 games this season. She had a season-high seven steals in the 81-36 win at Georgetown on New Years Eve.

#### Villanova

- Jasmine Bascoe and Brynn McCurry totaled 45 of Villanova's 81 points in the team's upset win at #25 West Virginia.

- Named 2025 Big 5 Women's Classic Champions after defeating St. Joseph's in December.

#### Xavier

- Had a season-high 13 steals vs. Marquette, the 12th time the Musketeers have posted 10 or more steals in a game over the last two seasons.

- The Musketeers defeated Cincinnati 77-70 to be named Skyline Chili Crosstown

#### Shootout Champions.

- Meri Kanerva is averaging 5.2 assists per game in BIG EAST only games, ranking third in the conference.

### 2024-25 SEASON REVIEW

- UConn earned its 12th national title, defeating South Carolina in the 2025 National Championship game

- UConn won its 24th regular-season title and 23rd BIG EAST Tournament crown in 2024-25

- Creighton also earned an NCAA Tournament berth

- The BIG EAST saw three earn bids into the Women's Basketball invitation Tournament (WBIT), with Marquette, Seton Hall and Villanova all securing national postseason berths to the 32-team event. Butler reached the Super 16 of the WNIT

- Azzi Fudd (UConn) was named the NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player, a BIG EAST All-Tournament team member and an All-BIG EAST First Team honoree

- UConn's Sarah Strong is the NCAA record holder for most points in an NCAA Tournament by a freshman (114)

- Seton Hall's Jada Eads became the program's first freshman to be named to the All-BIG EAST First Team

- Villanova's Jasmine Bascoe set the Villanova freshman record for steals in a season (66)

- Marquette's Lee Volker shot a career-best 41.5 percent (44-of-106) from the 3-point line, the third-highest percentage by a senior or graduate student in program history

- Xavier's Meri Kanerva's 346 total points ranked sixth in single-season school history by a freshman.

- UConn had the No. 1 WNBA Draft Pick in Paige Bueckers, to become the sixth top pick in program history. Teammates Kaitlyn Chen and Aubrey Griffin were both drafted in the third round

### 2025-26 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TV DETAILS

The upcoming season marks the first year of a six-year media agreement, which will span from 2025-26 through 2030-31, encompassing coverage on FOX Sports (FOX, FS1), NBC Sports (NBC, Peacock), and TNT Sports (TNT, TBS and truTV). The agreement will provide comprehensive national broadcast, cable, and direct-to-consumer streaming coverage of BIG EAST women's and men's basketball games. ESPN+ will also stream a minimum of 75 women's basketball games. Below is a breakdown by network:

#### FOX /FS1

•FOX will air four games while FS1 will show 13 games in 2025-26 to mark the fifth straight year BIG EAST women's basketball will be featured on the broadcast network.

#### NBC SPORTS/PEACOCK

•Peacock will stream 25 women's games, including all 10 of the conference's women's basketball tournament games. The 2026 BIG EAST Women's Basketball Tournament presented by JEEP will take place from Friday, March 6 to Monday, March 9 at Mohegan Sun.

#### TNT SPORTS

• TNT Sports will feature 15 regular season women's basketball games, including 14 league-play matchups, split across TNT and truTV throughout the 2025-26 season. All TNT Sports games will also stream on HBO Max.

#### ESPN+

• This past July, the BIG EAST and ESPN agreed upon a six-year digital media rights agreement, adding hundreds of live BIG EAST events to ESPN's robust college sports portfolio. For the 2025-26 season, 127 women's basketball games, including 73 conference games will appear on ESPN+.

### BIG EAST ROAD TRIP RETURNS

The "BIG EAST Road Trip presented by AlumniFi" is set to deliver another round of interactive experiences, traveling to each city for men's and women's basketball matchups and concluding at the men's and women's conference tournaments in March. The tour will feature two hours of pre-game entertainment and activities at each stop, including free throw challenges, spirit squad and mascot appearances, photo opportunities with the BIG EAST championship trophy, and school-specific activations tailored to each campus. All activities will be open to students, alumni, and fans, providing an inclusive and exciting gameday atmosphere.

**UConn-St. JOHN'S TO PLAY AT MADISON SQUARE GARDEN**

St. John's will host #1 UConn at Madison Square Garden on Sunday, March 1. The game will tip off at 7 p.m. on TNT/truTV. The two teams will meet at MSG for the first time in a decade. The game marks the Johnnies' third-straight season playing at the arena and the first-ever standalone game. The Huskies are 6-0 at MSG since 2000, while the Johnnies hold an 11-7 record at the arena. UConn has a 52-18 advantage in the all-time series against St. John's.

**STRONG, OJO NAMED KAY YOW CANCER FUND SERVANT LEADERS**

UConn sophomore Sarah Strong and DePaul graduate student Michelle Ojo were named to the Kay Yow Cancer Fund Class of 2025-26 Servant Leader Award honoree list.

The Kay Yow Servant Leader Award is presented annually to student-athletes who best embody the characteristics of Coach Kay Yow – people with a servant's spirit and a commitment to selfless leadership both on and off the court and athletic field. They are people who have, or will make an impact in the fight against cancer – improving lives and giving hope.

**HUSKIES, GAMECOCKS TO MEET IN 2026**

UConn and South Carolina will face each other in the 13th annual Basketball Hall of Fame Women's Showcase on Nov. 24, 2026. The last time the two teams met was the 2025 NCAA Championship, where UConn claimed its 12th national title. The Huskies are 11-5 against the Gamecocks all-time.

**BUECKERS NAMED NCAA WOMAN OF THE YEAR TOP 30 FINALIST**

UConn women's basketball alumna Paige Bueckers was selected as one of 30 finalists for the 2025 NCAA Woman of the Year award, as announced by the Woman of the Year Selection Committee.

Graduating with a degree in Human Development and Family Sciences with a cumulative 3.49 GPA, Bueckers has made an impact both on and off the court as a Husky. During her time at UConn, she volunteered at the Connecticut Children's Hospital where she spent time with patients in-person and virtually while participating in the hospital's social media based fundraising campaigns. Bueckers also provided funding and support for free grocery stores at Hopkins West Junior High School and UConn's Storrs Campus from 2022-25 and had a downtown Minneapolis pop-up during '22 NCAA Final Four Weekend. She was an active member of UConn's head coach Geno Auriemma's charity events – Geno's for the Kids Charity Dinner and Golf Tournament. Bueckers was the 2024 BIG EAST Scholar Athlete of the Year and a 2024 CSC First Team Academic All-American.

On the court, Bueckers, part of the 2025 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Champion Team, was nothing shy of incredible for UConn. In 2025, she was the Wade Trophy recipient, Honda Sport Award winner, Nancy Lieberman National Point Guard of the Year.
