## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - DEC. 24

### JORDAN RICHARDSON, G, WSU & MATHIAS WARD, F, UM

The Big Sky Conference has selected its men's basketball Players of the Week for games played Dec. 17-23. Weber State's Jordan Richardson and Montana's Mathias Ward, who both led their teams to two conference road wins, have been selected as the Co-Players of the Week.

Richardson, a 6-1 junior guard from Lewisville, Texas, averaged 14.5 points, four assists, two rebounds and a steal in road wins over Eastern Washington and Portland State. Richardson shot 70 percent from 3-point range (7-of-10) and 60 percent overall from the floor. He also had just two turnovers in 62 minutes of action.

In a 74-53 victory over Eastern Washington on Dec. 20, Richardson scored a season-high 15 points with three assists, three rebounds and a steal. He was 3-of-5 from 3-point range and 4-of-6 from the free-throw line. In a 73-69 overtime win over Portland State on Dec. 22, Richardson scored 14 points with five assists, a rebound and steal Richardson made 4-of-5 from 3-point range.

Richardson leads the Big Sky in 3-point field-goal percentage at 55.9 percent. He also leads in assist to turnover ratio at 3.2.

Ward, a 6-7 senior forward from Gig Harbor, Wash., averaged 14 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists as the Grizzlies earned road wins over Northern Arizona and Sacramento State. In the two games, Ward shot .667 percent from the floor (10-of-15) and was 7-of-8 from 3-point range.

Ward scored 12 points with six rebounds, two assists and a block in a 62-56 win over Northern Arizona on Dec. 9. Ward gave the Grizzlies the lead for good with a 3-pointer with 4:44 left to play. Ward netted 16 points with five rebounds and an assist in Montana's 61-60 win over Sacramento State on Dec. 22. Ward was 6-of-6 from the free-throw line, hitting all four of his attempts in the final 1:07 to help UM win its seventh straight league road game.

## THIS WEEK'S SKY HIGHLIGHTS

Just a handful of games dot this week's schedule, as student-athletes and coaches enjoy the Holiday season...Northern Arizona is the first team back in action. The Lumberjacks continue their difficult non-conference schedule when it travels to Brigham Young of the West Coast Conference. The game will be televised on BYU-TV...North Dakota returns to action on Friday for a home game against Bowling Green of the MAC Conference....Four teams are in action on Saturday, and the schedule includes one conference game...Northern Colorado travels to Southern Utah for the Thunderbirds' second conference game. Both teams opened league play with victories last week over North Dakota...Idaho State faces Washington State in Kennewick, Wash...Weber State takes on the University of the Southwest at the Dee Events Center...Montana State is at home against Northwest Indian College.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**RANDY & WAYNE:** Weber State's Randy Rahe and Montana's Wayne Tinkle both led their teams to a pair of conference road wins last weekend. The two coaches are both in their seventh season as their respective schools, and both have put up impressive records over that span. Rahe has an overall record of 126-71, while Tinkle is 122-75. Rahe's 126 victories ranks 10th all-time in Big Sky history. Tinkle is 11th. In conference games, Rahe has won 76 games, ranking him seventh all-time in league history. Tinkle has 68 league wins, which ranks 11th. Both should move up that list this season. Rahe is just three wins behind former Weber State and Idaho coach Joe Cravens, and 10 wins behind former Weber State coach Ron Abegglen. Tinkle is closing in on becoming Montana's all-time leader in Big Sky wins. He is just two behind Blaine Taylor, who guided UM from 1991-98, and five wins behind Mike Montgomery, who won 73 league games at UM from 1979-86. Rahe and Tinkle's current conference winning percentage ranks near the top. Rahe has a conference winning percentage of .775, which ranks third all-time in league history behind Weber State's Phil Johnson, who won .886 percent of his conference games in three seasons, and Idaho's Kermit Davis, who won .813 percent in two seasons. Tinkle's conference winning percentage of .694 currently ranks eighth all-time. Tinkle has led UM to the NCAA Tournament twice, while Rahe has led Weber State to the NCAA Tournament once. Rahe has won three regular-season titles. Tinkle has won one.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

**RPI REPORT:** Weber State and Montana are the top two Big Sky teams in this week's RPI ratings. Weber State improved seven spots to 93. Montana made a 77-spot jump to 120. Northern Arizona is third at 179. The Big Sky dropped to 31st among Division I Conferences. The Big Sky's non-conference schedule strength is ranked as the fourth-toughest in the nation.

**NCAA LEADERS:** Eastern Washington continues to rank second in the nation in 3-point field goals per game at 9.8. The Eagles hit 17 in a loss to UC Davis last Monday. Montana State ranks 11th in turnover margin. Montana is 13th in 3-point field-goal percentage. Eastern Washington freshman Venky Jois ranks 10th in the nation with six double-doubles. Idaho State's Tomas Sanchez is 11th in free-throw percentage at 93.1.

**NAU MILESTONES:** Northern Arizona senior Gabe Rogers scored his 1000th career point in the Lumberjacks' loss to Montana. Rogers now has 1,012 career points. Rogers is tied for 19th all-time in Big Sky history with 184 3-pointers. Senior guard Stallon Saldivar recorded his 400th career assist in a win over Montana State. Saldivar enters this week with 408 career assists, which is tied for 17th all-time in Big Sky history.

**Tip-ins:** Portland State's Aaron Moore recorded his first double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds in a loss to Weber State...UM's Will Cherry has moved into third place on the Big Sky's all-time steals list with 229...Cherry hit one free throw with two seconds left to lift UM to a 61-60 win over Sacramento State...Derrick Barden has 20 points and nine rebounds in Northern Colorado's win over North Dakota...NAU is one win away from matching its victory total of last season...NAU true freshman DeWayne Russell has scored in double figures in his first 11 collegiate games...Montana has won seven straight conference road games dating back to last season...Idaho State's Avibakuro Preh recorded his first double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds in a loss to Eastern Washington...NAU's Max Jacobsen scored a career-high 22 points with nine rebounds in a win over Montana State.
