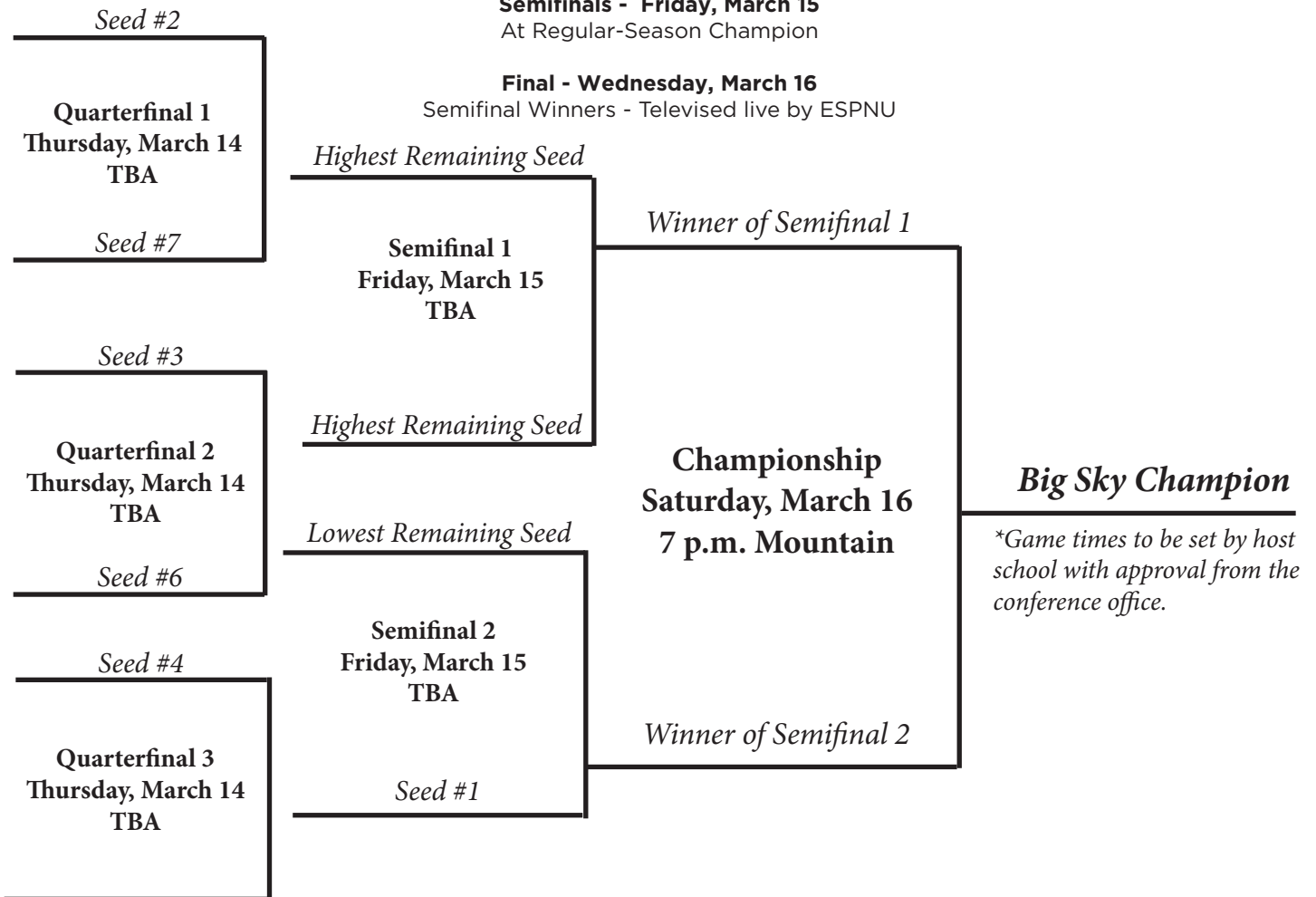

2011-12 SEASON IN REVIEW

MVP LILLARD HEADS ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

INDIVIDUAL AWARD
WINNERS
MVP Damian Lillard, Weber State
Defensive Player of the Year Will Cherry, Montana
Freshman Of the Year Dylan Garrity, Sacramento State
Newcomer of the Year Collin Chiverton, Eastern Washington

OGDEN, Utah (March 1, 2012) - For the second time in his career, Weber State's Damian Lillard was selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Most Valuable Player.

Lillard highlighted the individual award winners and the All-Conference Team, which was selected by the league head coaches

Lillard, a 6-foot-3, junior guard from Oakland, Calif., was one of three unanimous selections to the All-Conference First Team. Montana guard Will Cherry, who also captured Defensive Player of the Year, was a unanimous selection, as was Portland State senior guard Charles Odum.

Kareem Jamar, a sophomore from regular-season champion Montana, Portland State senior forward Chehales Tapscott, and Eastern Washington senior guard Cliff Colimon were also selected to the First Team.

Sacramento State point guard Dylan Garrity was selected as the Freshman of the Year. Collin Chiverton of Eastern Washington was tabbed the Newcomer of the Year.

Lillard won the league MVP as a sophomore in 2009-10. He played nine games last season before an injury cost him the remainder of the schedule. He applied for and received a medical redshirt, allowing him an extra season of eligibility.

Lillard leads the Big Sky and ranks second in the nation in scoring with an average of 24.5 points per game. He also leads the league in free-throw shooting percentage (.883), 3-point field

goals made per game (3.1), is fourth in assists (3.9), sixth in steals (1.4) and 15th in rebounding (5.0). He was named Big Sky Player of the Week five times, captured the Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week from the United States Basketball Writers Association once, and is a finalist for nearly every major national player of the year honor.

Lillard joins a select group of players to claim multiple Big Sky MVPs. Former Montana and NBA great Larry Krystkowiak won three MVPs from 1984-86. Idaho's Orlando Lightfoot won back-to-back MVP honors in 1992-93 and 1993-94, and Weber State's Harold Arce-neaux followed suit in 1998-99 and 1999-2000.

Lillard, who ranks ninth on the Big Sky's all-time scoring list with 1,835 career points, is now the 19th player in league history to be named to the All-Conference First Team three times.

Cherry, a 6-1 junior guard from West Oakland, was tabbed to the First Team for the second consecutive season, and picked up his first Defensive Player of the Year honor. Cherry leads the Big Sky and ranks sixth in the nation in steals per game at 2.6. He also is tied for fifth on the Big Sky's career steals list with 215.

Cherry guided Montana to a 15-1 conference mark, and the program's first outright conference regular-season championship since 1991-92. Cherry ranks third in the league in scoring at 16.1 points per game. He also averages 3.3 assists per game and shoots 79.1 percent from the free-throw line. He spearheaded a UM defense, which allowed a league-low 61.4 points per game, allowed a league-low .398 shooting percentage, and a league-low .328 shooting percentage from 3-point range.

Odum, a 6-foot senior from Lakewood, Calif., finished second in the league in scoring with an average of 19.1 points per game. During the regular season, Odum shot .531 percent from the floor, and .833 percent from the free-throw line. He helped the Vikings to a 10-6 conference record, good enough for third place.

Tapscott, a 6-5 forward from Hillsboro, Ore., led the Big Sky with an average of 9.2 rebounds per game. He tallied a league-high 11 double-doubles. Tapscott averaged 13.2 points per game, and also led the league in blocked shots (1.4 pg).

Jamar, a 6-5 sophomore from Venica, Calif., emerged as a terrific all-around player for Wayne Tinkle's Grizzlies. He recorded the first triple-double by a Big Sky men's player in 12 seasons with 21 points, 11 rebounds and 11 assists in a victory over Hawai'i on Feb. 18. Jamar averages 13.4 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.7 assists, 1.1 steals, and 0.7 blocks per game. He ranks in the top 15 in the conference in all four categories.

Garrity, a true freshman from Huntington Beach Calif., capped the regular season leading the Big Sky and ranked sixth in the nation in assists at 6.9 per game. He recorded 16 assists in a victory over Montana State, tying the single-game high in the NCAA this season. Garrity recorded four point-assist double-double this season. He finished with an assist to turnover ratio of 2.3, tops in the league.

Chiverton, a 6-foot-6 junior from San Jose, Calif., played in 30 games, averaging 14.7 points and making 2.9 3-pointers per game. Chiverton transferred from City of College of San Francisco.

Montana placed senior forwards Derek Selvig and Art Steward on the Second Team. Idaho State senior guard/forward Chase Grabau and senior guard Kenny McGowen were also named to the Second Team, along with Weber State junior guard Scott Bamforth.

WEBER SETS SKY RECORD: Weber State's free-throw percentage of 81.4 percent in 2011-12 was tops in the nation and set a Big Sky single-season record. Weber State made 538 of 661 free throws during the season. The previous mark was 79 percent by Montana State during the 1999-2000 season. Weber State's Damian Lillard finished 12th in the nation in free-throw percentage at 88.7 percent. Scott Bamforth was 21st at 87.5 percent. Portland State was second in the league with a percentage of 73.7. Weber State was the only team in the nation to make 80 percent of its free throws. Dayton was second in the nation at 77.7 percent. Harvard owns the NCAA Division I record for free-throw percentage in a season at 82.2 percent in 194. Weber State's 81.4 percent ranks fourth in single-season Division I history. Wisconsin shot 81.8 percent last season, while BYU shot 81.5 percent in 1989.

BEARS TOPS IN 3-POINT FG PERCENTAGE: Northern Colorado finished the season as the national leader in 3-point field-goal percentage. Northern Colorado made 199 of 448 3-point attempts for a 44.4 percent clip. Indiana was second in the nation at 43.1 percent. Weber State was second in the Big Sky at 39.1 percent. Sophomore Tate Unruh led the Bears with 60 3-pointers. He shot 46.2 percent from 3-point range. Sophomore Paul Garnica was tops on the team, shooting 48.5 percent from beyond the arc.

LILLARD, CHERRY HONORED BY USBWA: Weber State's Damian Lillard was named the District VIII Player of the Year by the United States Basketball Writers Association. Lillard and Montana junior guard Will Cherry were tabbed to the All-District Team. District VIII is one of nine districts across the nation and includes players from Utah, Wyoming, Colorado, Idaho, Nevada and Colorado. Both Lillard and Cherry were First Team All-Big Sky Conference selections. Lillard was named the league's MVP, while Cherry was the Defensive Player of the Year. They were joined on the District VIII team by Wes Eikmeier of Colorado State, Drew Gordon of New Mexico, Noah Hartsock of BYU, Michael Lyons of Air Force, Wendell McKines of New Mexico State, Mike Moser of UNLV, Andre Roberson of Colorado and Malik Story of Nevada. Tim Miles of Colorado State was named the District VIII Coach of the Year.

CHERRY PICKIN: Montana's Will Cherry became the Big Sky's all-time leader in steals in the tournament. Cherry entered the tournament with 14, which was tied for the all-time tournament record. Cherry had three steals in the semifinals against Eastern Washington, and three in the championship game against Weber State, giving him 20 in the tournament. Cherry has 223 career steals, which ranks fifth all-time in Big Sky history. He's two away from tying Eastern Washington's Ronn McMahon for fourth place at 225. Cherry has 83 steals this season, and ranks sixth in the NCAA in steals per game.

HONORS FROM THE NABC: Montana's Wayne Tinkle was named the District VI Coach of the Year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches. Tinkle led UM to a 25-7 record and its second Big Sky Championship in three seasons. Weber State's Damian Lillard and Montana's Will Cherry were selected to the District VI First Team. Weber State's Scott Bamforth and Portland State's Charles Odum were named to the second team.

COACH OF THE YEAR/EXPANSION

UM'S TINKLE NAMED COACH OF THE YEAR

The University of Montana's Wayne Tinkle was selected by his peers as the 2011-12 Big Sky Conference Men's Basketball Coach of the Year.

Tinkle guided Montana to the Big Sky Conference regular-season title with a 15-1 record, and the Big Sky Championship with an 85-66 victory over Weber State in the title game.

Montana had not won an outright Big Sky regular-season title since 1991-92, and had not tied for the regular-season championship since 1999-2000.

"It is certainly a good feeling for myself and the Grizzly basketball program to get that kind of recognition," Tinkle said. "Like we tell our players, with team success you're going to enjoy individual success. This would not have happened without the great staff that I am fortunate enough to have, and the players obviously are the ones who get it done on the court."

The Grizzlies went 25-7 overall. The 25 victories ranks as the third-most in school history. The 15 conference wins were the most in school history, and tied the all-time conference record.

Tinkle, in his sixth season coaching his alma mater, has compiled an overall record of 116-71. He has led the Grizzlies to three consecutive 20-win seasons, and trips to the NCAA Tournament in two of the past three seasons, along with a trip to the CBI last season.

Tinkle is the first Montana coach to win Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year honors since Blaine Taylor in 1991-92. Stew Morrill won the honor in 1990-91. Taylor is currently the coach at Old Dominion, while Morrill is at Utah State.

This marks just the fifth time a Montana coach has won the honor. Jud Heathcote was named Coach of the Year in 1974-75, and Jim Brandenburg shared the honor with Weber State's Neil McCarthy in 1977-78.

The Grizzlies had two players - junior guard Will Cherry and sophomore forward/guard Kareem Jamar, named to the All-Conference First Team. Forwards Derek Selvig and Art Stewart were tabbed to the second team. Cherry was named the league's Defensive Player of the Year.

Tinkle played for Montana from 1985-89, earning All-Conference honors three times. He was an assistant at Montana for five seasons before taking over the head position.
