## SACRAMENTO STATE'S DIETRICH NAMED BIG SKY CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

OGDEN, Utah (October 28, 2013) - Sacramento State's Courtney Dietrich has been named the Big Sky Conference Volleyball Player of the Week for the matches played the week of October 21 through October 27.

True freshman Dietrich helped the Hornets offensively, defensively, and with the serve as Sacramento State defeated both Portland State (3-1) and Eastern Washington (3-1) in two huge home matches last week. The middle blocker had at least seven blocks and eight kills, and hit for a high percentage in both matches. She posted averages of 2.25 kills, 1.88 blocks, 3.69 points and 0.38 aces per set while hitting a robust .382.

Dietrich had season highs in both kills (10) and blocks (8) while hitting .444 against Portland State. That included a block on match point to close a tightly fought win over the Vikings. She followed up that effort 24 hours later against Eastern Washington where she posted season highs in aces (3) and digs (6) to go along with eight kills, seven blocks and a .312 hitting percentage.

The Chelan, Wash., native committed just five errors in 34 attacks over the two matches, and combined to accumulate 29.5 points. During her two-match run, she posted season highs in kills, digs, aces and blocks, and her .444 hitting percentage against Portland State wasn't far off her season-best mark of .500.

## LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

**Talia Fermantez, Eastern Washington** - Fermantez led the Eagles with 11 kills against Sacramento State Saturday. She tied her season high with seven blocks and tallied a season-best four digs.

**Lori Mendenhall-Lee, Idaho State** - Mendenhall-Lee posted a career-high 73 kills in the Bengals 3-2 loss to Northern Arizona on Oct. 26. In that match, Mendenhall-Lee posted seven kills on 13 attempts for an attack percentage of .538. She had nine digs and two blocks...On Friday's 3-0 win over Southern Utah, Mendenhall-Lee posted 35 assists, six assists and four kills.

**Kelsey Schile, Montana** - Schile averaged 3.0 kills per set on .262 hitting and added 10 blocks as Montana went 2-1 on the week with a 3-1 victory at home over Montana State, a 3-0 loss at North Dakota and a 3-2 win at Northern Colorado...In Monday's four-set win over the Bobcats, Schile had 17 kills and 8 blocks, both season highs, while hitting .344. Following a 5-kill performance at North Dakota, Schile totaled 14 kills on .300 hitting in Saturday's win over the Bears.

**Anna Pioske, North Dakota** - Pioske helped lead North Dakota to a pair of home sweeps this week, cruising past Montana and Montana State, respectively, to remain atop the Big Sky Conference standings. Pioske nearly averaged a double-double with 12 kills and 9.5 digs per match. She started the week with a 9-kill, 13-dig performance in the win over the Griz Thursday. She followed that with a match-high 15 kills in the win over the Bobcats Saturday. It was her fifth match this season eclipsing the 15-kill mark and North Dakota is now 4-1 in those matches. For the week, Pioske hit .254 with 24 kills and 19 digs.

**Janae Vander Ploeg, Northern Arizona** - Vander Ploeg averaged nearly four kills a set and played a huge role in helping the Lumberjacks complete a two-match road sweep this weekend. For the weekend, the sophomore from Colorado Springs, Colo. averaged 3.88 kills while hitting a high percentage at .304 - nearly eighty points above her season average. Vander Ploeg also averaged 2.00 digs per set while leading the team with 34.0 points...In NAU's first match of the week - a 3-0 sweep over Weber State - Vander Ploeg narrowly missed her fourth double-double of the season with nine kills and nine digs. She was then very instrumental in the Lumberjacks' come-from-behind victory over Idaho State on Saturday. After NAU fell behind 2-0 in the match, Vander Ploeg led the Lumberjack charge with nine of her career-high 22 kills as well as two services in the critical third set that not only kept NAU alive in the match but handed Idaho State its first set loss at home this season. As the Lumberjacks completed their comeback to snap a three-way tie for second place with Idaho State and Portland State, Vander Ploeg finished with 22 kills - her highest total of her career and the highest total for any Lumberjack this season - while hitting .413 with seven digs...In the process, Vander Ploeg crossed the 600 kill mark for her career Saturday night vs. Idaho State.

**Ashley Guthrie, Northern Colorado** - Guthrie was an excellent facilitator this weekend as she tallied 99 total assists in matches against Montana State and Montana. She had 41 assists in a three-set victory against the Bobcats and topped that with 58 in a very competitive five-set loss to Montana. Against MSU, Guthrie helped two teammates record double-digit kills and helped the team as a whole hit .319 with just 12 attack errors, the Bears' lowest combined total in any match all season. Against Montana, she helped four players get to 10 or more kills, including three at 15 or more, and the Bears as a team hit .220. She also recorded double-doubles in each match, collecting 10 and 11 digs against Montana State and Montana, respectively. For the weekend, she averaged 12.3 assists per set as the Bears averaged 14.8 kills per set while hitting .255, all marks well above their season averages, in addition to eight kills with just one error while hitting .333, four block assists and one service ace.

**Garyn Schlatter, Portland State** - Schlatter posted her team-leading sixth double-double of the season Friday night at Sacramento State. She posted 45 assists and 11 digs in the match but the Vikings fell to the Hornets in four sets. She added five kills, two assists, and two blocking assists...Schlatter's 45 assists moved her career total to 4,015 becoming just the third Viking in program history to surpass the 4,000-career assist mark. Her career mark is third all-time at Portland State...For the season, Schlatter has 753 assists (10.32 aps) while adding 145 digs (1.99 dps), second most on the team. She is hitting .276 and has 19 service aces and 52 total blocks.
