Davion Berry, G/F, Weber State

Weber State's Davion Berry has been selected as the Big Sky Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for games played Dec. 12-15.



Berry, a 6-foot-4 junior guard/forward from Oakland, Calif., scored a career-high 25 points with two rebounds, two assists and two steals in Weber State's 78-68 loss to Brigham Young on Saturday night in Ogden, Utah.

Berry made 10-of-14 shots from the field, and was 4-of-5 from the free-throw line. The transfer from Cal State Monterey Bay scored 16 points in the second half. Berry scored 12 in the first five minutes of the second half to help cut BYU's lead to two points.

Berry ranks seventh in the Big Sky in scoring at 14.3 points per game. He is shooting 47 percent from the field, and averaging 3.3 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game.

THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

The 2012-13 conference season begins Monday night with a pair of games, and by the end of the week 10 conference games will be played...Northern Arizona plays host to Montana State on Tuesday night in a game that will air live on Fox Arizona Plus...North Dakota plays its first Big Sky Conference men's basketball game on Monday at Southern Utah, which is also playing its first game...On Wednesday night, defending champion Montana opens play at Northern Arizona. That game will also be televised on Fox Arizona Plus...Montana State opens conference play on Wednesday night at Sacramento State...Weber State travels to eastern Washington on Thursday night, while Idaho State is at Portland State...On Friday, Montana is at Sacramento State, and Northern Colorado is at North Dakota...On Saturday, Idaho State is at Eastern Washington and Weber State is at Portland State...Three non-conference games are also on this week's schedule...Northern Colorado looks to snap a six-game losing streak as it plays host to Tabor College on Monday...Eastern Washington travels to UC Davis on Monday night...On Friday, Southern Utah is at Denver.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

HOME STREAKS END: Weber State's 20-game home winning streak came to an end on Saturday, as did Montana's 15-game home winning streak. Weber State fell 78-68 to Brigham Young, the Wildcats' first home loss since falling to Eastern Washington in the 2010-11 regular-season finale. Montana lost 68-67 in two overtimes to South Dakota State, the Grizzlies' first home loss since falling to Nevada on Dec. 10, 2011. Both streaks were ranked in the top-10 longest active streaks in the NCAA. Montana enters league play having won 17 straight conference home games, dating back to the 2009-10 season. Weber State has won eight straight home games in Big Sky Conference play. Under Randy Rahe, Weber State is 78-13 at the Dee Events Center. Under Wayne Tinkle, Montana is 75-20 at Dahlberg Arena.

CONFERENCE DEBUTS: North Dakota and Southern Utah will play their inaugural Big Sky Conference games on Monday night. The teams will play each other in Cedar City, Utah, at 7:35 p.m. Mountain. Northern Colorado was the last new institution in the Big Sky. In 2006-07, the Bears finished 2-14 in conference play. In 1996-1997, Cal State Northridge, Portland State and Sacramento State all entered the Big Sky. Cal State Northridge went 8-8 in league play. Portland State was 6-10, and Sacramento State was 2-14. Cal State Northridge won its first league game, a 78-62 win over Portland State. Sacramento State also won its first league game, downing Portland State 69-61. Eastern Washington went 2-14 in its first season in the Big Sky (1987-88). Nevada went 5-9 in 1979-80, its first season in the league. In 1970-71, Boise State went 5-9 in conference play. Northern Arizona finished 4-10. It was the first season in the league for both schools. Because of the expansion, Big Sky teams will play 20 conference games. The top seven teams qualify for the postseason tournament.

RPI REPORT: The Big Sky Conference dropped three spots in this week's RPI Ratings provided by Collegiate Basketball News. The Big Sky is now 28th among Division I conferences, just behind the SWAC and just ahead of the Mid-Eastern. The Big Sky's schedule strength is ranked sixth overall. Weber State has the top RPI in the Big Sky at 100. The Wildcats dropped 32 spots from last week. Northern Arizona is second at 132, followed by Sacramento State at 162 and Montana at 197. Portland State's schedule strength is rated 20th, followed by Northern Arizona at 42 and Weber State at 79.

CHERRY RETURNS: Two-time All-Big Sky guard Will Cherry made his 2012-13 debut in Montana's 68-67 two overtime loss to South Dakota State on Saturday. Cherry, the 2011-12 Defensive Player of the Year, missed the first seven games of the season after recovering from a foot injury. Cherry played 13 minutes off the bench. He made 1-of-5 field goals with four rebounds. Cherry has 223 steals. He needs 61 steals to become the Big Sky's all-time leader.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

NCAA LEADERS: Eastern Washington continues to rank second in the nation in 3-point field goals per game with an average of 9.8. Illinois leads the nation at 10.0. Montana is third in the nation in 3-point field-goal percentage at 42.5 percent. Weber State is fourth in the nation in 3-point FG percentage defense (22.8). Montana State is seventh in the nation in turnover margin (6.0) and 13th in steals per game (10.3). Idaho State's Tomas Sanchez is second in the nation in free-throw percentage. Sanchez has made 26-of-27 free throws for an average of 96.3 percent. Sacramento State's Dylan Garrity is 12th at 94.3 percent, followed by NAU freshman DeWayne Russell (94.1). Eastern Washington's Venky Jois is 12th in the nation in double-doubles with five.

Tip-ins: North Dakota snapped a five-game losing streak with a 74-32 win over Presentation. Alonzo Taylor scored a career-high 17 points off the bench, hitting all eight of his field goals....Portland State lost at home in front of a sold-out Stott Center to Oregon State 79-74 on Tuesday. It marked the first time a Pac-12 team has played at the Stott Center. Renardo Parker and Lateef McMullan each scored 16 points in the loss...PSU snapped a five-game losing streak with an 85-74 home win over George Fox on Saturday. McMullan scored 14 points with a career-high eight assists. PSU hit a season-high 10 3-pointers...NAU senior guard Gabe Rogers needs 23 points to reach 1,000 for his career...NAU senior guard Stallon Saldivar needs five assists to reach 400 for his career...UM's Will Cherry needs seven points to reach 1,200 for his career...NAU enters conference play looking to snap a 15-game conference losing streak. NAU won its first conference game last season, downing Sacramento State 73-64 on Dec. 29, 2011...Weber State drew 8,695 to its home game against BYU...Big Sky teams are 3-44 when shooting less than 45 percent from the floor... Big Sky teams are 6-47 when trailing at the half...Montana's Kareem Jamar had 16 points, seven assists and six rebounds in the loss to South Dakota State...Big Sky teams are 21-12 at home, 5-38 in road games, and 2-6 in neutral court games.
