Sacramento State's Se'nyce Parrish tied the Big Sky single game record in 3-pointers made. She made 9-of-13 in an overtime win at Oregon State. Parrish also added 39 points... Last week, Northern Arizona's Amy Patton tied the Big Sky single game record in points. She had 41 points in the loss to Bradley. Patton also added 10 steals in that game, which ranks tied for second in the Big Sky single game...Portland State's Angela Misa recorded 21 rebounds in a win against Butler. That ranks tied for sixth in the Big Sky for rebounds...Sacramento State's Kylie Kuhns is on her way to break the Big Sky career record in rebounds. She has 972 in her career, and the record of 1,174 was set by Natalie Doma of Idaho State from 2004-08. She is 28 rebounds away from becoming the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Play begins this week on Monday when Montana State hosts Tennessee State at 7 p.m. Mountain. Seven games this week will be played on Big Sky TV...Conference play will begin on December 20 with five games being played. After that weekend, Big Sky Conference play will continue after the holidays on Thursday, January 3.

SAC'S PARRISH NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (December 3, 2012) - Sacramento State's Se'nyce Parrish has been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the games played the week of Nov. 27-Dec. 2.

Parrish, a junior from Clovis, Calif., was just two points shy of tying the Big Sky Conference single-game record with 39 points in Sacramento State's 80-71 overtime victory at Oregon State on Saturday. Parrish hit a crucial 3-pointer with 18 seconds left in regulation, and proceeded to connect on her next two 3-point attempts in overtime as the Hornets outscored the Beavers 12-3 in extra time.

Overall, Parrish tied the school record with nine 3-pointers made against the Beavers, and tied the Big Sky single-game record. In the win on Wednesday against San Francisco, Parrish recorded three steals, three assists, five rebounds and had 11 points.

In two games during the week, Parrish averaged 25 points per game, while shooting 54.8 percent from the floor (17-of-31), including 50 percent (10-of-20) from 3-point range and went 6-of-7 at the free-throw line. She now ranks eighth in the Big Sky at 13.2 points per game, while her 36.1 3-point field-goal percentage ranks fourth.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Laura Hughes, Eastern Washington - Hughes had a career-night in Eastern's lone game of the week against Idaho on Nov. 27. Hughes made 8-of-12 shots from the floor and went a perfect 4-of-4 from the line for a career-high and team-leading 20 points. She also led EWU on the glass with nine rebounds, and contributed a steal. She had 16 points in the second half, which helped EWU overcome a 12-point halftime deficit and take a lead with five minutes remaining in the game.

Lindsey Reed, Idaho State - Reed scored a total of 36 points this week. She scored a season high 20 points in ISU's 69-45 win over South Dakota. Reed shot 7-13 from the field and hit four 3-point shots. She went 2-2 from the line and had three rebounds, one assist and three steals. Against No. 19/21 Nebraska she led ISU with 16 points. She also added six rebounds and two blocks in the contest. She shot 5-12 from the field and posted three 3-point field goals.

Katie Baker, Montana - Baker averaged 15.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game while shooting 56.0 percent to lead Montana to a 2-0 record at the 32nd Lady Griz Classic in Missoula last week. Baker was voted MVP of the tournament for the second straight year...Baker scored 15 points and grabbed six rebounds in Thursday's 76-65 victory over Idaho and totaled 16 points and five rebounds in Saturday's 71-48 win over Tennessee State. She also had three steals in both games...Montana led Idaho by seven at the half and Tennessee State by eight, then built second-half leads of 20-plus points in both because of Baker's hot hand. She hit 10 of her 11 second-half shots in both games, going 5 for 5 against the Vandals and 5 for 6 against the Lady Tigers.

Rachel Semansky, Montana State - Semansky led Montana State to a pair of wins last weekend, including a 71-65 road victory at Utah State. Against the Aggies, Semansky just missed her 19th career double-double with 13 points and nine rebounds, while shooting 55 percent from the field and adding four assists and one steal. On Thursday, Semansky played just 13 minutes in MSU's 81-49 win over UM-Western, recording 12 points connecting on 60 percent from the floor. For the two games, the native of Highwood, Montana, averaged 12.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 1.5 steals per game, while shooting 57 percent from the field.

Madi Buck, North Dakota - Buck scored a career-high-tying 21 points and added a game-high 13 rebounds as visiting North Dakota defeated its in-state rival, North Dakota State, 73-63 Friday night at the Bison Sports Arena. Buck was 6-of-13 from the field and 8-10 from the free throw line in the win. She also added three assists, helping UND head coach Travis Brewster to his first career win. North Dakota heads home for a four-game home stand beginning with a Tuesday tilt with Air Force at the Betty Engelstad Center.

D'shara Strange, Northern Colorado - Strange scored a season-best 21 points in helping the Bears snap a four-game losing streak on Sunday against North Dakota State. Strange also tied for the team lead with seven rebounds in the game. On Thursday at Denver, Strange had 14 points and 11 rebounds for her first double-double of the year. Strange has scored at least 13 points in every game this year and this week she averaged 17.5 points and 9.0 rebounds per game, while shooting .400 from the floor and .778 (7-for-9) from the free throw line. She also had six steals and one assist in the two games.

Raven Anderson, Northern Arizona - Anderson averaged a double-double with 13.0 points and 10.5 rebounds per game while shooting 47.6% from the field last week and led NAU to its first win of the season. She recorded her first career double-double with career highs of 18 points and 14 rebounds while shooting 7-of-14 from the field and was the game's top scorer and rebounder in NAU's loss at UC Riverside on Sunday. On Friday night at Cal State Fullerton, Anderson totaled 8 points and 7 rebounds off the bench as NAU earned its first win of the season. Ten of her 21 rebounds for the week came on the offensive glass while she committed just two turnovers in 58 minutes of playing time and shot a team-high 10 free-throws. Anderson is now averaging 10.1 points and 7.0 rebounds per game this season while shooting 47.8% from the field.

Courtney VanBrocklin, Portland State - VanBrocklin led the Vikings with 20 points on 5-of-9 shooting in a 64-49 win over cross town rival Portland. She also added four rebounds, two steals, and a career-high seven assists. The Vikings move to 5-1 on the season for the first time since the 2007-08 season...On the season VanBrocklin is averaging 14.8 ppg, 4.8 rpg, 3.2 apg, and is shooting a team best .508 (31-for-61) to lead the Vikings. She is also 20-for-23 from the free-throw line.

Carli Moreland, Southern Utah - Moreland racked up 13 rebounds Saturday to go along with a season-high 16 points as SUU was narrowly edged at home by New Mexico State who came from behind late in the game for a 70-68 victory. Those totals made the 6-1 forward the game's top-scorer and rebounder. The performance was the second double-double of the year for Moreland who is currently averaging 7.8 points per game and leads the Thunderbirds with 8.0 rebounds a contest.
