# BIG SKY HIGHLIGHTS

**Coming Up:** This week's action will begin on Monday, when Southern Utah hosts Montana at 7:05 p.m. Mountain, and Eastern Washington travels to Portland State for a 7:35 p.m. tip off. If you can't make it to the game you can watch it for free on Big Sky TV...Conference play will continue on Thursday and Saturday.

**Watching Career Records:** Kylie Kuhns ranks third in career rebounds with 1,069. She is chasing the record of 1,174 set from 2004-08 by Natalie Doma of Idaho State. Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Amy Patton is chasing a record of her own. She is chasing the career points scored. She currently ranks seventh in Big Sky history with 1,755 points. The record of 2,296 was also set by Natalie Doma from 2004-08.

**Individual Single-Game Ranks:** On Nov. 24, NAU's Amy Patton tied the single-game record for points scored with 41 against Bradley. She became the fourth person to tie that record...That same game, Patton had 10 steals, which ranks tied for second in single game, and she also is tied for third in field-goals attempted with 29...On Dec. 1, against Oregon State, SAC's Se'nyce Parris made nine 3-pointers, which ties for first in single-game history. She also ranks tied for seventh with 39 points scored. And on Nov. 24, PSU's Angela Misa had 21 rebounds against Butler, which ranks tied for sixth in a single game.

**Team Single-Game Ranks:** On Dec. 8, Southern Utah scored 15 3-pointers against San Jose State. That ranks tied for fourth in a single-game...Northern Colorado ranks four times in a single-game as they defeated Johnson & Wales on Dec. 30. NC ranks tied for first in rebounds with 71, tied for fourth in 3-point field-goals made with 15, eighth in 3-point field-goals attempted with 36, and tied for ninth with 102 points scored.

## EWU'S HODGINS, MSU'S ADAMS NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (January 21, 2013) - Eastern Washington's Hayley Hodgins and Montana State's Latisha Adams have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Co-Players of the Week for the games played the week of Jan. 14-Jan. 20.

Hodgins, a redshirt freshman from Pasco, Wash., led EWU to an important home sweep, as the Eagles won back-to-back games against North Dakota and Northern Colorado (63-38). The redshirt-freshman averaged 16.5 points per game, while shooting 71 percent from the field. She also added six rebounds and three blocked shots during the weekend. Hodgins earned her first-career start on Saturday against UNC, and did not miss a single shot all game, going 7-of-7 from the field and 3-of-3 from long range. She finished with a career-high 17 points, and became the first player in the Big Sky this year to shoot 100 percent from the field with at least five attempts.

Against UND, Hodgins scored 16 points on 5-of-10 shooting from the floor, including 2-of-4 from downtown, and a 4-of-6 effort at the free throw line. She also contributed three rebounds and three blocked shots, as EWU rallied from an 11-point deficit in the second half to beat North Dakota, 75-72. In the last four games, Hodgins has scored 59 points for the Eags - 21 more than her total from the previous 12 appearances this season, and she has averaged 26.8 minutes per game.

Adams, a senior from Albuquerque, N.M., led Montana State in scoring as the Bobcats won two road games last week to take over sole possession atop the Big Sky Conference standings. For the week, the 5-foot-9 guard averaged 14.5 points and 2.5 rebounds, while shooting 47 percent from the field and 100 percent (10-10) from the line. In addition, she added four assists, four steals and a blocked shot. Against Southern Utah, Adams posted 16 points, but more importantly, took over the game in the second half, notching 12 points and connecting on 8-of-8 from the free throw line, including four straight makes in the final minute to secure the win.

For the third time in the last four games at Dahlberg Arena, Adams guided Montana State to a win over Montana. On Saturday, Adams recorded a team-high 13 points, converting five-of-11 from the field, including one three-pointer, which gave the Bobcats a 13-point lead with 10:11 remaining in the game. Her bucket at the 4:44 mark helped stave off a Lady Griz rally and her two charity tosses with 1:03 left secured the win. For the third straight week, Montana State knocked off a team that was in first place- the second time on the road.

## LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

**Ashleigh Vella, Idaho State** - In a tough 3-game week on the road, ISU went a perfect 3-0 and were led by senior forward Ashleigh Vella who averaged 14.3 points per contest and 5.3 rebounds. Vella also recorded 11 assists and three steals over the 3-game week. Vella led the Bengals against Northern Arizona tallying 18 points with seven rebounds. When ISU handed Sacramento State its first home loss of the season, Vella posted nine points and five rebounds. Against Weber State, Vella was just behind lead scorer Kaela Oakes, tying a season-high 16 points. In the game, Vella hit two 3-point shots and pulled down six rebounds while posting a season-high seven assists. Vella shot 51.9 percent overall for the week and went 45.5 percent from 3-point range. She was a perfect 10-10 from the free throw line.

**Katie Baker, Montana** - Baker scored a game-high 23 points and added 12 rebounds, her fifth double-double in seven Big Sky Conference games, as Montana lost at home Saturday to Montana State 58-49 in the Lady Griz' only game of the week. Baker went 10 for 17 from the field on a day when her teammates combined to shoot 9 for 46 (.196).

**Amy Patton, Northern Arizona** - Patton averaged a double-double with 15.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game while shooting 45.5% from the field as NAU defeated Weber State and lost to Idaho State. On Thursday against Weber State Patton shot 11-of-22 from the field with game highs of 22 points, 12 rebounds, and three steals to lead the Lumberjacks to a 76-55 win. Patton followed with eight points, eight rebounds, three assists and a steal against Idaho State. NAU's all-time leading scorer, Patton also moved to second in program history in career rebounds with her totals last week. She continues to lead the Big Sky with 19.8 points per game this season and is third in the conference with 8.4 rebounds per game.

**Allison Greene, Portland State** - Greene helped Portland State to a split last weekend. She led the Vikings with 13 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting .440 from the field. She also recorded four assists and four steals...Greene started the week with a eight point, eight rebound performance in PSU's loss to Northern Colorado. She then scored 18 points, one shy of her career high, with five rebounds, three assists, and two steals in the Vikings' win over North Dakota. She shot .583 (7-12) from the floor...For the season, Greene is averaging 9.2 points per game with 3.2 rebounds. She is also averaging 2.0 assists and 1.9 steals per contest this season.

**Kylie Kuhns, Sacramento State** - Kuhns shot 57.9 percent from the field as the Hornets split a pair of home games against Idaho State and Weber State. Kuhns totaled 25 points and 11 rebounds with four blocks, three assists, two steals and just one turnover in two games. Kuhns scored a team-high 15 points on 6-for-12 shooting with seven rebounds in a loss to the Bengals and tallied 10 points on 5-of-7 shooting with four rebounds in just 19 minutes against the Wildcats. Kuhns leads the Big Sky Conference in rebounding and is third in field goal percentage.

**Kimie Hawkins, Southern Utah** - Hawkins led the Thunderbirds in scoring with 12 points against Montana State in Southern Utah's only game last week. The senior forward was 4-5 at the foul line and pulled down five rebounds against the Bobcats. She also handed out two assists and came up with one steal.
