**Coming Up:** This week's action will begin on Monday, when Weber State hosts Idaho State at 7:05 p.m. Mountain...If you can't make it to the game you can watch it for free on Big Sky TV...Idaho State is looking for its third conference win, while Weber State is looking for its first win of the season...Conference play will continue on Thursday and Saturday.

**TV Games:** Three games can be seen on TV if you are either in Montana or Northern Arizona. Starting on Thursday, Northern Arizona will host Weber State. That game can be seen on FOX Sports Arizona, NAU-TV beginning at 6:35 p.m. Mountain. On Saturday, Montana will host Montana State at 3 p.m. Mountain. That game can be seen on Max Media. Also on Saturday, starting at 6:35 p.m. Mountain, Northern Arizona will host Idaho State on FOX Sports Arizona, NAU-TV.

**Watching Career Records:** Kylie Kuhns ranks third in career rebounds with 1,058. She is chasing the record of 1,174 set from 2004-08 by Natalie Doma of Idaho State. Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Amy Patton is chasing a record of her own. She is chasing the career points scored. She currently ranks ninth in Big Sky history with 1,725 points. She just passed MSU alum Katie Bussey, who had 1,710. The record of 2,296 was also set by Natalie Doma from 2004-08.

**Individual Single-Game Ranks:** On Nov. 24, NAU's Amy Patton tied the single-game record for points scored with 41 against Bradley. She became the fourth person to tie that record...That same game, Patton had 10 steals, which ranks tied for second in single game, and she also is tied for third in field-goals attempted with 29...On Dec. 1, against Oregon State, SAC's Se'nyce Parris made nine 3-pointers, which ties for first in single-game history. She also ranks tied for seventh with 39 points scored. And on Nov. 24, PSU's Angela Misa had 21 rebounds against Butler, which ranks tied for sixth in a single game.

**Team Single-Game Ranks:** On Dec. 8, Southern Utah scored 15 3-pointers against San Jose State. That ranks tied for fourth in a single-game...Northern Colorado ranks four times in a single-game as they defeated Johnson & Wales on Dec. 30. NC ranks tied for first in rebounds with 71, tied for fourth in 3-point field-goals made with 15, eighth in 3-point field-goals attempted with 36, and tied for ninth with 102 points scored.

## UM'S BAKER, SAC'S HILLIARD NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (January 14, 2013) - Montana's Katie Baker and Sacramento State's Fantasia Hilliard have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Co-Players of the Week for the games played the week of Jan. 7-Jan. 13.

Baker, a senior from Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, averaged 17.5 points on 50-percent shooting and 7.0 rebounds in leading Montana to a pair of home victories last week over North Dakota and Northern Colorado. She also went 7-of-8 from the free throw line.

Baker had 17 points and four rebounds in Thursday's 77-45 victory over North Dakota. She hit seven of her 11 field goal attempts and added two blocks as the Lady Griz limited UND to 28.3-percent shooting.

In Saturday's 56-42 victory over Northern Colorado, Baker totaled 18 points and 10 rebounds, her fourth double-double in six games and the 16th of her career. She also added four steals and three assists, both season highs.

After the Bears had cut a 17-point second-half deficit to nine with seven minutes to play, Baker scored the game's next six points to up Montana's advantage to 15.

Hilliard, sophomore from Sacramento, Calif., Hilliard scored 34 points and tallied 16 assists combined in Sacramento State's pair of Big Sky Conference wins over the weekend.

In helping the Hornets remain undefeated at home this season, Hilliard shined against Eastern Washington on Saturday. She scored a career-high 22 points on 7-of-9 shooting with a game-high seven assists. She went 7-of-9 from the field, 3-of-3 from 3-point range and was also a perfect 5-of-5 at the free throw line.

On Thursday versus Portland State the point guard had 12 points on 5-of-7 shooting plus nine assists. Hilliard is scoring a team-best 15.6 points per game in Big Sky play and has eclipsed 10+ points in all five league games. She is shooting 44.1 percent from the field and 46.7 percent from 3-point range in league games.

## LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

**Melissa Williams, Eastern Washington** - Williams had the best weekend of her career, posting back-to-back double-doubles in Eastern's pair of road games at Northern Arizona and Sacramento State. She averaged 11.5 points (nearly triple her season average) and 11.0 rebounds, while also leading the team in assists with seven. Against the Lumberjacks, Williams had a career high in both points and rebounds, as she finished with 13 tallies on 4-of-8 shooting and grabbed 11 boards. She also had four assists, one block and one steal in a career-high 34 minutes on the floor. Two days later against the Hornets, she had 10 points and 11 rebounds, to go along with three assists and two steals.

**Abyee Maracigan, Idaho State** - Maracigan posted her first career double-double Thursday night, with a career-high 21 points and 10 rebounds, helping ISU defeat SUU 80-71. Maracigan scored 13 points in the first nine minutes of the game to help ISU jump out to a 41-18 lead at the half. ISU made 10 3-point shots in the contest, four of them were made by Maracigan. The win against SUU broke a four-game losing skid for the Bengals.

**Rachel Semansky, Montana State** - Semansky averaged 16 points and five rebounds per game, while shooting 57 percent (12-21) from the field and 80 percent (8-10) from the line as the Bobcats held onto first place in the Big Sky Conference with a pair of home victories over Northern Colorado and North Dakota. MSU's 65-58 win over previously unbeaten UNC was the Bobcats' second straight game defeating the top squad in the league at the time. Against the Bears, Semansky led the Bobcats with 17 points, while hauling down four rebounds, dishing out two assists and adding two blocks. On Saturday, the 6-foot forward from Highwood, Mont., posted a game-high 15 points, while pulling down six rebounds, with an assist and a block.

**Amy Patton, Northern Arizona** - Patton averaged 16.5 points, 11.5 rebounds, and 4.5 assists per game with two double-doubles as NAU defeated Eastern Washington and lost by one point to Portland State. She shot 9-of-20 with 23 points, 11 rebounds, three assists, and two steals while playing all 40 minutes to lead NAU to a 83-68 home win over Eastern Washington on Thursday. She then totaled 10 points, 12 rebounds, six assists, and two steals in 40 minutes against Portland State for her fourth double-double of the season. The Big Sky's leading scorer at 20.5 points per game, Patton moved to ninth in Big Sky history in career scoring with her performances last week.

**Lauren Oosdyke, Northern Colorado** - Scored a season-high 23 at Montana State. Recorded her first double-double of the year with 11 points and a career-high tying 13 rebounds at Montana. Moved into 13th on the Big Sky Conference career free throws made list with 347 after going 7-for-8 on the weekend.

**Angela Misa, Portland State** - Misa helped the Vikings to a Big Sky Conference road split last weekend while recording a pair of double-doubles. For the weekend, Misa averaged 17.5 points and 13.5 rebounds per game. She shot .517 (15-29) from the field and .833 (5-6) from the free throw line...In the Vikings first game of the week, Misa scored a game-high 20 points (8-16 FG) with 12 rebounds. She went a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line and recorded a pair of steals in the Vikings' 81-77 loss at Sacramento State...She followed that performance with a 15 point, 15 rebound game in PSU's 60-59 win over Northern Arizona. She went 7-13 from the field and recorded two assists and two steals while playing a season-high 35 minutes...For the season, Misa is averaging 10.7 points and 10.9 rebounds per game. She is shooting .445 from the field has seven double-doubles, five in Big Sky play.

**Carli Moreland, Southern Utah** - Moreland scored 33 points in two games last week to help Southern Utah split a pair of road contests at Idaho State and Weber State. The junior forward was the Thunderbirds top-scorer in both games, shooting 60 percent from the field and 75 percent from the foul line. She also pulled down 11 rebounds and handed out three assists in the two-game set. For the season Moreland is averaging over seven points a game and nearly six rebounds while posting a field goal percentage mark of 48 percent. She also leads the team with 11 blocks on the year.
