THIS WEEK IN THE BIG SKY

- The final spot of the 2012 Banner Health North Colorado Medical Center Big Sky Volleyball Championship was decided Monday night. Montana State will be the sixth and final seed.
- The last time MSU was in the championship was back in 2005. The Bobcats won the first match against Idaho State and lost to the host Sacramento State in the semifinals.
- The 2008 championships was the last time we have six teams compete. From 2009-11 only four teams went.
- Since the 2008 season either Portland State or Northern Colorado have won the championship match.
- Northern Arizona's last championship was in 2007 and NAU lost to Eastern Washington in the quarterfinals.
- Keep an eye out on Northern Colorado's Marissa Hughes and Northern Arizona's Anna Gott as they are chasing career records in the Big Sky.
- Big Sky Conference Championship will begin on Friday starting at 9 a.m. The two quarterfinals will be played Friday morning with the two winners moving on to the semifinals that night to play the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds. The championship match will be played on Saturday at 7 p.m. All matches at the championship can be viewed for free on Big Sky TV.

NC'S HADDOCK NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE POTW

OGDEN, Utah (November 20, 2012) - Northern Colorado's Tambre Haddock has been named Big Sky Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for the matches played the week of Nov. 11-19. This is Haddock's second POTW this season.

Haddock, a sophomore from Longmont, Colo., helped lead the Bears to a 2-1 weekend, including wins in each of their final two regular-season Big Sky matches.

Over that stretch, Haddock had 36 kills as she finished with .314 hitting despite having 86 total attempts on the week. The other way Haddock helped the team to a strong finish to its regular season was with her defense. The outside hitter finished the week with 40 digs and a couple of double-doubles.

On Tuesday in the 3-1 loss to Colorado State, Haddock had nine kills and 16 digs. NC hit the road on Thursday and competed at Southern Utah, where Haddock had 16 kills on a .538 hitting percentage. She also led the team with 10 digs in the 3-0 win against the Thunderbirds.

In the 3-0 win at Northern Arizona, Haddock had 11 kills on a .391 hitting percentage. She also added 14 kills. For the week, she averaged 3.60 kills per set and 4.0 digs per set.

Northern Colorado will host the 2012 Banner Health North Colorado Medical Center Big Sky Volleyball Championship in Greeley, Colo. The matches will begin on Friday starting at 9 a.m. Mountain with the No. 3 seed Northern Arizona facing the No. 6 seed Montana State. Following that match will be the No. 4 seed Northern Colorado against the No. 5 seed North Dakota. The No. 1 seed Portland State and the No. 2 seed Idaho State both will face the winner of the two morning matches Friday night. The championship match will be played on Saturday at 7 p.m.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Cora Kellerman, Eastern Washington - Kellerman posted back-to-back double-doubles in her final weekend of collegiate volleyball. She averaged 3.88 kills on a .258 attack percentage, and 3.75 digs per set on the week. In their Thursday match, the Eagles upset then-No. 1 Idaho State, 3-1, while also upholding a 17-year home winning streak against the Bengals. Kellerman led Eastern with a match-high 15 kills, and had 17 digs. She also contributed two blocks. On Saturday against the Wildcats, Kellerman notched 16 kills on an impressive .357 clip. She had also had 13 digs and two service aces...Kellerman registered a double-double in five of the final six matches of her senior campaign, with at least 15 kills in each of those contests.

Breanne Van Every, Idaho State - Van Every recorded back-to-back double-doubles this weekend as the Bengals wrapped up a second-place finish in the regular season. Van Every led ISU with 17 kills and 16 digs against Eastern Washington and led the Bengals again against Portland State with 16 kills and 14 digs. She also had two service aces and six total blocks over the weekend.

Kayla Reno, Montana - Reno averaged 3.78 kills on .233 hitting and 3.78 digs per set as Montana lost in five sets at Sacramento State Saturday and in four sets at home to Montana State Monday. Reno also added six blocks (0.67) and three service aces...Reno had 14 kills on .207 hitting against the Hornets, with 19 digs and 3 blocks, and 20 kills on .259 hitting against the Bobcats, with 15 digs and 3 blocks.

Sarah Horton, Montana State - Horton posted 43 kills, averaging 4.78 per set to guide the Montana State volleyball team to its first Big Sky Conference postseason appearance since 2005. Needing just one victory to secure the final spot, Horton tallied a match-high 22 kills at Sacramento State as MSU dropped a 3-2 decision to the Hornets. Against, Sacramento State, she also posted her 14th double-double of the season with 17 digs. In MSU's do-or-die match at Montana on Monday night, Horton paced the Bobcats with a match-high 21 kills (5.25 kps), while hitting .267 from the field and adding eight digs, three blocks and two aces, including the match winner.

Kelli Dallmann, Northern Arizona - Dallmann averaged 3.12 kills and 2.62 digs per set as NAU defeated North Dakota and lost to Northern Colorado to finish third in the Big Sky in the regular season. She recorded a double-double with 13 kills and 13 digs to lead NAU to a 3-2 win over North Dakota on Thursday, posting her 10th double-double of the season. She then led the Lumberjacks with 12 kills and eight digs while adding one block against Northern Colorado. She is second on the team in both kills (3.12/set) and digs (2.63/set) this season.

Garyn Schlatter, Portland State - Schlatter helped lead the Vikings to a pair of wins to end the season and claim the Big Sky regular season championship. Schlatter tallied 81 assists over the teams seven sets last week (11.57 aps) while adding 13 digs, four kills, two aces, and eight blocking assists... Schlatter started the weekend with 32 assists, three digs, and six blocking assists in a three-set sweep of Weber State. She helped the team hit .262 in the match...The Weber State win helped set up the de facto regular season championship match against Idaho State. Schlatter recorded her 11th double-double of the season in the match with 49 assists and 10 digs. She also added three kills, an ace, and two more blocking assists in the four-set win to claim the regular season title... Schlatter has tallied 1,234 assists on the season for a 10.73 assists per set average. She also has 274 digs (2.38 dps), 91 kills, and 11 double-doubles.

Kayla Beal, Sacramento State - Beal helped lead Sacramento State to a pair of victories in must-win matches last week. With Sacramento State's back against the wall, the junior responded with averages of 3.60 kills, 1.40 digs and 1.40 blocks per set while hitting .322. She had 36 total kills - a large total for a rightside hitter - with just eight errors in 87 total attacks...That included 20 kills against Montana on Saturday night, and 16 kills against Montana State. Both victories went to five sets, and Beal combined for five kills, six digs, an ace, two blocks and a .333 hitting percentage in the fifth frame of both matches...In Saturday's win over Montana, Beal posted a match-high 20 kills to go along with a .386 hitting percentage, two aces, four blocks and a career-best 11 digs. The 20 kills were two shy of her career high...In Thursday's victory over Montana State, she posted 16 kills and a career-high tying 10 blocks to go along with a .256 hitting percentage...The Dixon, Calif., native has now recorded double figures in kills on 15 occasions this year, including seven times in the last nine matches. Against Big Sky competition, she is averaging 3.01 kills and 1.14 blocks per set to go with a .246 hitting percentage.
