MSU'S SEMANSKY AND NAU'S FROST NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (January 7, 2013) - Montana State's Rachel Semansky and Northern Arizona's Amanda Frost have been named the Big Sky Conference Women's Basketball Co-Players of the Week for the games played the week of Dec. 31-Jan. 6.

Semansky, a senior from Highwood, Mont., helped the Bobcats go 2-0 last week with a couple of Big Sky Conference road wins against Portland State (81-74) and Eastern Washington (73-60).

For the weekend, Semansky averaged 21 points and 6.5 rebounds, while shooting an impressive 72 percent (13-18) from the field and 84 percent (16-19) from the free throw line. In MSU's first outing of the weekend, Semansky tied the MSU school-record going 12-of-12 from the free throw line to finish with a game-high 22 points, while adding five rebounds, two assists, two steals and a blocked shot.

She followed that effort as the Bobcats snapped EWU's five-game winning streak, posting 20 points (8-10 FGs), eight rebounds and an assist. On the season, the forward has recorded four games with 20 or more points. She also leads the Big Sky in field-goal percentage, a spot she's held the past two seasons. Her 764 career rebounds moves her into third on MSU's all-time list, while her 1,154 career points are 14th all-time. Semansky also became just the third Bobcat in history to record over 1,110 points and 750 rebounds.

Frost, a junior from Riverside, Calif., scored a career-high 27 points in her first game of the season to lead NAU to a 71-61 road win over Southern Utah. She shot 10-of-15 from the field including 3-of-5 from 3-point range, while adding three assists, two steals, two rebounds, and a block in 36 minutes. She was playing in her first game of the year after suffering an injury the week before the start of the season.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Carrie Ojeda, Eastern Washington - Ojeda averaged nearly a double-double of 11.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game in Eastern's split this week against Montana and Montana State. The Eagles defeated the Lady Griz, 58-56, before falling in a tight contest to Montana State, 73-60. Against the Bobcats, Ojeda had an impressive all-around game, as she registered her fourth double-double of the year with 13 points and 10 rebounds, and also had a team-leading four assists, two blocks and two steals. She was 5-of-6 from the free throw line as well. In the win over Montana, she had nine points, seven rebounds.

Lindsey Reed, Idaho State - Reed led ISU in its 64-59 loss to North Dakota. Reed scored 16 points in the second half alone on her way to an 18-point performance. She also had three rebounds, one assist and a steal against UND. Against Northern Colorado, she scored in double figures again as she scored 10 points in the second half alone to bring her game total to 15. She also added four rebounds, one assist and a block in 36 minutes of play. In Big Sky play, Reed leads the Bengals, averaging 14.0 points per game.

Katie Baker, Montana - Baker posted a pair of double-doubles as Montana split the Eastern Washington-Portland State road trip. She averaged 15 points, 14 rebounds and 3 blocks as the Lady Griz lost to the Eagles 58-56 and defeated the Vikings 70-55...Baker had 13 points on 5-of-9 shooting, 12 rebounds and 3 blocks in Thursday's loss at EWU. In Saturday's win over PSU, she had 17 points, a season-high 16 boards and 3 blocks for her 15th career double-double as she moved into 18th place on the Montana career scoring list (1,154).

Madi Buck, North Dakota - Buck led UND with 18 points and seven rebounds to help North Dakota defeat the defending league champion Idaho State Bengals, 64-59 Thursday night. Buck followed that with a 10-point, seven-rebound effort in Saturday's blowout win over Weber State to give her four straight games with double-digit point totals and nine for the season. UND takes to the road for its next four, beginning with a Thursday night tilt at Montana.

Lauren Oosdyke, Northern Colorado - Oosdyke scored season-highs in back-to-back games with 17 in the win over Weber State and followed it up with 21 in the win over Idaho State. After the Bengals went on a 15-0 run to cut the Bears lead to three, Oosdyke scored seven straight, including a banked 3-pointer as the shot clock expired to extend the lead back to eight. She also made both free throws in the final 2:36 after ISU head coach Seton Sobolewski was called for a technical. Oosdyke added 10 rebounds, four assists and five steals in the two games to go along with her 19.0 points per game.

Courtney VanBrocklin, Portland State - VanBrocklin averaged 23.5 ppg this past week. She shot .371 (13-35) from the field and .500 (5-10) from three-point range while playing all but five minutes for the Vikings... VanBrocklin started the weekend with a 21-point six-assist performance against Montana State. She hit a pair of three pointers, pulled down three rebounds, and went 9-11 from the free-throw line against the Bobcats... VanBrocklin then matched her career high with 26 points against Montana. She shot .500 (8-16) from the field with a trio of three-pointers and four rebounds while playing 38 minutes...On the season, VanBrocklin is averaging 15.9 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 3.0 apg while averaging 33.2 minutes. She has led the Vikings in scoring eight times including each of the last three games.

Kimie Hawkins, Southern Utah - Hawkins scored a career-high 22 points to lead Southern Utah to a 79-71 victory over Sacramento State on Saturday. The senior forward went 10-14 from the field and hit a pair of free throws while also grabbing eight rebounds. For the week, Hawkins averaged 12.0 ppg, 6.5 rpg, 2.0 apg and 1.0 spg while shooting over 50 percent from the floor.
