UND'S BUCK AND SAC'S KUHNS NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (December 31, 2012) - North Dakota's Madi Buck and Sacramento State's Kylie Kuhns have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Co-Players of the Week for the games played the week of Dec. 24-Dec. 30.

Buck, a junior from Bismarck, N.D., scored a team-high 18 points to go along with six rebounds and a career-best five blocked shots as North Dakota upset host University of Utah, 62-56, Saturday afternoon in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Buck was 9-of-10 from the free throw line and hit a clutch 3-pointer with the shot-clock expiring to spark a 10-0 UND run in the second half. North Dakota and Buck's defensive efforts helped keep a potent Utes attack at bay, holding Utah to just 33 percent shooting and more than 15 points under their points per game average coming into the contest.

Buck leads UND with averages of 10.6 points, 7.6 rebounds and 2.0 steals per contest. Her .875 free throw percentage also tops the squad.

Kuhns, a senior from Salem, Ore., tallied 20 points and 15 boards to push Sacramento State past rival UC Davis, 66-65, in overtime on Sunday afternoon. With the Hornets down three to the Aggies and under a minute left in the game, Kuhns grabbed an offensive rebound on a missed 3-pointer and, as she was fouled, muscled in a layup. She sank the ensuing game-tying free throw to tie it up at 57-57 and force overtime.

Kuhns also tied Sacramento State's career steals record with two against the Aggies, matching Kristy Ryan's mark of 179. Kuhns is the first player in school history to reach 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds. Last week, Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky Conference history to reach 1,000 career rebounds.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Lexie Nelson, Eastern Washington - Nelson led EWU in its 58-47 win over Warner Pacific on Saturday (Dec. 29) at Reese Court. Nelson had a game-high 19 points – the 10th double-digit performance of the season and just four shy of her career high. She drained three 3-pointers, which she has done in five games already this year, and contributed four rebounds, three assists and one block. She had just two turnovers in 31 minutes on the floor – the most minutes played by an Eagle in the game. Nelson ranks third overall in the Big Sky in scoring, and is sixth in both 3-point field goals average and 3-point field goal percentage.

Amber Van Deudekom, Northern Colorado - Van Deudekom came off the bench against Johnson & Wales and recorded a double-double in just 12 minutes of playing time with career-highs in both points (10) and rebounds (13). She also had two assists with no turnovers and was a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw line. The sophomore played in only 39 minutes in her freshman year and had scored two points on four previous occasions. Her career-high in rebounding had been seven from last year. Van Deudekom's seven offensive rebounds helped lead the team to 71 total boards, shattering the previous school Division I record of 54.

Courtney VanBrocklin, Portland State - VanBrocklin Scored a game-high 18 points in the Vikings win over crosstown rival the University of Portland this past Saturday. She scored her 18 points on 6-12 shooting from the field while playing all 40 minutes in the contest. She was 3-4 from beyond the arc and 3-4 from the free-throw line... VanBrocklin added seven rebounds, six assists, and a steal in the win over the Pilots. Her six assists was one shy of her career high of seven she recorded against the Pilots earlier this season... VanBrocklin improved her scoring average to 14.4 ppg this season which leads the Vikings. She is shooting 49 percent from the field and has shot 50 percent or better in five of the 10 games she has played this year.

Lori Parkinson, Southern Utah - Parkinson scored 11 points and grabbed 11 rebounds as the Thunderbirds downed in-state rival Utah Valley by a final score of 64-49 last week. The SUU forward shot 41 percent from the floor and added a free throw to record her first career double-double. Eight of her 11 boards came on the offensive end and she led the T-Birds with three steals in the game. For the season Parkinson is averaging 5.7 ppg to go along with 5.1 rebounds with a field goal mark of 50 percent.
