Coming Up: This week's action begins on Thursday with five games. Starting at 7:05 p.m. Mountain, Montana will host Portland State, Eastern Washington will travel to Montana State, North Dakota and Weber State tip off in Ogden, Utah, and Idaho State hosts Northern Colorado. At 7:05 p.m. Pacific, Northern Arizona will travel to Sacramento State. If you can't make it to any of the games this weekend you can catch them on Big Sky TV for free.

Watching Career Records: Kylie Kuhns ranks third in career rebounds with 1,081. She is chasing the record of 1,174 set from 2004-08 by Natalie Doma of Idaho State. Kuhns became the fifth player in Big Sky history to have more than 1,000 rebounds...Amy Patton is chasing a record of her own. She is chasing the career points scored. Currently she is ranked sixth in Big Sky history with 1,792 points. The record of 2,296 was also set by Natalie Doma from 2004-08.

Individual Single-Game Ranks: On Nov. 24, NAU's Amy Patton tied the single-game record for points scored with 41 against Bradley. She became the fourth person to tie that record...That same game, Patton had 10 steals, which ranks tied for second in single game, and she also is tied for third in field-goals attempted with 29...On Dec. 1, against Oregon State, SAC's Se'nyce Parris made nine 3-pointers, which ties for first in single-game history. She also ranks tied for seventh with 39 points scored. And on Nov. 24, PSU's Angela Misa had 21 rebounds against Butler, which ranks tied for sixth in a single game.

Team Single-Game Ranks: On Dec. 8, Southern Utah scored 15 3-pointers against San Jose State. That ranks tied for fourth in a single-game...Northern Colorado ranks four times in a single-game as they defeated Johnson & Wales on Dec. 30. NC ranks tied for first in rebounds with 71, tied for fourth in 3-point field-goals made with 15, eighth in 3-point field-goals attempted with 36, and tied for ninth with 102 points scored.

NC'S OOSDYKE NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (January 28, 2013) - Northern Colorado's Lauren Oosdyke has been named Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the games played the week of Jan. 21-27.

Oosdyke, a senior from Coto de Caza, Calif., scored over 20 points in both home victories for the Bears, scoring a season-high 24 points over Northern Arizona and following it up with 21 in the win over Sacramento State on Saturday.

Oosdyke shot .680 (17-for-25) from the floor, including an 11-for-12 performance inside the arc against the Lumberjacks. She nailed a career-best three 3-pointers against the Hornets and made 8-of-10 from the free throw line.

Oosdyke also averaged 6.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game for the week and turned the ball over just twice in 69 minutes - with none against the pressure defense of Sacramento State. She scored her 1,300th career point, moving into seventh with 1,339 on the Northern Colorado career charts.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Kylie Huerta, Eastern Washington - Sophomore point guard Kylie Huerta led EWU to another perfect week of Big Sky action, as Eastern went 2-0 with a road win at Portland State and a home victory against Southern Utah...Huerta averaged 10 points and 7.5 assists in the two games combined, and posted two different career highs. Against the T-Birds, Huerta was just one assist shy of a double-double, as she scored 12 points and had a career-high nine assists to lead her team to a 79-70 win. She was 4-of-7 from the field, including 2-of-2 from beyond the arc, and made both her attempts at the charity stripe. The 5-foot-1 guard had nine assists and just two turnovers in 37 minutes on the floor...Against Portland State, Huerta had an all-around impact, with a career-high five steals, to go along with eight points, six assists and three rebounds. Huerta, the shortest player in the Big Sky, ranks third in league-only statistics for assists and is first in assist-to-turnover ratio.

Ashleigh Vella, Idaho State - Senior forward Ashleigh Vella led the Bengals past conference leader Montana State Saturday. Vella scored a season-high 22 points with seven rebounds, three assists, two blocks and a steal in 34 minutes. Against Montana she tabbed 12 points with three rebounds, three assists and a block. ISU broke MSU's seven-game win streak and created a tie for first place between UM and MSU.

Kenzie De Boer, Montana - De Boer averaged 16.7 points, 3.7 rebounds and 3.3 steals as Montana completed a three-game road-trip sweep last week. De Boer shot 45.5 percent from the field in the three wins and went 7 for 13 (.538) from 3-point range and 13 for 16 (.813) from the line as the Lady Griz moved into a first-place tie with Montana State at the midway points of the season...De Boer, a 1,000-point career scorer, had the best offensive game of her career in Monday's 78-63 win at Southern Utah. With 27 points she was two off her career high, but she scored those points on just 12 shot attempts. She went 9 for 12 from the field, 5 for 7 from 3-point range and 4 for 5 from the line while adding four steals...De Boer had 8 points, 4 rebounds and 3 steals in Thursday's 57-52 win at Idaho State, then added 15 points, 5 rebounds and 3 steals in Saturday's 61-53 win at Weber State.

Kalli Durham, Montana State - Durham averaged 14.5 points per game as the Bobcats went 1-1 on the road this weekend. The Miles City, Mont., native had her best game of the weekend at Idaho State, notching a team-high 20 points on seven-of-15 from the field, including three 3-pointers. For the weekend, Durham shot 48 percent from the field and added two rebounds, two steals and an assist.

Madi Buck, North Dakota - Buck registered back-to-back double-doubles last week, as UND split with Sacramento State and Northern Arizona. Buck scored 11 and grabbed 10 rebounds against the Hornets on Thursday, then poured-in 14 first-half points en route to a 16-point, 11-rebound effort in the win over the Lumberjacks Saturday.

Aubrey Davis, Northern Arizona - Davis averaged 11.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 2.0 blocks per game while shooting 52.6% for the week. She totaled a career-high 18 points with 10 rebounds, three blocks, and one assist on 8-of-14 shooting on Saturday at North Dakota. On Thursday at Northern Colorado, Davis posted four points, three rebounds, and a block in 20 minutes. She totaled just one turnover in 53 minutes played and shot 10-of-19 overall from the field.

Allison Greene, Portland State - Sophomore guard Allison Greene led the Vikings this past week averaging 15 points and five rebounds per game while tallying five assists and three steals. She averaged 38.5 minutes over the span shooting .423 (11-26 FG) from the floor while going 7-of-8 from the free throw line...Greene started the week with a 14 point, four rebound performance playing 35 minutes against Eastern Washington. She went 6-for-13 from the floor with a 3-pointer. She added her third straight double-digit scoring performance with 16 points against Southern Utah in a career-high 42 minute. She went 3-for-13 from the field against the Thunderbirds while going a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw line. She added six rebounds in the game.

Andrea Jones, Southern Utah - Junior guard Andrea Jones averaged 10.7 points a game in Southern Utah's three outings last week while shooting 37 percent from the floor. The biggest moment of the week for Jones came at Portland State where she scored the final two baskets of the game to cap a 10-0 run that saw the Thunderbirds rally for a 70-68 win in overtime. She also had a team-high 18 points against Montana earlier in the week while recording a total of 11 steals, six assists and five rebounds in the three-game set. Jones currently ranks sixth in the Big Sky with an average of 3.1 apg and thirteenth in steals at 1.8 spg.
