ISU'S HONE EARNS BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (October 29, 2012) - Idaho State's Jaclyn Hone-Hawkins has been named the Big Sky Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for the matches played the week of Oct. 22-Oct. 28. This is Hone-Hawkins' first POTW honor.

Hone-Hawkins, a senior from Shelley, Idaho, helped Idaho State go 2-0 this weekend on the road, defeating North Dakota (3-0) and defending Big Sky Champion Northern Colorado (3-0). Those wins secured a spot for ISU at the 2012 Banner Health North Colorado Medical Center Big Sky Volleyball Championship in Greeley, Colo., November 23-24.

Against North Dakota, Hone-Hawkins posted a team-high six blocks as well as seven kills, two assists and 11 digs. On Saturday night against Northern Colorado, Hone-Hawkins recorded a double-double tallying a team-high 14 kills and 12 digs. She also recorded one assist, one ace and five blocks in the contest. Hone-Hawkins' performance helped ISU claim sole possession of the No. 2 spot in the conference and the Bengals remain one game behind Portland State.

So far this season, Hone-Hawkins has 230 kills on a .316 hitting percentage. She has 169 digs and 93 total blocks. She has also recorded seven double-doubles this season including one this weekend against NC.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Cora Kellerman, Eastern Washington - Eastern Washington finally snapped its 26-match losing streak that spanned over two seasons, as the Eagles recorded back-to-back sweeps of Sacramento State and Montana. Playing nearly every single rotation of all nine sets played over the week, Kellerman averaged 4.11 kills and 3.78 digs in Eastern's three home matches...Against the Hornets, she had 15 kills and a team-high 17 digs for her sixth double-double of the season. She dominated the first set against Sac State with 10 kills on a .529 attack percentage. The Eagles prevailed 29-27 in that set for their very first first-set win of the season, which set the tone for their first overall win as well. On Thursday against Montana, Kellerman posted 11 kills on a .296 clip. She also had eight digs and two blocks, as Eastern won its second-straight match in three. For the third outing in a row, Kellerman posted double-digit kills with 11 in Eastern's narrow loss to Montana State. She also had nine digs, one ace and one block.

Brooke Bray, Montana - Bray averaged 3.43 kills on .364 hitting and added 1.43 blocks per set as Montana dropped both matches on the Eastern Washington-Portland State road trip...Bray had eight kills on .438 hitting and three blocks in Thursday's 3-0 loss to the Eagles and a team-high 16 kills on .333 hitting and a match-high seven blocks in Saturday's 3-1 loss to the Vikings.

Sarah Horton, Montana State - Horton totaled 30 kills, averaging 4.29 kps, and 26 digs, 3.71 dps, as the Bobcats continue to hold steady in 5th place in the Big Sky standings following a road split at Portland State/Eastern Washington this weekend. Against league-leading Portland State, Horton notched her 11th double-double of the season with 11 kills and a career-matching 19 digs. In addition, she posted two blocks and a service ace against the Vikings. In MSU's 3-0 sweep over Eastern Washington, Horton posted a match-high 19 kills, averaging 6.33 per set, while hitting .375 from the field. Horton also chipped in nine digs, three aces and a block against the Eagles. In their three road trips this season in Big Sky play, the Bobcats have split each series.

Ronni Munkeby, North Dakota - Munkeby averaged 15 kills per match as UND split a pair of conference matches. Her match-high 16 kills helped North Dakota to a grueling five-set win over Weber State Saturday. For the week, Munkeby hit .359 (30-7-64) and recorded eight assisted blocks.

Payton Bock, Northern Arizona - Bock hit .556 with a career-high 17 kills and five blocks in NAU's lone match of the week Saturday at Sacramento State. She committed just two attack errors in 27 swings as NAU took a 2-0 lead before the Hornets came back to win in five. For the season Bock is now hitting .312 with 2.30 kills and 1.25 blocks per set and is among the conference leaders with a .353 hitting percentage, 2.69 kills, and 1.41 blocks per set in Big Sky play.

Kelley Arnold, Northern Colorado - Arnold stood out all week as the Bears' best all-around player. In particular, her contributions on the offense stood out the most...She finished the weekend with a team-leading 41 kills on .373 hitting. She led the Bears in kills in each of the three matches and, in fact, has led the team in that category for eight straight matches...It wasn't just the offense though where she was productive as she finished with 26 digs, seven assists, five aces and six total blocks...Against instate-rival Denver, Arnold finished with 14 kills (.357 hitting) while tallying eight digs, four assists and an ace. Once she got back into Big Sky play, her roll continued as she powered the Bears to a sweep over Weber State at home. She finished with 12 kills (.400 hitting) and was outstanding on defense - coming up with six digs and five blocks. Her service game was also on-point as she tallied four aces...She finished the weekend up with another good match against Idaho State - finishing with her 10th double-double of the season with 15 kills (.367 hitting) and 12 digs.

Kasimira Clark, Portland State - Clark 50 digs over the Vikings' two matches this past week while adding four service aces and seven assists. Her 6.25 digs per set average over the weekend is above her season average of 5.33 which leads the conference... She started the week with 19 digs, three aces, and six assists in a four-set battle with Montana State Thursday night. She then posted 31 digs against Montana on Saturday. The 31 digs is her second most and the fourth most by any player in the Big Sky player this season. She also added an assists and an ace against Montana...Clark leads the conference in digs overall with 485 (5.33 dps) and is second in aces with 35 (0.38 aces/set). She is also first in the conference with 5.53 digs per set in Big Sky matches this season.

Kayla Beal, Sacramento State - Beal led Sacramento State to a 2-1 record last week, as the right side hitter hit a robust .495 with averages of 4.45 kills, 1.09 digs and 1.36 blocks per set. She totaled 49 kills with just three errors in 93 total attacks while also adding three aces. Beal hit at least .435 in all three matches during the week and tallied double figures in kills in all three contests. That included a career-high 22 kills and a .435 hitting percentage in a win against a Northern Arizona squad ...In the NAU victory, Beal had four kills and a .571 hitting percentage in the decisive fifth set. She finished the match with six digs and six blocks to go along with the 22 kills. In the team's win over Southern Utah on Thursday, Beal had 11 kills and a career-best .647 hitting percentage as she committed no errors in 17 total attacks while also finishing with three aces and three blocks...In the team's loss to Eastern Washington on Monday, Beal had 16 kills, a .500 hitting percentage (16-1-30) and six blocks.
