A trio of Big Sky teams - Montana State, Eastern Washington and Cal Poly - are perfect in conference play as league action enters its fourth weekend...Cal Poly puts its 2-0 conference mark on the line against No. 10 Montana...No. 5 Montana State, which had a bye last week, looks to move to 3-0 when it travels to Weber State. That game will be televised live on ROOT SPORTS...No. 4 Eastern Washington will try to move to 3-0 as it plays host to Southern Utah (2-1, 5-2). Southern Utah handed Eastern Washington its only league loss last season...No. 19 Northern Arizona, which rallied for a 39-38 win over Sacramento State last week, returns home to face Idaho State. The Bengals snapped a 17-game conference losing streak last week, but will be seeking their first win in Flagstaff since 1984....UC Davis, which suffered its first league loss of the season last week at the hands of Montana, is on the road against Northern Colorado. The Bears are hoping to snap a six-game slide...Sacramento State (2-1) travels to North Dakota. UND will be playing its fifth home game of the season...Portland State has a bye this week.

ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Oct. 14

OFFENSE - Luke Austin, WR, Idaho State



Austin, a 6-foot-1, 185-pound senior from Boise, Idaho, caught eight passes for a career-high 173 yards and three touchdowns in Idaho State's 40-26 win over Northern Colorado. Austin's TD catches were for 7, 15, and 74 yards. Austin helped Idaho State snap a 17-game losing streak to conference teams. This is Austin's first ROOT SPORTS Player of the Week honor.

OFFENSE - Chase Cartwright, QB, No. Arizona



Cartwright, a 6-3, 215-pound junior from Chandler, Ariz., came off the bench in the third quarter to ignite Northern Arizona to a 39-38 come-from-behind win over Sacramento State. Cartwright completed 16-of-19 passes for 208 yards and three touchdowns with no interceptions. He had a QB rating of 228.3. Northern Arizona trailed by 17 points when Cartwright came off the bench. He guided

NAU on four straight TD drives, the first three ending in touchdown passes. This is Cartwright's first ROOT SPORTS Player of the Week honor.

DEFENSE - Tyree Mills, CB, Southern Utah



Mills, a 6-2, 178-pound senior from Pasadena, Calif., tallied nine tackles - eight solo - with two interceptions and three pass breakups in Southern Utah's 17-7 win over Portland State. Southern Utah was clinging to a 10-7 fourth-quarter lead when Mills intercepted a Collin Ramirez pass and returned it 41 yards to the Portland State 1-yard line. SUU scored a touchdown three plays later to go ahead 17-7. This is Mills' first ROOT SPORTS Player of the Week honor.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Brock Miller, P, Southern Utah



Miller, a 5-11, 182-pound senior from Solana Beach, Calif., averaged 48.6 yards per punt with three inside the Portland State 20-yard line in the Southern Utah's 17-7 win over the Vikings. Miller had a long punt of 65 yards. He had punts downed at the Portland State 5, 8 and 6 yard lines. Miller is Southern Utah's all-time leader with an average of 43.2 yards per punt. This is Miller's second career ROOT SPORTS Player of the Week honor.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

THREE UNDEFEATED: The top of the Big Sky standings currently look a lot like the end of the 2012 season standings. Cal Poly, Eastern Washington and Montana State are all 2-0 in conference, the three remaining teams unblemished in league play. Cal Poly, Eastern Washington and Montana State all tied for the 2012 conference title with 7-1 conference records. There is very little margin forever, however, as five teams currently sit at 2-1 in conference. Montana, Northern Arizona, Sacramento State, Southern Utah, and UC Davis are all 2-1 in conference. Eastern Washington plays host to Southern Utah on Saturday, while Cal Poly travels to Montana.

BAUMAN UP TO SEVENTH: Northern Arizona senior running back Zach Bauman rushed 27 times for 196 yards and two touchdowns in the Lumberjacks' 39-38 win over Sacramento State. Bauman moved into seventh place on the Big Sky's all-time rushing list, surpassing former Eastern Washington great Jesse Chatman, who had 4,173 yards from 1999-2001. Bauman has 4,294 rushing yards. Bauman needs 182 yards to move into sole possession of sixth place. Bauman now has 5,330 career all-purpose yards, which ranks 11th in Big Sky history. He needs 99 yards to move into sole possession of 10th place on the all-time list. Bauman has 21 career 100-yard rushing games.

OFFENSIVE IGNITERS: Cal Poly's Dano Graves started for the first time this season, leading the Mustangs to a 47-0 win over Weber State. Graves, a sophomore transfer from Air Force, became the third QB to start for Cal Poly this season. Graves rushed 17 times for a team-high 116 yards. He also completed 13 of 16 passes for 169 yards with three touchdowns and no interceptions. Northern Arizona junior Chase Cartwright came off the bench in the third quarter and guided the Lumberjacks to a come-from-behind 39-38 win over Sacramento State. Cartwright entered the game in the third quarter with the Lumberjacks trailing 31-14. Cartwright, who started two games in 2012, but had yet to play this season, completed 16 of 19 passes for 208 yards with three touchdowns and no interceptions.

BENGALS SNAP CONFERENCE SKID: Idaho State snapped a 17-game conference losing streak with a 40-26 home win over Northern Colorado. Idaho State had lost 21 straight to Division I competition dating back to a 50-20 win over Northern Colorado on Sept. 17, 2011. Idaho State is 3-3, its best start after six games since 2005 when the Bengals were 4-2. Idaho State has matched its win total from the previous two seasons combined. Xavier Finney rushed for 146 yards in the win on Saturday, becoming the first Bengal to reach the century mark since the final game of the 2009 season. It was the most rushing yards by a Bengal since Josh Barnett rushed for 173 yards against Northern Colorado in 2006.

MCGHEE ON VERGE OF ELITE LIST: Montana State senior quarterback DeNarius McGhee enters Saturday's game against Weber State with 9,840 career passing yards. McGhee needs 160 passing yards to become the third player in Big Sky history to throw for 10,000 yards and rush for 1,000 yards in his career. McGhee currently has 1,008 career rushing yards. Former Montana State QB Travs Lulay threw for 10,746 yards and rushed for 1,459. Nussmeier, who played for Idaho from 1990-93, threw for 10,824 and rushed for 1,230. McGhee has 10,848 career all-purpose yards, which ranks 10th in Big Sky history. McGhee needs 95 yards to move into ninth place past Erik Meyer of EWU.

BOBCATS, WILDCATS ON ROOT SPORTS: Montana State makes its 2013 debut on ROOT SPORTS on Saturday as it travels to Weber State. Coverage from Stewart Stadium in Ogden begins at 3:30 p.m. Mountain. Tom Glasgow, Robb Akey and Jen Mueller will call the game. The game will be televised live on ROOT SPORTS, as well at DIRECTV's Audience Network Channel 101. Weber State opened the season with a 50-40 home win over Stephen F. Austin. Montana State lost at Stephen F. Austin 52-38 on Sept. 21. Montana State has not lost in Ogden since 1996.

KUPP NAMED TO RICE WATCH LIST: Eastern Washington freshman wide receiver Cooper Kupp was named to the Jerry Rice Award Watch List last week. The Rice is awarded by the Sports Network to the top freshman in the FCS. Kupp has caught 22 passes for 427 yards and ranks second in the league with eight touchdown catches.

KRAMER THIRD IN LEAGUE WINS: Idaho State coach Mike Kramer won his 55th career conference game on Saturday, moving him into sole possession of third place on the conference wins list. Nevada's Chris Ault is the all-time leader with 68 wins. Northern Arizona coach Jerome Souers has won 57 conference games. Montana's Don Read is fourth with 54 wins. Cal Poly's Tim Walsh is in fifth place with 51 conference wins.

SKY IN THE SAGARIN: Three Big Sky teams are ranked in the top 11 FCS teams in this week's Jeff Sagarin Ratings. Eastern Washington is seventh among FCS teams and 87th overall. Montana is eighth, and Montana State is 11th. Northern Arizona is 25th. The Big Sky is ranked fourth among FCS conferences, behind the Missouri Valley, Colonial and Southland.

THREE SKY TEAMS IN THE TOP 10: Montana State, Eastern Washington and Montana are all ranked in the top 10 of both major FCS Top 25 polls this week. Northern Arizona is also ranked in both polls. In the Sports Network Poll, Eastern Washington is fourth, Montana State is fifth, Montana is 10th, and Northern Arizona is 19th. In the Coaches' Poll, Montana State is fifth, Eastern Washington is sixth, Montana is ninth, and Northern Arizona is 21st. North Dakota State is first in both polls, followed by Sam Houston State and Eastern Illinois.

Extra points: Sacramento State's DeAndre Carter has caught a TD pass in five straight games...EWU's Ronnie Hamlin had a 77-yard interception return for a touchdown in the Eagles' 35-14 win over North Dakota. It was the 10th-longest INT return in school history...PSU's Kyle Loomis, who ranks second in the nation in punting, averaged 50.7 yards per punt against Southern Utah...PSU's seven point output in a loss to Southern Utah was its fewest points in a league game since suffering a 14-0 shutout to Montana State on Oct. 7, 2006...Montana's Anthony Goodwin leads the nation with an average of 2.3 pass breakups per game...EWU's Vernon Adams is second in the nation in passing touchdowns with 21...Weber State's 47-0 loss to Cal Poly marked its first time being shutout against a Big Sky team since losing 34-0 to Idaho State in 2002...The shut-out was Cal Poly's first since the final game of the 2006 season...Sacramento State has been called for just one penalty for five years in each of the last two weeks...Northern Colorado's Jace Davis caught six passes for 188 yards and a touchdown in a loss to Idaho State. It was the fourth-highest total for Northern Colorado in its Division I history. Davis has three of the top five games. Davis has 2,409 career receiving yards, tops for the Bears in the Division I era...Northern Arizona is 6-1 against conference opponents on the road since the start of the 2012 season...Through 18 conference games, home teams are 9-9...EWU All-American CB T.J. Lee III has six career forced fumbles, which is tied for the school record...Freshman LB Chinedo Ahanonu had nine tackles (eight solo with one TFL) in his first game as Southern Utah pulled his redshirt season because of injuries.
