OFFENSE - Garrett Safron, QB, Sacramento State



Safron, a 6-foot-2, 190-pound junior from Santa Monica, Calif., completed 26-of-39 passes for 312 yards and three touchdowns in Sacramento State's 37-21 win over Northern Colorado. Safron threw TD passes of 11, 12, and 13 yards. It was the fifth 300-yard passing game of his career. He completed passes to eight different receivers, and also ran for 33 yards to finish with 345 yards of total offense. Safron has thrown 16 touchdown games in Sacramento State's last four games. Safron helped Sacramento State win its first two Big Sky games

for the first time in school history.

DEFENSE - Anthony Goodwin, CB, Montana



Goodwin, a 6-foot-1, 180-pound senior from Murrieta, Calif., intercepted two passes, had seven more pass breakups and three tackles in No. 10 Montana's 55-27 victory over Portland State. Both of Goodwin's interceptions led to Montana touchdowns. His first interception came in the first quarter. He returned it 9 yards to the Portland State 36-yard line. His second interception came in the third quarter at the Portland State 45-yard line. The seven pass deflections are the most by a player in the FCS this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Greg Hardin, Ret., North Dakota



Hardin, a 5-11, 177-pound senior from Bellevue, Neb., returned a kick 99 yards for a touchdown in North Dakota's 28-25 win over Idaho State. Hardin became the first player in school history to return three kicks for touchdowns in his career. Hardin's return came in the third quarter and put his team up 21-10. Hardin had 126 receiving yards to finish with 225 all-purpose yards. He became the school's all-time leader in receiving yards.

SPECIAL TEAMS - Shawn Johnson, Ret., Montana St.



Johnson, a 5-9, 175-pound junior from Bakersfield, Calif., returned a kick 100 yards for a touchdown in Montana State's 36-7 win over Northern Arizona. The kick return was Montana State's first for a touchdown since 2008, and just the third 100-yarder in school history. Johnson finished the game with 246 all-purpose yards. He rushed for 92 yards with a 27-yard touchdown run, and also had

54 punt return yards.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

MCGHEE ENGINEERS 33rd WIN: Montana State QB DeNarius McGhee quarterbacked Montana State to a 36-7 win over Northern Arizona on Saturday, making his 33rd victory as a starting quarterback. McGhee is now tied with Dave Dickenson for second place in league history. Dickenson led UM to 33 regular-season wins from 1993-95. Nevada's Eric Beavers holds the Big Sky record with 40 career victories. McGhee is also on the verge of becoming just the second QB in league history to pass for 10,000 yards and rush for 1,000 in his career. Montana State has a bye week this week, and takes on Weber State in Ogden on Oct. 19. McGhee will enter that game with 9,840 passing yards and 1,008 rushing yards. McGhee is the active FCS leader in total offense with 10,864 yards of offense. McGhee has guided Montana State to a 23-3 record in Big Sky Conference games. Former Montana State QB Travis Lulay threw for 10,746 yards and rushed for 1,459 yards.

NAU DEFENSE SCORES AGAIN: Northern Arizona's Austin Hasquet returned an interception 37 yards for a touchdown in the Lumberjacks' 37-7 loss to Montana State. It marked Northern Arizona's sixth defensive touchdown this season, and fourth on an interception return. The league record for team interception returns for touchdowns is six by Northern Arizona in 1985. Northern Arizona has scored a defensive touchdown in four consecutive games. The six touchdowns have come by six different players. Northern Arizona's defense has scored as many touchdowns this season as NAU's offense.

AGGIES 2-0: After starting the season 0-4, UC Davis has won back-to-back conference games. UC Davis finished 3-5 last season in conference, the program's first in the Big Sky. Junior Gabe Manzanarez rushed for 175 yards on 33 carries with two touchdowns in the win over Southern Utah. Manzanarez rushed for 208 yards and a touchdown the week prior in a win over Idaho State. The UC Davis defense, which is allowing 20.7 points per game, held SUU to 34 rushing yards and had five sacks.

A FIRST FOR THE HORNETS: Sacramento State beat Northern Colorado 37-21 on Saturday night at home to move to 2-0 in Big Sky play for the first time in school history. Sacramento State joined the Big Sky Conference in 1996. On Sept. 28, Sacramento State opened league play with a 31-3 win over Weber State, marking just the third time the Hornets won their Big Sky opener. Sacramento State moved to 8-0 all-time against Northern Colorado. Hornet QB Garrett Safron completed 26-of-39 passes for 312 yards and three touchdowns. Safron has thrown 16 TD passes in the last four games, including 10 to DeAndre Carter.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL: Montana is the only team remaining in the FCS that has yet to throw an interception this season. Every other Big Sky team has thrown at least three interceptions. Montana quarterback Jordan Johnson leads the nation in pass efficiency. Johnson is completing 60 percent of his passes with 14 touchdowns. Johnson has attempted 110 passes this season. UM leads the Big Sky and ranks seventh in the nation in turnover margin at 1.6.

SKY IN THE SAGARIN: Three Big Sky teams are rated in the top 10 among FCS teams in this week's Jeff Sagarin Ratings. Eastern Washington is sixth among FCS teams and 85th overall. Montana State is seventh and 89th. Montana is eighth and 94th. North Dakota State is No. 1 amongst FCS teams and 37th overall. Northern Iowa is second, followed by Eastern Illinois, Towson and McNeese State.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

DALY, ADAMS ADDED TO WATCH LISTS: Montana State senior defensive end Brad Daly was added to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch list, while Eastern Washington quarterback Vernon Adams was added to the Walter Payton Award Watch list. Daly leads the league with nine sacks and 12 tackles for loss. His average of 2.2 tackles for loss per game ranks third in the nation. He leads the nation in sacks per game. Adams ranks fourth in the nation in total offense at 367.8 yards per game. He has thrown 19 touchdown passes which ranks second in the nation. He is second in the nation in pass efficiency at 189.8 percent. The awards are presented at the end of the season by The Sports Network. Montana linebacker Jordan Tripp, Eastern Washington linebacker Ronnie Hamlin, and Northern Colorado linebacker Clarence Bumpas are also candidates for the Buchanan. Montana State quarterback DeNarius McGhee and Northern Arizona running back Zach Bauman are candidates for the Payton. Big Sky Conference players have won seven Walter Payton Awards and five Buck Buchanan Awards.

PACKING THEM IN: Two Big Sky Conference teams rank in the top four in the nation in average attendance per game. Montana leads the nation with an average of 25,904 fans per home game. Montana State is fourth with an average of 19,960. James Madison of the CAA is second at 22,701, while Southern of the SWAC is third at 22,080. Montana State drew a Bobcat Stadium record crowd of 21,027 to Saturday's win over Northern Arizona. Montana State is second in the nation in percentage of capacity filled at 131.34 percent. The listed seating of Bobcat Stadium is 17,777. Montana is 12th in percentage of capacity at 102.72 percent. Eastern Washington is 17th at 93.51 percent.

HARDIN SETS MARKS: North Dakota senior All-American Greg Hardin became the school's all-time leader in reception yards, and also became the first player in school history to return three kick returns for touchdowns in his career. Hardin caught eight passes for 126 yards in UND's 28-25 win over Idaho State. Hardin has 2,978 receiving yards in his career. Hardin returned a kick 99 yards for a touchdown, marking his third career kick return for a score, and the second this season. Hardin is the only player in the Big Sky with more than one kick return for a touchdown this season. Hardin had 225 all-purpose yards against the Bengals. He ranks third in the nation in all-purpose yards per game at 221.6.

Extra points: Montana State senior Tanner Bleskin became the school's all-time leader in receptions with 170. Bleskin caught four passes for 46 yards. His 170th catch, which broke the record, was thrown by his brother Jake Bleskin...Sacramento State's DeAndre Carter leads the nation with 10 touchdown catches... ISU's Brendon Garcia made a career-long 51-yard field goal in ISU's loss to North Dakota...ISU Mitch Beckstead interception two passes, his first career picks and the first interceptions for the Bengals this season...Cal Poly's Bobby Zalud made a 53-yard field goal in a 24-10 loss to Yale. It is the longest field goal in the FCS this season...Northern Colorado QB Seth Lobato returned last Saturday after missing two games with an injury. Lobato threw for 340 yards in a loss to Sacramento State...Home teams are 6-6 in the first 12 conference games...Northern Arizona's Zach Bauman needs 76 rushing yards to move into seventh place on the Big Sky's all-time rushing list...Four Big Sky teams are ranked in both major FCS polls. In the Coaches' Poll, MSU is 7th, followed by EWU. UM is 10th and NAU is 21st. In the Sports Network Poll, EWU is 6th, MSU is 7th, UM is 11th and NAU is 19th. Cal Poly dropped out of the top 25 in both polls.
