Eastern Washington enters 3-0 in league and 5-2 overall. Montana is 3-1, 6-1...No. 5 Montana State returns home to face a dangerous UC Davis squad in another battle of top league teams. Montana State is 3-0 in league, while UC Davis comes to Bozeman 3-1 in conference...No. 16 Northern Arizona hits the road to face Cal Poly. The Lumberjacks are 3-1 in conference play and have won two in a row. Cal Poly (2-1, 3-4) is coming off a tough 21-14 overtime loss to Montana. The Mustangs notched their first ever win over NAU last year in Flagstaff...Portland State, coming off a bye week, will gun for its first conference win as it plays host to North Dakota. This will mark North Dakota's first game outdoors this season...Idaho State renews its rivalry with Southern Utah in Cedar City. The teams have not met since 2005...Northern Colorado, Weber State and Sacramento State all have the week off.

ROOT SPORTS Players of the Week Oct. 21

OFFENSE - Zach Bauman, Sr., RB, Northern Arizona



Bauman, a 5-foot-10, 200-pound senior from Chandler, Ariz., rushed for a career-high 266 yards and scored three touchdowns in Northern Arizona's 39-30 win over Idaho State. Bauman carried the ball 28 times and averaged 9.5 yards per carry. He scored on runs of 3 and 52 yards. Bauman also led the team in receiving with seven catches for 58 yards, including a 9-yard TD reception. Bauman's 324 all-purpose yards were the most in a game by a Big Sky player this season. Bauman moved into fifth place on the league's all-time rushing list with 4,560 yards. This is the Walter Payton Award candidates third career Player of the Week honor.

DEFENSE - Brock Coyle, Sr., LB, Montana



Coyle, a 6-2, 245-pound senior from Bozeman, Mont., tallied 15 tackles and the game-clinching interception in Montana's 21-14 overtime win over Cal Poly. Coyle had two tackles for loss and helped the Grizzly defense keep the Mustangs off the board in the second half and overtime. In overtime, Coyle intercepted Cal Poly quarterback Dano Graves' third-down pass at the 2-yard line to secure the victory. This is Coyle's second career Player of the Week honor.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Rory Perez, K, Montana State



Perez, a 6-2 199-pound senior from Moreno Valley, Calif., averaged 52 yards per punt in Montana State's 34-16 win over Weber State. Perez punted five times with a career-long of 68 yards. Three of his five punts pinned Weber State inside its own 20-yard line, including two inside the 10-yard line. This is Perez's second career Player of the Week honor.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

BAUMAN FIFTH ON ALL-TIME LIST: Northern Arizona's Zach Bauman rushed for a career-high 266 yards and two touchdowns in the Lumberjacks' 39-30 win over Idaho State. Bauman now ranks fifth on the Big Sky's all-time rushing with 4,570 yards. Bauman needs 171 yards to move past Portland State's Ryan Fuqua into fourth place. The Walter Payton Award candidate needs 440 yards to become just the fourth player in league history to rush for 5,000 yards. Bauman has also moved into eighth place on the Big Sky's career all-purpose yardage list with 5,654. Bauman is 268 yards away from seventh-place Pete Mandley of Northern Arizona, who holds the Lumberjack school record with 5,922 all-purpose yards. Bauman had 58 receiving yards and a touchdown against the Bengals, for a total of 324 all-purpose yards, which is tied for 19th all-time in Big Sky history. Bauman has 1,094 career receiving yards. He is one of two running backs in Big Sky history to rush for 4,000 yards and catch 1,000 yards worth of passes. Weber State's Trevyn Smith, who had 5,029 rushing yards and 1,349 receiving yards is the other. Bauman is second among active players in the FCS in rushing yards. Sam Houston State's Tim Flanders is first with 5,105. Bauman has 22 career 100-yard rushing games. Bauman needs 116 yards to become the ninth player in FCS history to rush for 1,000 yards in four straight seasons.

MCGHEE JOINS ELITE CLUB: Montana State senior quarterback DeNarius McGhee threw for a season-high 313 yards in the Bobcats' 34-16 win over Weber State on Saturday. It was McGhee's eight career 300-yard passing game. McGhee surpassed 10,000 career passing yards in the game, becoming the third player in league history and just the 11th in the history of college football to pass for 10,000 yards and rush for 1,000 in his career. McGhee has 10,153 career passing yards 1,019 career rushing yards. Former Montana State great Travis Lulay and former Idaho QB Doug Nussmeier, who is now the offensive coordinator at Alabama, are the other Big Sky players to reach the 10,000/1,000 club. McGhee has a 11,172 yards of total offense in his career, which ranks eighth all-time in Big Sky history. McGhee is the active FCS leader in total offense and is third in passing yards. McGhee owns a 34-9 record as the Bobcats' starting quarterback. The 34 victories rank second in league history behind Nevada's Eric Beavers.

200th GAME AT WASHINGTON-GRIZZLY STADIUM: Saturday's game between Eastern Washington and Montana will officially mark the 200th game at Washington-Grizzly Stadium. Since the stadium opened in 1986, Montana has amassed a 175-24 all-time record. Four victories from the 2011 season were wiped away by NCAA sanctions. Eastern Washington owns four victories at Washington-Grizzly Stadium, more than any other team. The Eagles have won there in 1990, 1992, 1997 and 2005. In 2012, Montana went 3-3 at home, marking the first time the Grizzlies lost more than twice in the same season at WGS.

ROOT SPORTS IN MISSOULA: ROOT SPORTS will televise the Montana-Eastern Washington game on Saturday. Coverage begins at 1:30 p.m. Mountain. Tom Glasgow, Jason Stiles and Brad Adam will call the game. It will be available on ROOT SPORTS, as well as DIRECTV's Audience Network channel 101. This marks the 12th time in the last 18 years that both No. 3 Eastern Washington and No. 10 Montana have been ranked heading into the contest. Its the first time both have been ranked in the top 10. UM has won the last three meetings in Missoula. EWU has won the last two meetings in Cheney.

THREE SKY TEAMS IN TOP 10: Three Big Sky teams are ranked in the top 10 of both major FCS polls this week. In the Sports Network Poll, Eastern Washington is third, Montana State is fifth, and Montana is 10th. In the Coaches' Poll, Eastern Washington is fourth, Montana State is fifth and Montana is 10th. Northern Arizona is also ranked in both polls. Northern Arizona is 16th in the Sports Network poll and 19th in the Coaches' Poll. North Dakota State is the unanimous No. 1 in both polls. Eastern Illinois is second in both polls.

SKY IN THE SAGARIN: Eastern Washington is the top Big Sky team in this week's Jeff Sagarin Ratings. Eastern Washington is rated 83rd overall and fifth among FCS teams. Montana State is among FCS team, while Montana is 10th. Five Big Sky teams are ranked in the top 30 FCS teams. Northern Arizona is 26, followed by Cal Poly at 28 and Sacramento State at 30. The Big Sky is ranked fourth among FCS conferences, behind the Missouri Valley, CAA and Southern.

TOPS IN ATTENDANCE: Montana continues to lead the FCS in average attendance. The Grizzlies drew 25,913 to last week's home game vs. Cal Poly. UM is averaging 25,906 fans per game. James Madison is second at 21,470. Montana State is fourth in average attendance at 19,960. Montana State, Montana and Eastern Washington are all averaging more than 100 percent of the listed capacity of their respective stadiums.

FIRST PICK FOR JOHNSON: Montana quarterback Jordan Johnson threw his first interception in the second quarter of Montana's 21-14 overtime win over Cal Poly. Johnson had thrown 156 passes dating back to the 2011 season without an interception. Johnson had attempted 142 passes this season until the interception. UM still leads the nation in fewest interceptions thrown with one.

BALDWIN ONE WIN FROM 50: Eastern Washington's Beau Baldwin enters Saturday's game at Montana with a record of 49-21 with the Eagles. Baldwin is looking to become the 15th coach to amass 50 career wins while coaching in the Big Sky. Baldwin is in his sixth season with the Eagles. Four active coaches have won at least 50 games in the Big Sky. Northern Arizona's Jerome Souers is second on the all-time wins list with 89. Idaho State's Mike Kramer is fourth with 83. Kramer won the majority of his games at Eastern Washington and Montana State. Cal Poly's Tim Walsh, who coached Portland State from 1996-2006 in the Big Sky, is sixth on the all-time list with 77 wins. Montana State's Rob Ash eighth on the all-time list with 55 wins. Ash needs four more wins to tie former Boise State coach Jim Criner for seventh place.

Extra points: Sacramento State is 3-1 in conference for the second straight season...UC Davis is 3-1 in conference. The Aggies finished 3-5 in league during their first year in the league...UC Davis has won back-to-back road games for the first time since 2010...Sacramento State's Morris Norrise is fourth among active FCS players with 186 catches. North Dakota's Greg Hardin is fifth with 183. Norrise has caught at least one pass in 22 straight games...Weber State true freshman QB Austin Chipoletti threw for a career-high 309 yards in a loss to Montana State. He also scored his first career rushing touchdown...Montana State's Brad Daly leads the nation in sacks per game and tackles for loss per game. He has 10 solo sacks and 15 solo tackles for loss...Northern Colorado's defense has combined for at least 100 tackles in three straight games...Northern Colorado's Tomaine Dennis rushed for 135 yards in a loss to UC Davis. He has 1,434 career rushing yards, which is the most by a Bear running back in the Division I era...Montana State's Steven Bethley returned a blocked extra point 100 yards for two points in the win over Weber State. It was the longest defensive conversion return in MSU history, and the first in the history of Stewart Stadium...Sacramento State's Brandon Kellerman rushed for a career-high 119 yards against North Dakota...Road teams won three conference games last week. Home teams are now 12-12 in conference games...Idaho State's Justin Arias threw for 390 yards in a loss to Northern Arizona...Cal Poly's Kristaan Ivory has rushed for at least 100 yards in all three conference games.
